OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have lost six of their last eight games...are now 2-2 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (2-2) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- Jesse Chavez tossed 6.0 innings...has allowed a season-high tying eight hits in each of his last two starts (three times overall).
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 4, r, 2b, bb, 2 so) has reached base safely in each of his last 44 games as a third basemen, which is the longest such streak by an Athletics third basemen since at least 1914...has reached base safely in 47 of his last 48 games overall and 49 of 53 for the season.
- John Jaso (2 for 3) is batting .350 (21 for 60) with four home runs and 10 RBI in 17 games in May after hitting .236 with a home run and four RBI in 22 games in April...the four home runs are his most ever for a month.
- Nick Punto (1 for 2, r, hr, 2 rbi, 3 bb) hit his first home run of the season in the fourth inning which snapped a 51-game homerless streak (last: Aug. 12, 2013 vs. New York-NL)...collected a season-high and career-high tying three walks (eighth time, last: May 1, 2012 vs. Oakland).

- The **Detroit Tigers** are currently 2-2 on their seven-game road trip to Oakland (2-2) and Seattle (three games).
- Rick Porcello tossed 5.2 innings and allowed a season-high six walks (previous high: two, three times).
- Miguel Cabrera (1 for 3, r, 2 rbi, bb) is batting .374 (49 for 131) with 24 runs, 13 doubles, seven home runs and 39 RBI over his last 34 games.
- Ian Kinsler (2 for 5, 2 r, 2 2b, rbi) is batting .348 (39 for 112) with 21 runs scored, 13 doubles, two home runs and nine RBI in 25 games in May.
- Victor Martinez (2 for 4, 2b, 2 rbi) has hit safely in 28 of last 31 games, batting .375 (45 for 120) with 10 doubles, nine home runs and 24 RBI during that span.
