OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won four straight and six of their last seven...with tonight's win, have won 14 of their last 19 games against Boston after losing seven of the previous eight...the A's are a season-high 18 games over .500...are 6-2 on this 10-game homestand against New York-AL (2-1), Texas (2-1) and Boston (2-0).
- Brad Mills made his A's debut tonight, his first Major League start since 2012...was acquired from Milwaukee on Tuesday in a minor league trade for cash considerations.
- Sean Doolittle has a 23.1 inning-scoreless streak, which is a career-high.
- Yoenis Céspedes (1 for 2, r, 2 bb, so) is batting .328 (24 for 73) in 18 games in June after batting .245 over his first 52 games.
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 3, r, hr, 3 rbi, bb, sb) has hit safely in the each of his last six games (7 for 22, .318) since snapping his career-high 0-for-33 hitless streak.
- Craig Gentry (1 for 2, sb, hbp) is 10 for 25 (.400) over his last ten games after going 5 for 29 (.172) over his previous contests.

BOSTON NOTES

- The Boston Red Sox scored three runs...had scored two or fewer in each of the previous six games...are now 0-2 on their season-long tying 10-game roadtrip to Oakland (0-2), Seattle (three games), and New York-AL (three games)...are now 2-3 against Oakland this season.
- Felix Doubront is 1-2 with a 7.85 ERA (16 er/18.1 ip) in his career against the A's...struck out four tonight, surpassing Mickey Harris (369) for 13th place on the Red Sox' all-time strikeouts list among left-handers.
- Brock Holt (0 for 4, 2 so, hbp) has reached base safely in 26 of his 29 starts as Boston's lead-off hitter, going .322 (41-for-127) during that stretch.
- Mike Napoli (2 for 4, r, so) is batting .291 (14 for 48) with 2 HR since returning from the DL on June 8.
