OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have won a season-high six consecutive games and are now a season-high 10 games over .500...this is the team's first six-game win streak since May 24, 2013-May 29, 2013...are now 6-3 on this 10-game homestand against Seattle (1-3), Washington (3-0), and Chicago (AL) (2-0).
- Drew Pomeranz** struck out a career-high eight batters...has made two starts this season, and has not allowed a run in 10.0 innings...tossed 5.0 innings tonight and has now tossed five innings or fewer in each of his last 18 starts dating back to Aug. 1, 2012...that is the longest streak of five innings or fewer by a Major Leaguer since at least 1914 (previous: Len Barker, 14 from May 21, 1985-June 10, 1987).
- Yoenis Cespedes** (2 for 4, 2 r, 2b, rbi) is batting 15 for 48 (.312) with five doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, six walks and 13 runs scored over his last 14 games.
- John Jaso** (3 for 5, 2 r, 2b, so) is 15 for 33 (.454) with four walks over his last ten games after going 3 for 26 (.115) over his previous ten contests.
- Brandon Moss** (3 for 5, r, 2b, 2 hr, 5 rbi) is batting .365 (15 for 41) with four home runs and 12 RBI over his last ten games...had his fifth career two-home run game...last was Aug. 28, 2013 at Detroit.

- Alexi Ramirez** (0 for 2, bb) was replaced at shortstop in the seventh inning...had played every inning of every game until he was replaced.
