OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have won 15 of their last 20 home games after losing six straight...with today's win, the A's are a season-high 16 games over .500...are 4-2 on this 10-game homestand against New York-AL (2-1), Texas (2-1) and Boston (four games).
- **Sonny Gray** is 8-2 with a 1.90 ERA (18 er in 85.2 ip) in 13 career appearances against the AL West compared to 4-4 with a 3.79 ERA against all other teams.
- **Sean Doolittle** has a 22.1 inning scoreless streak, which is a career-high.
- **Alberto Callaspo** (2 for 4) is 8 for 11 (.727) with two RBIs and two walks since being reinstated from the paternity list...was 1 for 28 over his final nine games before going on the PL last Friday.
- **Josh Donaldson** (2 for 4, rbi) has a 14-game hitting streak against Texas dating back to Sept. 3, 2013...is 19 for 54 (.351) with 11 runs, six doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI and seven walks during that streak...is the longest active hitting streak against the Rangers.
- **Derek Norris** (1 for 3, bb) is 7 for 14 (.500) with three doubles, two home runs and eight RBI over his last three games and is now batting .406 (13 for 32) in June.
- **Stephen Vogt** (0 for 3, rbi, 2 so) has a six-game hit streak snapped.

- The **Texas Rangers** have now dropped five of their last six meetings with Oakland, and nine of the last 13...are 3-3 on their three-city, nine-game trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (1-2) and Anaheim (three games).
- **Nick Tepesch** had a three-game win streak against AL West opponents snapped...is winless in last four starts, going 0-2 with a 5.93 ERA (12 er in 18.2 ip).
- **Shin-Soo Choo** (2 for 4, 2 rbi) snapped an 0 for 14 streak in the 4th inning...is 7 for 53 (.132) with 11 walks in his last 16 games.
- **Luis Sardinas** (1 for 3, so) has a career-best seven-game hitting streak, batting .409 (9 for 22) during that span.
