#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** had a season-high six-game win streak snapped today...went 6-4 on the 10-game homestand against Seattle (1-3), Washington (3-0), and Chicago (AL) (2-1)...have an off-day tomorrow, then begin a nine-game, 11-day road trip to Cleveland (3 games), Tampa Bay (3 games) and Toronto (3 games).
- John Jaso** and **Gordon Beckham** hit lead-off home runs for the A's and White Sox, respectively...the last time the A's played in a game in which both teams hit a lead-off home run was Aug. 30, 2002. (Ray Durham for Oakland, Jacque Jones for Minnesota).
- Tommy Milone** has a 0.64 ERA (1 er in 14.0 ip) in his last two starts after going 0-3 with a 5.86 ERA in his first five starts.
- Dan Otero** has thrown six straight scoreless outings (8.2 ip) after allowing four runs over his previous two appearances (0.2 ip)...began the season by allowing one run over his first 10 games (12.1 ip).
- John Jaso** (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, bb, so) is 16 for 36 (.444) over his last 11 games after going 3 for 26 (.115) over his previous ten contests...has hit safely and scored a run in each of his last five games (10 for 17, seven runs)...hit his third career lead-off home run (previous: Sept. 4, 2010 at Baltimore).

#### CHICAGO NOTES

- The **Chicago White Sox** snapped a four-game losing streak with today's win...snapped a seven-game losing streak at O.Co Coliseum...continue their nine-game, 10-day trip at Houston (3 games) and Kansas City (3 games)...hit their first lead-off home run of the season today (Beckham, first inning).
- Gordon Beckham** and **John Jaso** hit lead-off home runs for the White Sox and A's, respectively...the last time the White Sox played in a game in which both teams hit a lead-off home run was Aug. 17, 2006 against Kansas City (David DeJesus and Pablo Ozuna).
- Jose Abreu** (1 for 4, r, hr, 3 rbi, 2 so) became the first White Sox player, and fourth in MLB history, to hit 15-plus home runs in his first 42 career games (also Wally Berger, Kevin Maas and Wally Joyner)...eleven of his 15 home runs have come in the last 24 games.
- Gordon Beckham** (3 for 4, 2 r, hr, rbi) hit his second lead-off home run of his career (previous: Aug. 7, 2013 against Kansas City)...had his second three-hit game of the season (4 hits, May 6 at CHC).
