OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** are 3-5 over their last eight games and 10-10 over their last 20 contests...are now 12-5 in their last 17 games against New York since July 19, 2012.
- **Sonny Gray** is 1-2 with a 5.63 ERA (15 er in 24.0 ip) over his last four starts...went 5-1 with a 1.99 ERA over his first 10 starts...allowed two earned runs in the first inning...has now allowed eight runs in 14 first innings pitched this season (5.14 ERA).
- **Yoenis Cespedes** (0 for 3, so) had his season-high nine-game hitting streak snapped...went 15 for 41 (.366) over the streak.
- **Coco Crisp** (0 for 3, bb, so) had his 12-game home hitting streak snapped...went 17 for 46 (.370) during the streak...it was the longest home hitting streak by an Athletic over the last three years.
- **Josh Donaldson** (0 for 4) extended his hitless streak to 0 for his last 27, which is the longest hitless streak of his career.
- **Jed Lowrie** (1 for 2, 2b, bb) is 39 for 127 (.307) in his career against the Yankees.
- **Derek Norris** (1 for 3) is 6 for 18 (.333) in June.
- **Andy Parrino** (0 for 3, so) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento today for his first stint in the majors this year.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The **New York Yankees** are now 5-2 on their nine-game road trip to Kansas City (1-2), Seattle (3-0), and Oakland (1-0).
- **David Phelps** snapped his four-game losing streak, which was the longest losing streak of his career...had a 6.57 ERA (18 er in 24.2 ip) in his four consecutive losing starts over the streak.
- **Jacoby Ellsbury** (1 for 4, rbi, bb, 2 so) has hit safely in a season-high 17 straight games...is 25 for 67 (.373) with nine runs, three doubles, two home runs, and 13 RBI over the streak...it is the longest hitting streak by a Yankee since Derek Jeter hit safely in 19 straight games, Sept. 4-25, 2012.
- **Derek Jeter** (2 for 4, r, gidp) is 10 for 24 (.417) with six runs, one double, two RBI, two walks, and two stolen bases in six games on the road trip.
- **Ichiro Suzuki** (2 for 4, r, rbi, so) is 8 for 22 (.364) with two RBI in seven games (five starts) on the road trip.
