OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their Major League leading sixth series sweep of the season...are 11-3 in their last 14 home games after losing six straight at the O.co Coliseum...went 5-2 on this seven-game homestand against Detroit (2-2) and Los Angeles-AL (3-0)...are 5-1 against the Angels this season and 18-11 against the AL West.
- Sonny Gray tossed 6.2 innings...has now tossed six innings or more while allowing three or fewer runs in 11 of his 12 starts this season...threw a season-high 113 pitches.
- Alberto Callaspo (3 for 4) recorded a season-high tying three hits (third time, last: April 30 at Texas).
- Coco Crisp (1 for 5, r, 2b, rbi) hit safely in all seven games on the homestand (9 for 27, .333) and now has a 13-game home hitting streak (17 for 46, .370)... that is the longest home hitting streak by an Athletic over the last three years...is batting .329 (23 for 70) in Oakland compared to .195 (16 for 82) on the road.
- Josh Donaldson (2 for 4, 2 rbi) is batting .325 (25 for 77) with 23 runs scored, two doubles, a triple, eight home runs, 24 RBI and 16 walks over his last 21 games...has reached base safely in each of his last 47 games as a third basemen, which is the longest streak by an A's third basemen since at least 1914...it is the longest streak by any Major League third basemen since Alex Rodriguez's 53-game streak in 2004. (April 18-July 17).
- Stephen Vogt (0 for 4, so) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today for his first stint with the Athletics this year.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels have lost three consecutive games for the first time since being swept in their opening series in Seattle (March 31-April 2)...are currently 2-5 on their ten-game road trip to Seattle (2-2), Oakland (0-5) and Houston (three games).
- Jared Weaver allowed season highs in hits (11) and runs (6)...also allowed a season-high tying five earned runs...recorded his first loss against the Athletics since Sept. 23, 2011 (at home), and his first loss at the Coliseum since Sept. 4, 2010...was 5-0 with a 0.41 ERA (2 er in 44.1 ip) in his last six starts against the Athletics prior to today's start.
- Hank Conger (0 for 3, so) extended his hitless streak to 0 for 13.
- Collin Cowgill (1 for 3, 2 r, bb, 2 so) has reached base safely in 31 of 35 starts.
- Howie Kendrick (2 for 4, so) has hit safely in 14 of his last 17 games, and 17 of his last 22 (26 for 88, .295).
