 Tonight's game was played under protest...the last time the A's protested a game was 11 years ago today, July 3, 2003, in Oakland against Seattle...the Mariners were managed by Bob Melvin.

OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics beat the Blue Jays for the first time this season and the first time since Aug. 12, 2013...are 1-0 on this six-game homestand against Toronto (1-0) and San Francisco (two games).
- Sonny Gray allowed one run in seven innings pitched...was 2-2 with a 5.50 ERA (22 er in 36.0 ip) in his previous six starts.
- Yoenis Cespedes (0 for 4) had a 15-game hitting streak snapped...the streak was an A's season high.
- Brandon Moss (1 for 2, r, 2b, 2 bb) is batting .394 (13 for 33) with two home runs, seven RBI and four multiple hit games over his last eight games.
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 3, r, 2b) is batting .368 (21 for 57) with two home runs and 10 RBI over his last 19 games after hitting .263 with two RBI over his first six contests.

- The **Toronto Blue Jays** have dropped six of their last seven road games...are 0-1 on this 10-game road trip against Oakland (0-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Tampa Bay (three games).
- · R.A Dickey has lost four consecutive starts for the first time since 2004...did not allow a home run for the first time in nine starts.
- Jose Bautista (1 for 4) has reached base safely in 75 of his last 81 games this year.
- Edwin Encarnacion (1 for 4, so) has a 11-game hit streak, batting .421 (16-38) over those contests...has reached base safely in 64 of his last 76 games, recording a hit in 55 of them...has 19 doubles, one triple, 26 home runs and 69 RBI over that span.
- Adam Lind (1 for 3, 2b) is batting .345 (49 for 142) over his last 46 games...has reached base safely in 45 of his 57 contests this season.
