OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have won a season-high five consecutive games after losing five of the previous six...are now 5-3 on this 10-game homestand against Seattle (1-3), Washington (3-0), and Chicago (AL) (1-0).
- Jesse Chavez** tossed a career-high eight innings...has now tossed seven innings or more in four of his eight starts this season.
- Yoenis Cespedes** (1 for 4, so) is batting 13 for 44 (.295) with four doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, six walks and 12 runs scored over his last 12 games.
- Josh Donaldson** (1 for 3, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) hit a two-run home run in the fifth inning...it was his first home run in May, snapping a 15-game homerless streak...combined for three home runs in his two games prior to the homerless streak.
- Josh Reddick** (2 for 3, 2 r, 3b, rbi, bb, so) hit an RBI triple in the second inning, his third triple of the season...hit just two triples in 2013...it was his first RBI hit since April 29 at Texas.

CHICAGO NOTES

- The **Chicago White Sox** have lost three straight games after winning five of their previous six.
- John Danks** is now 6-2 with a 2.20 ERA (17 er in 69.2 ip) in 10 career starts against the Athletics.
- Daniel Webb** issued a season-high four walks.
- Jose Abreu** (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi 2 so) now has 14 home runs and 32 RBI in his last 33 games...is the first player in White Sox history, and the sixth player in MLB history to hit at least 14 home runs in his first 40 career games (last: Albert Pujols, 14, 2001)...his 38 RBI in his first 40 career games are the second most in franchise history (Zeke Bonura, 43, 1941).
- Gordon Beckham** (1 for 3, 2b, bb, so) has hit safely in 12 of his last 13 games, going 16 for 54 in the span (.296).
- Conor Gillaspie** (1 for 4) is batting .294 (10 for 34) with three doubles, four RBI, and five runs scored in his last nine games.
