OAKLAND NOTES

- · Tonight's game was delayed 38 minutes due to a circuit breaker outage...the breaker had to be reset manually in the left field light tower.
- The Oakland Athletics are 12-4 over their last 16 home games after losing a season-high six straight games at home from April 21-May 7 (Game 1)...are now 13-5 in their last 18 games against New York since July 19, 2012...are 1-1 on their current 10-game homestand against New York-AL (1-1), Texas (three games) and Boston (four games).
- Scott Kazmir has allowed one run or fewer in five of his last seven starts...is 4-1 with a 1.44 ERA (7 er in 43.2 ip) and a .188 (29 for 154) batting average over that span...went 4-1 with a 2.64 ERA and .223 opponents batting average over his first seven starts.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 4, so) extended his hitless streak to 0 for his last 31, which is an ongoing career long...he was ejected by home plate umpire Hal Gibson after the bottom of the seventh inning.
- John Jaso (0 for 4, rbi) is 0 for his last 21, which is the longest hitless streak of his career (previous: 18, Sept. 30, 2010-April 8, 2011).
- Eric Sogard (1 for 3, r, 2 rbi, bb) drove in two runs with a second-inning single...had just one RBI over his previous 27 games spanning 77 at bats.
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 2, r) has hit safely in four straight games and nine of 11 contests since being recalled June 1...is hitting .417 (5 for 12) over current four-game hitting streak.

NEW YORK NOTES

- The New York Yankees are now 5-3 on their nine-game road trip to Kansas City (1-2), Seattle (3-0), and Oakland (1-1).
- Hiroki Kuroda allowed more than three earned runs on the road for the first time this season (seventh road start)...fell to 1-9 in his last 14 road starts dating back to July 31, 2013.
- Jacoby Ellsbury (0 for 3, bb) had his season-high 17-game hitting streak snapped...went 25 for 67 (.373) with nine runs, three doubles, two home runs, and 13 RBI over the streak...was the longest hitting streak by a Yankee since Derek Jeter hit safely in 19 straight games, Sept. 4-25, 2012.
- Kelly Johnson (1 for 2, r, 2b, bb, so) is now 8 for 23 (.348) over his last eight games after going 2 for 23 (.087) over his previous 12 contests.
- Brian McCann (1 for 4, so) made his second career start—and fifth appearance—at first base...his last appearance at first base was a start on May 28 at St.
- Mark Teixeira was a late scratch from the Yankees linuep with left ribcage tightness.
