OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost four of their last five games and are now 6-9 over their last 15 after starting the year 13-5... are now 0-2 on this 10-game homestand against Seattle (0-2), Washington (three games) and Chicago-AL (three games).
- Jesse Chavez took his first loss in seven starts this season...allowed a season-high tying four earned runs (last: April 27 at Houston).

L — Chavez (2-1)

- Sean Doolittle recorded a season-high four strikeouts...struck out at least four consecutive batters in one game for the second time in his career (last: five consecutive strikeouts, June 10, 2012 at Arizona)...is the first pitcher in the majors this season to pitch at least 1.1 innings while striking out all batters faced.
- Alberto Callaspo (0 for 3, bb, so, gidp) is now 0 for his last 14...is batting .164 (12 for 73) over his last 20 games after hitting .394 over his first nine contests.
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) is 7 for 21 (.333) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, four walks and six runs scored over his last seven games.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 5) is batting .317 (13 for 41) at home compared to .208 (11 for 53) on the road.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 4, bb, so) has reached base safely via hit or walk in each of his last 28 games...that ties his 28-game streak from last season (Aug. 25-Sept. 23) for the A's longest such streak over the last six years...is 35 for 116 (.302) with 24 runs, 10 doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, and 15 walks during his current streak.
- Nick Punto (1 for 3, 2 rbi, bb, so) is 4 for 12 (.333) against Seattle this season.

- Robinson Cano (2 for 4, r, ibb, so, gidp) has hit safely in 26 of his 31 games this season with 11 multiple hit games.
- James Jones (2 for 5, r, 2 so) recorded his first career multiple hit game.
- Mike Zunino (0 for 3, rbi, sf) extended his hitless streak to 0 for his last 10.
