WINS AND LOSSES: The Rangers are 3-1 on this 3-city, 9-game trip to the West Coast in Seattle (2-1), Oakland (1-0), and Anaheim...Texas has won 4 of 5 beginning 6/11...club is 7-7 in June and 13-11 beginning May 24 but just 21-27 since 4/25...at 35-35, this marks the 1st time that Texas has not had a winning record through 70 games since 2008 (35-35/35-36 after 71 games)...this is the 1st time Texas has been at the .500 mark since 6/7 at 31-31 with last winning mark on 6/6 at 31-30...team has been a season high 3 games under .500 on 3 occasions, last at 31-34 on 6/10 and has been season-high 6 games over .500 twice.

STANDINGS: Texas has been in the 4th position for 14 of the last 15 days beginning 6/3...Monday's victory moved the Rangers to within 7.0 games of the division-leading A's for the 3rd time in last 4 days...club has not trailed by fewer than 7.0 games since 6/2 (6.0 GB)...largest deficit of the seasonm is 8.0 games on 9 total days...Texas had not trailed by as many as 8.0 games through a season's 1st 69 games since 2006 (-17.5 GB)... prior to this season, Rangers had not been anywhere other than first or 2nd in the division as late as mid-May since 9/22/08 (3rd place).

ON THE ROAD: The Rangers have won 4 of 5 away from home beginning June 1...the .800 road winning percentage in June is 3rd best in the majors to .857 (6-1) for KC and SEA...Texas is 19-16 away from home, winning 6 of 9, 9 of 13, and 10 of last 15, the longer span beginning 5/22...the Rangers' .667 (10-5) winning percentage since 5/22 is T5th best in the majors in that period....overall, Texas' .554 away winning percentage is T6th best mark in the A.L....team was also 18-17 after 35 road games a year ago (19-17 after 36) and 20-15 in 2012...team is 5-4-0 in last 9 road series, winning 3 of the last 4.

--Texas ranks 2nd in the majors with a .277 batting average (BAL-.289) and a .333 on-base percentage (LA-.340) away from home...the Rangers have a .288 (214-742) road batting average over the last 21 games since 5/4.

VERSUS OAKLAND: Texas is 4-3 vs. the A's this season, snapping a 3-game losing streak on Monday for 1st victory since 4/23...the Rangers hjave won all 4 meetings at O.co Coliseum and lost all 3 at Globe Life Park...the Rangers have lost 7 of the last 11 to the A's, goining 0-6 at home in that span...Texas is 21-24 in the series since the start of 2012...club has won 4 straight at O.co Coliseum since a loss on 9/4/13, the team's longest winning streak here since 5 in a row, 8/12-9/21/11...club is 9-4 in Oakland since start of 2013...all-time, the Rangers lead, 328-316 overall with the A's having a 167-155 advantage here in Oakland.

--the 14 runs on Monday were the Rangers' most at O.co Coliseum since they tallied 16 on 9/26/10...that was also Texas' last 4-HR game here.

--Texas is 16-12 overall vs. the A.L. West, 10-6 on the road.

VERSUS LEFTHANDERS: The Rangers are facing lefthhanded starters in each of the 1st 2 games of this series...Only one southpaw had started against the Rangers in the previous 22 games, Cleveland's T.J. House on 6/9 in Arlington...in their last 3 starts, lefthanders have allowed 21 runs/19 ER in 10.1 innings versus Texas, going 0-2 with a ND...the last LH starter to defeat the Rangers was Dallas Keuchel on 5/13 at HOU...overall, Texas is 9-10 in games started by opposing lefthanders, 6-3 on the road.

--Texas is batting .289 (183-633) against lefthanded pitching in 2014, the 2nd highest team average in the majors behind COL (.294)...the Rangers have a ML high .354 OBP vs. southpaws with the 2nd best slugging percentage at .444 (COL-.480).

--Alex Rios is tied with BAL's Nelson Cruz for the highest batting average vs. LHP among qualifying major leaguers at .429 (27-63).

OFFENSIVE SURGE: Texas matched its season high with 14 runs on Monday (5/4 at LAA), the 7th time it has been in double figures in 2014... the club's 16 hits last night were the most since 5/25 at DET (17) while the 4 homers were the highest total since 9/9/13 at TB (4)...the Rangers had not hit more than 2 HR in a game all year as the 69 contests without a 3+ HR game marked the team's 3rd longest such streak ever to begin a year: 1973 (122) and 1978 (83)...team produced just 6 runs and 19 hits total in the 3 games in SEA over the weekend...Texas has a .282 (235-832) average over last 24 games to improve from .257 to .266, 3rd highest in the majors to COL (.284) and DET (.275)...team has a .192 (28-146) AVG with RISP over the last 19 games beginning 5/27.

POWER AT FIRST: Rangers 1st basemen have connected for 3 home runs in the last 2 games after hitting just 5 in the season's 1st 68 contests... on Sunday, Brad Snyder hit his 1st major league homer in the 2nd inning to account for the Rangers' lone run...last night Donnie Murphy went deep twice for the 4th 2-HR game of his ML career, the 1st since 8/19/13 vs. WAS as a member of the Chicago Cubs...it was the 2nd 2-homer game of the season by a Ranger (Adrian Beltre on 6/4 vs. BAL) and the 1st multi-HR game by a Texas 1B since Mitch Moreland went deep twice on 5/14/13, also at OAK.

BEHIND THE PLATE: Robinson Chirinos was 3-for-5 with a homer and 3 RBI on monday...he matched his career high for hits (3rd time, all in 2014) and had a season best for RBI...Chirinos has 2 HR and 5 RBI in last 2 games and 4 HR and 10 RBI in his last 8 games...he is tied for 3rd in A.L. for HR in June (4)...his 6 overall HR match Brian McCann for the 2nd most for an A.L. catcher, one behind Yan Gomes, Derek Norris, Salvador, Perez, and Mike Zunino...Chirnos is batting .357 (15-42) with 4 HR and 12 RBI over his last 12 G to rise from .198 to .248, best since 5/3 (.250)...he also leads qualifying ML catchers by throwing out 42.9% of runners trying to steal (15 of 35).

ROOKIE PRODUCTION: Michael Choice also has 4 homers in June after-snapping an 0-for-16 drought with his 7th blast of the season on Monday... his last 3 and 4 of last 6 hits have been HR...Choice is T3rd with MIN's Josmil Pinto among A.L. rookies in HR behind CWS's Jose Abreu (19) and HOU's George Springer (12) and ranks 4th among A.L. rookies with 26 RBI...Rougned Odor had his 2nd game of 3+ hits on Monday and is batting .361 (22-61) with 12 RBI in last 19 games to rise from .179 to .303, 3rd best among ML rookies (75+ AB) behind MIN's Danny Santana (.340) and BOS's Brock Holt (.333).

BY THE NUMBERS: The Rangers lead the majors in both overall disabled list uses (20) and current players on DL (14)...the 20 DL uses are already most by the Rangers since 2010 (25) with the club record being 29 in 2004...Texas has used 41 players in 2014, tied for the most in MLB and has employed 23 pitchers (including Mitch Moreland), 2nd behind NYY (24)...Rangers have also used11 rookies, T2nd in MLB (Stats, Inc.).

THE CLOSER: Joakim Soria has worked 7.2 scoreless innings with 7 saves in his last 8 games and has a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) in his last 21 appearances to drop season ERA from 7.20 to 1.80...he is 15-for-16 in save chances, converting the last 7 since blown save on 5/27 at MIN... Soria has converted all 14 career save chances vs. OAK and has held the A's to a .132 average (7-53) over his last 14 appearances against them... he has converted all 11 save tries with a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in 15 career games here at O.co Coliseum...Soria has pitched 14.0 scoreless innings in last 13 outings here beginning 5/17/07.

RANGERS SIGN CARLOS PENA: The Rangers have signed 1B Carlos Pena to a minor league contract and assigned him to Round Rock (AAA)... Pena, 36, is expected to be active either tonight or tomorrow... the RHB has a career .233 average with 285 home runs for TEX (2001), OAK (2002), DET (2002-05), BOS (2006), TB (2007-10, 2012), CHI (2011), HOU (2013), and KC (2013)...he went to spring training with LAA but was released on 3/23 and has not played in 2014.

MINOR LEAGUE SIGNING: The Rangers have signed the 24th round pick from the June 1st Year Player Draft, RHP Austin Pettibone from UC-Santa Barbara and assigned him to Spokane (Short Season A)...22 of the 40 total draft selections are under cointract.

SHORTS: Yu Darvish's next strikeout will be the 600th of his major league career...Darvish brings a string of 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings into Tuesday's start...Colby Lewis earned his 49th win as a Ranger on Monday, tying Matt Harrison and Derek Holland for 12th all-time, one behind Doc Medich...3B Adrian Beltre moved from 4th to 2nd in the latest A.L. All-Star balloting results, trailing the A's Josh Donaldson...1B Mitch Moreland is being examined by orthopedist Dr. Ned Amendola in Iowa City, IA today to seek an additional counsel on the course of action for his injured left ankle...it is likely Moreland will require surgery and an extensive rehab period for his ankle injury.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#11 Yu Darvish, RHP (7-2, 2.11)

TONIGHT: The 27-year-old right-hander is scheduled to make his 13th start of the season in the middle game of this series tonight at the Coliseum...has wins in 4 straight starts for first time in his career and is 6-1, 1.83 (11 ER/54.0 IP) his last 7 starts to drop season ERA from 2.59 to 2.11, 3rd in the A.L...last Ranger to win more than 4 straight starts (zero no decisions) was Martin Perez (6 straight Aug./Sept. 2013)...his 6 wins since the start of May are T2nd-most in MLB (Tanaka-7), this despite missing a turn through the rotation due to neck stiffness...has completed 7.0+ innings in 6 straight starts, tied for longest streak in the A.L. this season and matching his own 2012 streak for longest by any Texas starter since the beginning of 2011...has quality starts in 10 of 12...his 24 career double-digit strikeout games are T2nd in club history (Ryan-34; Witt-24) and are 2nd-most 10-K games in 1st 73 career starts since 1914 (Dwight Gooden-27)...this season, Rangers have gone 10-2 in his starts.

ON THE LEADERBOARD: Darvish ranks among American League leaders in K's per 9 (1st, 10.65), ERA (3rd, 2.11), opp. average (4th, .218), opp. SLG (4th, .316), strike-outs (6th, 101), opp. OPS (6th, .600), opp. OBP (8th, .283), and WHIP (8th, 1.13)...has held right-handed batters to a .198 (26-131) average, 8th-lowest in the A.L...opposition is batting .130 (9-69) w/ RISP, 2nd-lowest in the league (Kazmir-.117).

LAST START: Posted first career CG in last start on Wed. vs. MIA, a 6-hit shutout (9.0 IP, 6 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 10 SO, 117 pitches/76 strikes)...it was the 1st CG SHO by a Rangers RHP since Alexi Ogando on 5/23/11 vs. CWS, as the previous 11 CG SHO for Texas were by LHP...allowed 4 of 9 leadoff batters in an inning to reach, and his lone 1-2-3 inning was when he struck out the side on 10 pitches in the 8th, and never faced more than 4 batters in any frame...induced career-high 3 GDP's after a total of 2 GDP's in his first 11 starts...only inning w/ more than 17 pitches was the 1st (21)...threw just 4 pitches in the 3rd inning: popout, single, and GDP.

VS. OAKLAND: Is 0-1, 6.75 (7 ER/9.1 IP) in 2 starts vs. A's this season and 1-7, 4.73 (28 ER/53.1 IP) in 9 career starts against Oakland....last 8 starts vs. A's: 0-7, 5.32 (27 ER/45.2 IP) since winning first career start against them on 5/6/12 in Arlington...3 of those 7 losses have been games in which Rangers were shut out, including a pair of 1-0 defeats...only other opponent to pin more than 2 losses on Darvish in his career is Seattle (3-3)...has more games vs. A's than any other opponent, including back-to-back outings to finish April...took his 1st loss in '14 in a 4-0 Texas defeat on 4/28 vs. OAK, in what was the shortest outing of his ML career and just the 2nd in which he failed to complete 5.0 frames...career 0-2, 7.71 (14 ER/16.1 IP) in 3 career starts at the Coliseum, taking no decision in only other start here in '14 on April 21 (6.0 IP, 8 H, 3 R-ER), a 4-3 Rangers come-from-behind win...is a combined 0-5 in 6 starts at OAK and SEA (0-3), but is 8-1 all-time at other 2 A.L. West opponent parks (LAA: 5-1, HOU: 3-0).

STRIKEOUTS: Needs one strikeout to reach 600 for his career...leads A.L. in K's per 9 (10.65), 2nd-best in MLB (Strasburg-10.82)...is 6th in A.L. w/ 101 SO...is averaging career-best 3.74 SO/BB...has 4 games of 10+ K's in 2014 (T2nd-most in MLB, David Price has 6), all in his last 6 starts, season-high 12 K's twice...now has 24 career games of 10+ K's, tying Bobby Witt for 2nd in team history behind Nolan Ryan (34)... he has the 2nd-most 10-strikeout games in his 1st 73 career starts since 1914, trailing only Dwight Gooden (27)...has easily most K's (599) and most 10-K games (24) in MLB since start of 2012...had 41 K's in a 4-start span from 5/9-6/1, and, according to Elias, becoming 2nd ML pitcher in 2014 with 40+ K's over a 4-G span (MIA's Jose

MR. 500: Recorded his 500th career strikeout April 6 at TB (Wil Myers in 1st inning) to become 2nd-fastest pitcher in last 100 years (62 G) to accomplish the feat, behind Dwight Gooden (61 G)...reached 500 K's in his 402nd career inning, quickest by a starter in ML history...donated his cap from that game to the National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum in Cooperstown, NY.

PAIN IN THE NECK: Opened season on 15-day DL with neck stiffness after being scratched from scheduled spring start on March 21, missing a slated Opening Day outing...was activated to start club's 6th game of the year on 4/6 at TB...was the 2nd DL stint of his ML career (also July 7-22, 2013 - right trapezius strain)...was also scratched on day of scheduled start on 5/27 at MIN with neck stiffness, but MRI that day was termed "unremarkable" and he made start on next turn through rotation on 6/1 at WSH.

ON THE ROAD: Is 4-0, 2.10 (8 ER/34.1 IP) in his 5 road starts this season, and is 16-10, 3.29 (80 ER/218.2 IP) in 33 career road starts...enters tonight having tossed 9.0 consecutive scoreless innings on road...24 career quality starts on the road, including 14 of his last 18 road starts since the start of 2013...owns a .208 opponents average and 11.03 strikeouts-per-9-innings ratio away from home during his career, both best among active starters (min. 25 road starts).

A LITTLE LOVE: After receiving just 3 total runs of support in 5 April starts, Darvish has received 39 runs in his last 7 starts...his 6.50 run support average since May 1 is 4th-highest in the A.L. (had ML-low 1.44 RSA in March/April)...has received 8+ runs in 3 of his last 7 starts, this after going 28 consecutive starts (May 21, 2013-April 28, 2014) without receiving as many as 8 runs of support (received 4-or-fewer runs in 26 of those 28 outings)...has made 3 ultra quality starts (7.0+ IP, 2 ER-or-fewer) without recording a win this season...Darvish has received no run support in 4 of 12 starts, 2-runs-or-fewer in 6 of 12.

THAT'S QUALITY: Had a streak of 4 consecutive ultra quality starts (7.0+ IP, 2 ER-or-5/9-6/1, the first Ranger to do so since Derek Holland (4), Sept. 2-19, 2012.

2014: Team is 10-2 in his starts...Gimenez (1.74 ERA, 6 ER/31.0 IP) has caught him in his last 4 starts, Chirinos (4.67, 9 ER/17.1 IP) was behind the plate for him in 3 straight starts (4/16-28), and Arencibia (1.22 ERA, 5 ER/37.0 IP) caught 4 outings overall...had season-opening 16.0-inning scoreless streak and has allowed runs in just 10 of his 87 frames this year...has had multiple run-scoring innings in a game just 3 times (4/28 vs.
