OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are now 14-6 over their last 20 games...are now 3-0 on this six-game homestand against Toronto (3-0) and San Francisco (two games).
- Scott Kazmir threw a season-high 113 pitches...won his tenth game of the season...it is the second time in his career he has won 10 games before the All-Star Break...the last time was 2006 when he went 10-6 before the break...is 5-0 with a 1.00 ERA (4 er in 36.0 ip) over his last five starts in Oakland.
- · Alberto Callaspo (2 for 4, r, 2b) snapped his 0 for 17 hitless streak with a single in the second inning.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 5, rbi) is batting .358 (38 for 106) with 24 runs, seven doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI and 17 walks over his last 29 games.
- · Jed Lowrie (2 for 4, r, 2b, rbi) now has 28 RBI in 47 career games against Toronto...that is his most against any team.
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his 19th home run of the season in the third inning...12 of his home runs have put the A's ahead.
- Derek Norris (1 for 4, 2 so) is batting .347 (17 for 49) with three home runs and 10 RBI over his last 16 games.
- Stephen Vogt (2 for 3, r, bb) is batting .375 (24 for 64) with two home runs and 10 RBI over his last 21 games after hitting .263 with two RBI over his first six contests.

TORONTO NOTES

- The **Toronto Blue Jays** have dropped eight of their last nine road games...snapped their 19-inning streak of not scoring when they scored a run in the first inning...are now 0-3 on their 10-game roadtrip to Oakland (0-3), Los Angeles-AL (three games), and Tampa Bay (three games).
- Mark Buehrle is 0-5 over his last five starts...has a 3.60 ERA (16 er in 40.0 ip) over the losing streak.
- Jose Bautista (1 for 4, 2b, so) has hit safely in 26 of his last 33 games...is batting .316 (36 for 114) with nineteen runs, eight doubles, five home runs, 19 RBI and 18 walks over that stretch.
- Edwin Encarnacion (0 for 1, rbi) came out of the game in the top of the first inning with right quadriceps soreness.
- Brad Glenn (1 for 2, bb) hit an infield single to second base in the top of the fifth inning to record his first major league hit...that snapped an 0 for 13 hitless streak to begin his major league career.
