THE LATEST:
Yesterday, TOR won the series finale & the last game of their homestand, 7-4 in walk-off fashion vs. MilL, courtesy of an Edwin **Encarnacion** 3R-HR with two out in the 9th inning...TOR improved to **47-39** on the season with the victory...It was Toronto's **4**th walk-off victory of the year (**1**st since **June 24** vs. NYY)...It was the **1**st time TOR hit a walk-off HR since **Brett Lawrie** did it on **May 1, 2012** vs. TEX...Improved to 7-6 when the game is decided in the final at bat...When TOR is in a **tie after seven innings** this season, have posted a record of **8-1**...Recorded their **14**th come from behind win of the season & won for the **13**th time when the opposition strikes first (13-24)...Are now 15-13 in series finales this season, snapping a 4game losing streak in those affairs.

GETTING OUT THE BROOMS:

Swept a series (2-0 vs. MIL) for the 7th time this season (1st since June 3-5 at DET, 3-0)...It was their 1st series sweep at home since May 26-28 vs. TB (3-0), 4th overall at Rogers Centre this year...It was Toronto's 3rd 2-game sweep of the season (at PHI, vs. PHI).

Are looking to win **three** straight contests for the 1st time since a 6-game win streak from **May 31-June 6**...It marks just the 2nd time TOR has won back to back games since that point...Are looking to go **3-0** to start the month of **July** since **1992** (**8-0**)...Yesterday, marked just the **2**nd series victory for TOR over their last **eight** (**2-5-1**) since **June 6**...Since that point have posted a record of **10-15** & have been outscored 107-92 (-15 run differential)...Overall, have dropped nine of their last 15 & 13 of their last 21 games.

FROM THE TOP:

ROM THE TOP:

Have held sole possession of 1st place in the AL East for 42 consecutive days...The last time TOR has been alone in 1st place for this many days in a row occurred in 1993 (June 24-end of season)...The last time TOR was alone in 1st later than July 2 was on July 6, 2000 (46-40, 0.5 GA)...Currently own the 5th best winning% in the AL (.547, 47-39), OAK leads at .607 (51-33).

- ABOUT YESTERDAY:

 → J.A. Happ (7.0, 6H, 4ER, 4K) did not figure in a decision for the 1st time this year (12th start)...After allowing four runs after 3.0 IP of work, retired the next 12 of 13 batters, over 4.0 IP allowing just one base runner (bunt single)...It marked 2nd time this year he worked at least 6.0 IP without issuing a walk...In fact, has walked two batters
- or less in eight of his 12 starts this season.

 For the 2nd game in a row, Jose Bautista hit a HR in his 1st at bat of the game (HR #17 of the season).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

- Tonight, TOR begins a 10-game road trip with the opener of a 4-game series at OAK...Following the series with the A's, travel to Anaheim to take on the Angels (47-36) in a 3-game set...Enjoy an off-day on July 10 before concluding the road trip with a 3-game series at Tampa Bay (38-49)...This trip leads into the all-star break which will conclude the 1st half of the season.
- Are 22-18 on the road, having dropped five of their last six & seven of their last 10 contests...Prior to those last 10 games on the road, TOR had won six in a row & 11 of 12 games...Have lost back to back series (0-3 at NYY/1-2 at CIN) for the 1st time since April 29-BLUE JAYS vs. ATHLETICS
 All-Time: 182-207 May 3 (1-2 at KC/1-2 at PIT).

- TOR recorded a 3-game sweep of their previous meeting at Rogers Centre (May 23-25)...TOR allowed just five runs over those 3-games (outscored them, 11-5)...It was the 1st sweep of the A's in a series of **3-games or more** since **2003**...It was the **1**st time TOR won **three** straight games in a season since **2008** (six straight)...TOR has won **eight** of their last **12** meetings since **2012**...TOR has won **four** of their last **five** & **six** of their last **10** contests in Oakland.

KING OF THE YARD:

- Yesterday, Edwin Encarnacion hit the 3rd walk-off HR of his career (1st since Sept. 22, 2011 vs. LAA)...It was his 150th career HR as a Blue Jay, passing Lloyd Moseby for 7th on the all-time club list...It was his 26th HR of the season & is T-1st in the Majors with Nelson Cruz (BAL) & Jose Abreu (CWS)...Since 2012, no player has hit more HR than Edwin (104, two more than Miguel Cabrera)...His 26-HR prior to the break are the 6th most in club history, setting a career high. The club record for most HR prior to the break is 31 career high...The club record for most HR prior to the break is 31-HR set by **Jose Bautista** in **2011**. Prior to **May 1**, Edwin was batting .**250** with **2**-HR, **15**-RBI & a .**747**
- OPS in 27 games...Over his last 58 games since that point, is batting .296 with 24-HR, 54-RBI & a 1.082 OPS...Since May 1, leads the Majors in HR, RBI, SLG (.694), XBH (37), TB (150) & OPS (1.082).

EXTRA, EXTRA:

- Edwin Encarnacion leads the Majors with 49-XBH this season (three more than Mike Trout who ranks 2nd)...The 49-XBH prior to the break represents a career high & ranks T-5th most by a Blue Jay...Carlos Delgado (55-XBH in 2000) & Vernon Wells (55-XBH in 2003) own the club record for most XBH prior to the break.
- Edwin Encarnacion is riding a season high 10-game hit streak (.429, 15-35) & has hit safely in 15 of his last 17 games, batting .397 (25-63) with 5-2B, 6-HR, 15-RBI & 10-BB...Has reached base safely in **21** of his last **39** plate appearances.

GOING STRONG:

- Yesterday, **Jose Bautista** homered (#17) in the 1st inning in back to back contests, his 2nd start since suffering a mild right hamstring strain on **June 22** at CIN...The HR was his 121st prior to the all-star break as a Blue Jay...Only Carlos Delgado (187) & Vernon Wells (131) have hit more HR prior to the break as a Blue Jay.
- Jose has reached base safely in 74 of his 79 starts, having recorded a hit in 58 of those games...Has hit safely in 31 of his last 43 games since May 12 (.319, 8-2B, 8-HR, 26-RBI, 26-BB, .431 OBP, .973 OPS)...Despite missing six games from June 23-28, still leads the Majors with 60-BB...Among the AL, ranks 1st in OBP (.431), times on base (149), 4th in OPS (.970), 7th in SLG (.539) & T-9th in HR (17).

HEATING UP:
◆ Over his last eight contests, Jose Reyes is batting .368 (14-38) with 4-2B, 1-3B & 1-HR...Yesterday marked his 5th multi-hit game over that stretch...Among AL leadoff hitters, Jose ranks 1st in runs (45), 2B (18), XBH (27), 2nd in hits (76), SB (16) & TB (118).

YARD WORK:

TOR leads the Majors with 113-HR this season (eight more than BAL who rank 2nd)...Have homered in 11 of their last 13 contests (20 total)...Had hit just **9**-HR over the previous **13** games prior to that...Hit **3**-HR in yesterday's game for the **14**th time this year.

Yesterday, the Toronto Blue Jays signed **9**th overall selection **RHP Jeff Hoffman** & **11**th overall selection **C Max Pentecost**...This brings the total number of players signed from the 2014 First Year Player Draft to 27, including 10 picks from the top 10 rounds.

TONIGHT'S START & 2013/14 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is making his 12th career start (17th appearance) vs. the A's...Has thrown 6+ innings in all but five starts...ls 2nd fastest pitcher in MLB at 18.3 seconds between pitches behind teammate Buehrle at 16.9 seconds.
- Has allowed 13 HR over his last 44.1 IP...Has surrendered a home run in eight straight starts...Has lost three starts consecutively, however hasn't lost four straight in a single season since 2004...Did lose five straight starts from 9/30/05-6/18/08 a span of three seasons for him.
- Had a string of seven consecutive quality starts from 4/22-5/24
- Suffered the loss in his last start on June 27 vs. CWS (6IP/5ER/4HR)... Surrendered a season high 4-HR, 2nd time in his career to allow that many & 1st since a career high 6-HR on April 6, 2006 vs. DET...Lost his 3rd consecutive start, 1st time to have done that since July 6-21, 2013... Recorded his 1,000th career SO in the 3rd inning (Flowers).
- In innings 1-4 this season has an ERA of 2.25 (68IP/17ER)...From the 5th inning on his ERA jumps to 8.00 (36.0IP/32ER).
- Comes into today having walked 3.7 batters per nine innings this season, 4th highest total among AL starters... Had a career mark of 2.9 nine heading into the season... In fact over his last four seasons (2010-13) had walked just 2.4 per nine innings.
- June 14 at BAL left the game after 6.2 innings with a groin strain, took the loss falling 3-2, despite recording his 9th quality start...Was pushed back two days to rest groin in next start on June 22
- June 9 vs. MIN marked first time since 8/10-9/28/08 having three consecutive games with less than 6IP.
- Won his 5th game of the season & lowered his ERA to 3.95 in a 5-2 victory vs. OAK on May 24...Marked the 1st time in his TOR career to have an ERA under 4.00...The 8.1 IP set a season high & was his 7th consecutive quality start.
