OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** snapped a four-game losing streak, which was the longest of their season...The A's are 25-19 on Memorial Day since moving to Oakland...the A's hit a season-high five home runs in a game for first time since Aug. 9, 2013 (at Toronto)....each of the first four home runs were solo home runs, the first time the A's have hit four solo home runs since June 16, 2013 vs. Seattle...the A's hit back-to-back home runs for the second time this year (May 9 vs. Washington).
- Tommy Milone is 3-0 with a 1.03 ERA (3 er in 26.1 ip) over his last four starts after going 0-3 with a 5.86 ERA over his first five starts.
- Kyle Blanks (2 for 3, 3 r, hr, rbi, bb) homered for the first time since June 16, 2013, ending a career-high 49-game homerless streak.
- Josh Donaldson (3 for 5, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) has reached base safely in each of his last 41 games as a third basemen, which is the longest such streak by an Athletics third basemen since at least 1914...is a .361 (17 for 47) career hitter against Detroit during the regular season.
- Brandon Moss (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) has 18 extra base hits in May, which ties the Oakland record for extra base hits in the month of May (Jason Giambi,
- 2001)...is batting .333 (27 for 81) with 15 runs, eight doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 21 RBIs and 10 walks over his last 21 games. • Derek Norris (1 for 5, r, hr, 4 rbi) hit his first career grand slam in the 8th inning.

DETROIT NOTES

- The Detroit Tigers have now lost seven of their last eight games...the Tigers are currently on a seven-game road trip against Oakland (four games) and Seattle (three games)...Detroit has a .571 road winning percentage (14-8) this season.
- Drew Smyly allowed a career-high four home runs...had allowed four home runs in nine games and 39.1 innings prior to today...also allowed a career-high tying eight hits and six earned runs.
- Miguel Cabrera (1 for 4, 2b, so) is batting .380 (46 for 121) with 21 runs, 13 doubles, six home runs and 35 RBI over the last 31 games.
- Victor Martinez (2 for 4) has hit safely in 25 of last 28 games, batting .366 (40 for 109) with nine doubles, nine home runs and 22 RBI during that span.
