#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** are now 19-13 on the season...are now 0-1 on this 10-game homestand against Seattle (0-1), Washington (three games) and Chicago-AL (three games)...A's are 6-5 in first games of series this season.
- Scott Kazmir** recorded his first loss of the season...the loss snapped his career-high tying six-game winning streak dating back to Sept. 21, 2013...before tonight was 4-0 for the first time in his career.
- Fernando Abad** has not allowed a run in his first 14 outings (13.1 ip).
- Daric Barton** (0 for 3) is 0 for 14 in seven games against Seattle this year...entered the season with a .303 career average against Seattle.
- Alberto Callaspo** (0 for 3, bb, gidp) is now 0 for his last 11...is batting .171 (12 for 70) over his last 19 games after hitting .394 through his first nine contests.
- Josh Donaldson** (1 for 4, so) has reached base safely via hit or walk in each of his last 27 games...over the last six years, the only streak by an Athletic longer is his 28-game streak from last year (Aug. 25-Sept. 23)
