



## Texas Rangers (35-35) at Oakland A's (42-28)

RHP Yu Darvish (7-2, 2.11) vs. LHP Tommy Milone (4-3, 3.47)

**WINS AND LOSSES:** The Rangers are 3-1 on this 3-city, 9-game trip to the West Coast in Seattle (2-1), Oakland (1-0), and Anaheim...Texas has won 4 of 5 beginning 6/11...club is 7-7 in June and 13-11 beginning May 24 but just 21-27 since 4/25...at 35-35, this marks the 1st time that Texas has not had a winning record through 70 games since 2008 (35-35/35-36 after 71 games)...this is the 1st time Texas has been at the .500 mark since 6/7 at 31-31 with last winning mark on 6/6 at 31-30...team has been a season high 3 games under .500 on 3 occasions, last at 31-34 on 6/10 and has been season-high 6 games over .500 twice.

**STANDINGS:** Texas has been in the 4th position for 14 of the last 15 days beginning 6/3...Monday's victory moved the Rangers to within 7.0 games of the division-leading A's for the 3rd time in last 4 days...club has not trailed by fewer than 7.0 games since 6/2 (6.0 GB)...largest deficit of the season is 8.0 games on 9 total days...Texas had not trailed by as many as 8.0 games through a season's 1st 69 games since 2006 (-17.5 GB)...prior to this season, Rangers had not been anywhere other than first or 2nd in the division as late as mid-May since 9/22/08 (3rd place).

**ON THE ROAD:** The Rangers have won 4 of 5 away from home beginning June 1...the .800 road winning percentage in June is 3rd best in the majors to .857 (6-1) for KC and SEA...Texas is 19-16 away from home, winning 6 of 9, 9 of 13, and 10 of last 15, the longer span beginning 5/22...the Rangers' .667 (10-5) winning percentage since 5/22 is T5th best in the majors in that period...overall, Texas' .554 away winning percentage is T6th best mark in the A.L...team was also 18-17 after 35 road games a year ago (19-17 after 36) and 20-15 in 2012...team is 5-4-0 in last 9 road series, winning 3 of the last 4.

--Texas ranks 2nd in the majors with a .277 batting average (BAL-.289) and a .333 on-base percentage (LA-.340) away from home...the Rangers have a .288 (214-742) road batting average over the last 21 games since 5/4.

**VERSUS OAKLAND:** Texas is 4-3 vs. the A's this season, snapping a 3-game losing streak on Monday for 1st victory since 4/23...the Rangers have won all 4 meetings at O.co Coliseum and lost all 3 at Globe Life Park...the Rangers have lost 7 of the last 11 to the A's, going 0-6 at home in that span...Texas is 21-24 in the series since the start of 2012...club has won 4 straight at O.co Coliseum since a loss on 9/4/13, the team's longest winning streak here since 5 in a row, 8/12-9/21/11...club is 9-4 in Oakland since start of 2013...all-time, the Rangers lead, 328-316 overall with the A's having a 167-155 advantage here in Oakland.

--the 14 runs on Monday were the Rangers' most at O.co Coliseum since they tallied 16 on 9/26/10...that was also Texas' last 4-HR game here.

--Texas is 16-12 overall vs. the A.L. West, 10-6 on the road.

**VERSUS LEFTHANDERS:** The Rangers are facing lefthanded starters in each of the 1st 2 games of this series...Only one southpaw had started against the Rangers in the previous 22 games, Cleveland's T.J. House on 6/9 in Arlington...in their last 3 starts, lefthanders have allowed 21 runs/19 ER in 10.1 innings versus Texas, going 0-2 with a ND...the last LH starter to defeat the Rangers was Dallas Keuchel on 5/13 at HOU...overall, Texas is 9-10 in games started by opposing lefthanders, 6-3 on the road.

--Texas is batting .289 (183-633) against lefthanded pitching in 2014, the 2nd highest team average in the majors behind COL (.294)...the Rangers have a ML high .354 OBP vs. southpaws with the 2nd best slugging percentage at .444 (COL-.480).

--Alex Rios is tied with BAL's Nelson Cruz for the highest batting average vs. LHP among qualifying major leaguers at .429 (27-63).

**OFFENSIVE SURGE:** Texas matched its season high with 14 runs on Monday (5/4 at LAA), the 7th time it has been in double figures in 2014...the club's 16 hits last night were the most since 5/25 at DET (17) while the 4 homers were the highest total since 9/9/13 at TB (4)...the Rangers had not hit more than 2 HR in a game all year as the 69 contests without a 3+ HR game marked the team's 3rd longest such streak ever to begin a year: 1973 (122) and 1978 (83)...team produced just 6 runs and 19 hits total in the 3 games in SEA over the weekend...Texas has a .282 (235-832) average over last 24 games to improve from .257 to .266, 3rd highest in the majors to COL (.284) and DET (.275)...team has a .192 (28-146) AVG with RISP over the last 19 games beginning 5/27.

**POWER AT FIRST:** Rangers 1st basemen have connected for 3 home runs in the last 2 games after hitting just 5 in the season's 1st 68 contests...on Sunday, Brad Snyder hit his 1st major league homer in the 2nd inning to account for the Rangers' lone run...last night Donnie Murphy went deep twice for the 4th 2-HR game of his ML career, the 1st since 8/19/13 vs. WAS as a member of the Chicago Cubs...it was the 2nd 2-homer game of the season by a Ranger (Adrian Beltre on 6/4 vs. BAL) and the 1st multi-HR game by a Texas 1B since Mitch Moreland went deep twice on 5/14/13, also at OAK.

**BEHIND THE PLATE:** Robinson Chirinos was 3-for-5 with a homer and 3 RBI on Monday...he matched his career high for hits (3rd time, all in 2014) and had a season best for RBI...Chirinos has 2 HR and 5 RBI in last 2 games and 4 HR and 10 RBI in his last 8 games...he is tied for 3rd in A.L. for HR in June (4)...his 6 overall HR match Brian McCann for the 2nd most for an A.L. catcher, one behind Yan Gomes, Derek Norris, Salvador, Perez, and Mike Zunino...Chirinos is batting .357 (15-42) with 4 HR and 12 RBI over his last 12 G to rise from .198 to .248, best since 5/3 (.250)...he also leads qualifying ML catchers by throwing out 42.9% of runners trying to steal (15 of 35).

**ROOKIE PRODUCTION:** Michael Choice also has 4 homers in June after snapping an 0-for-16 drought with his 7th blast of the season on Monday...his last 3 and 4 of last 6 hits have been HR...Choice is T3rd with MIN's Josmil Pinto among A.L. rookies in HR behind CWS's Jose Abreu (19) and HOU's George Springer (12) and ranks 4th among A.L. rookies with 26 RBI...Rougned Odor had his 2nd game of 3+ hits on Monday and is batting .361 (22-61) with 12 RBI in last 19 games to rise from .179 to .303, 3rd best among ML rookies (75+ AB) behind MIN's Danny Santana (.340) and BOS's Brock Holt (.333).

**BY THE NUMBERS:** The Rangers lead the majors in both overall disabled list uses (20) and current players on DL (14)...the 20 DL uses are already most by the Rangers since 2010 (25) with the club record being 29 in 2004...Texas has used 41 players in 2014, tied for the most in MLB and has employed 23 pitchers (including Mitch Moreland), 2nd behind NYY (24)...Rangers have also used 11 rookies, T2nd in MLB (Stats, Inc.).

**THE CLOSER:** Joakim Soria has worked 7.2 scoreless innings with 7 saves in his last 8 games and has a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) in his last 21 appearances to drop season ERA from 7.20 to 1.80...he is 15-for-16 in save chances, converting the last 7 since blown save on 5/27 at MIN...Soria has converted all 14 career save chances vs. OAK and has held the A's to a .132 average (7-53) over his last 14 appearances against them...he has converted all 11 save tries with a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in 15 career games here at O.co Coliseum...Soria has pitched 14.0 scoreless innings in last 13 outings here beginning 5/17/07.

**RANGERS SIGN CARLOS PENA:** The Rangers have signed 1B Carlos Pena to a minor league contract and assigned him to Round Rock (AAA)...Pena, 36, is expected to be active either tonight or tomorrow...the RHB has a career .233 average with 285 home runs for TEX (2001), OAK (2002), DET (2002-05), BOS (2006), TB (2007-10, 2012), CHI (2011), HOU (2013), and KC (2013)...he went to spring training with LAA but was released on 3/23 and has not played in 2014.

**MINOR LEAGUE SIGNING:** The Rangers have signed the 24th round pick from the June 1st Year Player Draft, RHP Austin Pettibone from UC-Santa Barbara and assigned him to Spokane (Short Season A)...22 of the 40 total draft selections are under contract.

**SHORTS:** Yu Darvish's next strikeout will be the 600th of his major league career...Darvish brings a string of 12.0 consecutive scoreless innings into Tuesday's start...Colby Lewis earned his 49th win as a Ranger on Monday, tying Matt Harrison and Derek Holland for 12th all-time, one behind Doc Medich...3B Adrian Beltre moved from 4th to 2nd in the latest A.L. All-Star balloting results, trailing the A's Josh Donaldson...1B Mitch Moreland is being examined by orthopedist Dr. Ned Amendola in Iowa City, IA today to seek an additional counsel on the course of action for his injured left ankle...it is likely Moreland will require surgery and an extensive rehab period for his ankle injury.

**TEAM PITCHING:** Monday marked the 17th times this season, the Rangers have issued 8+ runs in a game, most in the majors...Texas permitted 28 hits and 13 runs in 17.0 innings in the last 2 games to lift the season ERA from 4.44 to 4.51, 2nd highest in the majors (COL-4.67)...staff had permitted just 3 runs in 27.0 innings in the previous 3 games...Texas has a 5.45 ERA (86 ER/142.0 IP) in last 16 games to rise from 4.22...club matched its season high with 23.0 consecutive scoreless innings from 6/10 (9th) thru 6/14 (4th)...the Rangers are 2nd in the majors in shutouts with 13 shutouts, one behind STL...the Rangers and Cardinals are only ML teams to record as many as 13 SHO in season's 1st 67 games since 1970 and 2 of 9 since 1914 to accomplish the feat...last A.L. club was CLE in 1968 (14 in 1st 57 games)...13 SHO are team's most since club record 19 in 2011 and are already T7th most all-time...Texas has ML-high .281 opp. avg. (next-highest: MIN-.271)...Texas' 4.35 road ERA ranks 11th in the A.L.

**STARTERS:** Colby Lewis permitted 5 runs in 5.1 innings on Monday after the rotation has allowed just 4 runs in 27.1 innings in the previous 4 games...streak of 4 straight quality starts. longest streak since 8/26-31/13 (5) ended last night...rotation has 5.16 ERA (39 ER/68.0 IP) over last 12 starts to rise from 4.36 to 4.50, 12 in A.L...starters worked 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings over 4 games, 6/10-14...club tops the A.L. in complete games (3)...opponents are hitting .328 (128-390) with 14 HR last 17 starts to rise from .276 to ML-high .288...rotation has issued ML high 152 BB.

**RELIEVERS:** The bullpen has allowed 18 runs in 22.1 innings in its last 6 games of work to go from 4.21 to 4.51, 13th in the league in relief ERA...has a 6.27 ERA (36 ER/51.2 IP) in its last 15 games to rise from 3.98...bullpen's .268 opp. avg. is highest in ML...bullpen has converted 16 of 25 save tries (64.0%), saves in 7 of last 9 wins...Rangers' 14 relief wins are 2nd in the A.L. (CLE-17).

**25 SCOTT BAKER** **0-1-0, 7.62** vs. LHB: 17-69 (.246) vs. RHB: 14-for-46 (.304)  
 Allowed a career-high 9 runs in 5.0 IP in last outing on 6/9 vs. CLE, 1st Texas reliever since Elizardo Ramirez, 6/4/08 vs. CLE...has struck out 7 batters in 2 of his last 3 relief app., most in a game since Ron Mahay (7), 8/18/03 at DET...2nd ML pitcher since 1998 with multiple 7-K relief apps. (MIN's Liam Hendriks, 2 in 2013)...is the 1st Texas pitcher with at least 3 relief appearances of 5.0+ IP since Jamie Moyer (3) in 1990...has gone at least 5.0 IP in 5 of his 6 appearances (2 starts of exactly 6.0 IP and 3 relief outings of 5.0+ IP)...has just 8 career relief outings...contract purchased for 2nd stint w/ Rangers on 5/14...pitched once in first stint w/ TEX (purchased 5/7, DFA'd 5/8, outrighted to Round Rock 5/11)...originally signed by Texas to minors contract on 3/28 and began season at Round Rock, going 4-1, 3.32 (14 ER/38.0 IP) in 6 starts...spent spring in Seattle's camp as a non-roster invitee but was released on 3/25.

**56 NEAL COTTS (L)** **2-3-0, 3.54** vs. LHB: 13-for-45 (.289) vs. RHB: 16-for-65 (.246)  
 Has worked 5.2 scoreless innings in his last 5 games and issued a run in just one of last 11 appearances (2 ER/10.1 IP)...has a 1.80 ERA (4 ER/20.0 IP) over last 22 games to drop season ERA from 7.88 to 3.54...has allowed runs in 6 of his team high 32 appearances...has current season-high 27-game homerless streak, 3rd-longest of career...is tied with OAK's Luke Gregerson for A.L. lead in blown saves (5)...is 1-for-9 in save chances with Texas in 2013-14...is 2-2, 4.91 (8 ER/14.2 IP) with 4 of 5 blown saves in 18 G on road, 0-1, 2.03 (3 ER/13.1 IP) in 14 G at home...has 12.2 scoreless IP with 15 K over last 10 G vs. OAK since start of 2013...has held OAK 4-for-42 (.095) in that stretch...was selected by OAK in the 2nd round of the 2001 draft.

**44 JASON FRASOR** **1-1-0, 1.50** vs. LHB: 7-for-36 (.194) vs. RHB: 8-for-47 (.170)  
 Has not allowed an ER (2 total runs) over last 10.1 innings (12 outings) to lower season ERA from 2.63 to 1.50, 9th-lowest among A.L. relievers...opened the season with 7.2 SHO innings in 1st 9 G...scoreless in 21 of 28 games in 2014...has a 1.84 ERA (12 ER/59.0 IP) in last 68 outings with the Rangers beginning 6/1/13...suffered first blown save on 5/14 at HOU, surrendering 2-run HR to George Springer...had not allowed a HR in previous 38 G (31.2 IP) dating to 2013, 2nd-longest streak in club history...has entered with the bases loaded 3 times and allowed 3 of 9 IR to score...has allowed runs in just 3 of last 20 G vs. OAK...has allowed one R in 6.1 IP over 9 G vs. OAK since start of 2013, holding OAK batters to 2-for-21 in that span.

**46 ROBBIE ROSS JR (L)** **2-4-0, 5.61** vs. LHB: 24-for-86 (.279) vs. RHB: 58-for-166 (.349)  
 Has issued 5 runs in just 1.1 innings in the last 2 games and allowed 9 hits and 8 runs in 3.1 innings in his last 4 outings to raise season ERA from 4.68 to season high 5.61...is 1-0, 9.00 ERA (12 ER/12.0 IP) in 9 appearances since move to bullpen, with opponents hitting .415 (22-53)...opened season in rotation and moved to bullpen on 5/20...was 1-4, 4.78 (26 ER/49.0 IP) over 9 starts...went 0-4 with a 6.97 ERA (24 ER/31.0 IP) final 6 starts...T7th in A.L. with 10 GIDP despite just 60.2 IP.

**39 BEN ROWEN** **0-0-0, 0.00** vs. LHB: 2-for-4 (.500) vs. RHB: 0-for-2 (.000)  
 Has pitched 2.0 scoreless innings in his 1st 2 big league appearances on SUN and MON...retired all 3 batters faced in the 8th inning (IR scored on SF) on Sunday in his ML debut...was recalled from Round Rock (AAA) on 6/11 after going 1-0 w/ 2 saves and 2.75 ERA (6 ER/19.2 IP) in 16 relief appearances w/ 2 BB and 14 SO for the Express...RHB hit just .196 (10-51)...did not allow a run in last 10 outings, totaling 12.1 SHO IP with a BB and 10 SO in that span...Rangers 2012 Minor League Reliever of the Year has gone 19-5 w/ 1.46 ERA and 0.967 WHIP figure over 159 career appearances in the minors, all in relief...was in major league camp with Rangers this spring, but did not appear in a game due to right biceps tendinitis.

**28 JOAKIM SORIA** **1-2-15, 1.80** vs. LHB: 10-for-52 (.192) vs. RHB: 3-for-38 (.079)  
 Has worked 7.2 scoreless innings with 7 saves in his last 8 games and has a 0.45 ERA (1 ER/20.0 IP) in his last 21 appearances to drop season ERA from 7.20 to 1.80, 14th in A.L....is 15-for-16 in save chances, converting last 7 since blown save on 5/27 at MIN, ending streak of 15 straight since previous blown save on 8/10/11 at TB...is T5th in A.L. in saves and is 3rd with 93.8 save pct...has **ML-best .079 (3-38) opp. avg. vs. RHB** (min. 30 AB by RHB) and has lowest lowest overall opponents BA (.144) among A.L. relievers...12 SO, 0 BB last 8 outings...his 11.33 K/BB ratio (34 K/3 BB) is 4th-best in majors (min. 20.0 IP)...has 175 career saves, 9th among active pitchers...did not allow a hit from 4/12-5/12, with Jed Lowrie (reached on error) only base runner...prior to this year, had not recorded a save since 9/11/11 at SEA...4 of his 6 runs allowed (and 4 of 5 ER) have been in non-save situations...has converted all 14 career save chances vs. OAK...has held OAK to a .132 average (7-53) over last 14 appearances...has converted all 11 save tries with a 1.15 ERA (2 ER/15.2 IP) in 15 career games at O.co Coliseum...has pitched 14.0 scoreless innings in last 13 outings here beginning 5/17/07.

**37 SHAWN TOLLESON** **2-1-0, 3.44** vs. LHB: 11-for-47 (.234) vs. RHB: 17-for-78 (.218)  
 Has allowed 3 runs in 3.0 innings in his last 4 appearances but has posted a 2.12 (4 ER/17.0 IP) in last 15 outings to lower season ERA from 4.86 to 3.44...opposing batters are 12-for-61 (.197) with 16 SO in that 15-game span...tied for A.L. relief lead in HR allowed (7)...runs in 11 of 28 G with 9 of 13 runs issued the result of 7 homers...has fanned 28 in 29.2 IP in last 22 G...has worked more than 1.0 inning 11 times with season-high 2.1 IP on 4/29 vs. OAK.

**TEAM BATTING:** Texas matched its season high with 14 runs on Monday (5/4 at LAA), the 7th time it has been in double figures in 2014...club's 16 hits were most since 5/25 at DET (17) while 4 homers were most in a game since 9/9/13 at TB (4)...club had not hit more than 2 HR in a game all year and 69 games without a 3+ HR game was team's 3rd longest streak to begin a year: 1973 (122) and 1978 (83)...club is batting .247 (67-271) over last 8 G but has a .282 (235-832) average over last 24 games to improve from .257 to .266, 3rd in the majors to COL (.284) and DET (.275)...rank among A.L. leaders in SH (1st, 25), INF hits (2nd, 69), hits (3rd, 626), and 3B (3rd, 15) but are tied with BOS for A.L. 2nd fewest HR (50) and have most GDP's (69) in MLB...is 3rd in SB (49) and 1st in CS (29) in A.L...Texas ranks 2nd in the ML with a .277 road batting average behind BAL (.279) and a .333 OBP behind LAD (.340)...the Rangers are 2nd among ML clubs with a .289 BA vs. LHP (COL-.294) and have the best OBP at .354..

**1 ELVIS ANDRUS** **.265 AVG, 2 HR, 17 RBI, .312 OBP, .349 SLG** **SHORTSTOP — R/R**  
**Mon.:** 2-for-5, 2B, RBI, 2 R, SH **Trip:** .333 (6-18), 2B, RBI, 3 R, 2 SB **Streak:** 7 G (.355, 11-31, 6 R, 2 2B, RBI, BB, 2 SB)

Has a 7-game hitting streak at .355 (11-31) and reached safely via H or BB in 23 of 26...is hitting .299 (47-157) over last 39 games since 5/4 to rise from .217 to .265, best since 4/23 (.271)...is 2-for-last-17 w/ RISP and .115 overall average is 2nd lowest among A.L. qualifiers...is among A.L. leaders in SB (5th, 16), SH (T3rd, 5), and CS (T4th, 4)...has a pair of 11-G hit streaks: May 4-14 and March 31-April 12...latter streak was 2nd-longest season-opening hit streak in club history (13 by Al Oliver, 1979)...has started 67 G at SS w/ 8 errors, 1 E last 40 G...one start at DH...is all-time club leader in steals (181)...is batting .338 (24-71) vs. LHP...is batting .169 (15-89) in 22 games vs. OAK since start of 2013.

**29 ADRIAN BELTRE** **.309 AVG, 8 HR, 34 RBI, .353 OBP, .488 SLG** **THIRD BASEMAN — R/R**
