OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics won on a walk-off for the fifth time this season...have won five straight and seven of their last eight...with today's win, have won 15 of their last 20 games against Boston after losing seven of the previous eight...the A's are a season-high 19 games over .500...are 7-2 on this 10-game homestand against New York-AL (2-1), Texas (2-1) and Boston (3-0)...The A's are 8-4 in extra-inning games this season, and 11-9 in one-run games.
- · Manager Bob Melvin was ejected from the game by HP umpire Quinn Wolcott in the 8th inning.
- Jesse Chavez did not allow a run in seven innings pitched...was previously 4-4 with a 3.75 ERA (20 er in 48.0 ip) in eight starts in May and June...allowed just three hits, the second-fewest he has allowed this season, and did not allow a hit until the sixth inning.
- Sean Doolittle has a 24.1 inning-scoreless streak, which is a career-high.
- Yoenis Céspedes (1 for 4) has hit safely in each of his last seven games...is batting .328 (25 for 77) in 19 games in June after batting .245 over his first 52
- Coco Crisp (1 for 5, so, rbi) hit his seventh career walk-off RBI, and second this year... is batting .373 (25 for 67) with 17 runs, six doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI and 12 walks over his last 19 games.
- Stephen Vogt (2 for 3, 3b, r, bb) is 12 for 29 (.413) with eight RBI over his last ten games after going 5 for 19 (.263) over his first six contests...hit his first triple since Aug. 31, 2013 (vs. Tampa Bay).

BOSTON NOTES

- The Boston Red Sox have lost three straight following a three-game win streak...have played eight consecutive games decided by two runs or less...are now 0-3 on their season-long tying 10-game roadtrip to Oakland (0-3), Seattle (three games), and New York-AL (three games)... are 2-4 against Oakland this
- Rubby De La Rosa made his first career apperance against the A's...allowed one earned run in seven innings pitched...was 0-2 with a 6.35 ERA (8 er in 11.1 ip) in three previous road starts this season...had a 10.2 scoreless-innings streak snapped in the 3rd.
- Brock Holt (3 for 4, bb) has reached base safely in 27 of his 30 starts as Boston's lead-off hitter, going .335 (44-for-131) during that stretch.
- Dustin Pedroia (1 for 5, r) is 7 for 24 (.292) over his last six games with two doubles, a home run and three RBIs.
