OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost five of their last six games after winning five straight...are 1-1 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (1-1) and Lost Angeles-AL (three games).
- Sonny Gray tossed six innings and allowed a season-high four runs...allowed two runs in the first inning...had not allowed more than one run in the first inning since August 25, 2013 at Baltimore.
- Alberto Callaspo (2 for 4, r, 2b, rbi) extended his hitting streak against the Tigers to 16 games dating back to July 17, 2012...that is now the longest active
 streak against Detroit...is 21 for 57 (.368) during the streak.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 3, bb) has reached base safely in each of his last 42 games as a third basemen, which is the longest such streak by an Athletics third basemen since at least 1914...is a .340 (17 for 50) career hitter against Detroit during the regular season.
- John Jaso (1 for 1, r, hr, 2 rbi, bb) is batting .340 (18 for 53) with four home runs and 10 RBI in 16 games in May after hitting .236 with a home run and four RBI in 22 games in April.

DETROIT NOTES

- The Detroit Tigers snapped their three-game losing streak...are currently 1-1 on their seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-1) and Seattle (three games).
- Max Scherzer has allowed a total of 12 runs over his last two starts (13 ip)...allowed just 12 runs over his first nine starts this season (59.0 ip).
- Joba Chamberlain has not allowed a run in 13 of his last 14 appearances, and has a 1.32 ERA over that stretch (2 er in 13.2 ip)
- Miquel Cabrera (2 for 4, 2 r. hr. 2 rbi, so) is batting .380 (48 for 125) with 23 runs, 13 doubles, seven home runs and 37 RBI over the last 32 games.
- Ian Kinsler (0 for 5, so) had his 11-game hitting streak snapped...batted .400 (20 for 50) with 10 runs scored, eight doubles, and three RBI over the streak.
- Victor Martinez (1 for 3, bb) has hit safely in 26 of last 29 games, batting .366 (41 for 112) with nine doubles, nine home runs and 22 RBI during that span.
