THE LATEST

- Last night the Blue Jays lost 5-1 at Oakland and are now 0-3 on this ten game road-trip...Overall the club has lost five straight on the road dating back to June 21 at Cincinnati...It was the 13th time this season the team has been to one run scored or less (7th on the road) and third consecutive game...Yesterdays lone run came in the first inning snapped a stretch of 19.0 consecutive scoreless innings...It also represented the 51st time the Blue Jays have scored first to start a game this season and are not 34-17.
- It also was the fifth straight road loss for the club...As a result the Blue Jays are now 1.0 games back of the first place Orioles in the AL East...Toronto held sole possession of first place in the AL East for 42 consecutive days from May 22 to July 2 - longest stretch since
- 1993 (June 24- end of season, 90 days). TOR starters have worked at least **6.0** IP in **13** consecutive contests, posting an ERA of 3.04 (31ER/91.2) while holding opponents to a .213 AVG...However, have the team has won just five of the 13.

- AT THE PLATE: The Blue Jays scored just two runs in the last three games which is the fewest runs over any three consecutive game this season...In the three games have batted .186(19-102) with three doubles and seven walks...It is also the third time this year to go a season high **three** consecutive games without hitting a home run.
- In the last three games the club is hitless in 17 at bats with runners in scoring position.

EARLY JULY RESULTS:

- In July are batting .232(39-168) which is 11th in the AL while scoring
- the fewest runs in the AL at 13 tied with Oakland. On the mound the July the Blue Jays have allowed only one HR in 45.1 innings and post the **lowest ERA** in the league at 2.18 (11ER/45.1IP) after the first five games.

THIS & THAT:

- Have lost six of their last eight, nine of their last 14 & 12 of their last 18 contests...Including this series, have won just two of their last nine series (2-6-1) dating back to June 6...Since that point have posted a record of 10-18 & have been outscored 117-94 (-23 run differential)...Have batted just .194 (41-211) with RISP over that period...However, over that stretch since June 6, TOR starters have worked at least six innings in 21 of those 28 games and the staff overall has posted a 3.89 ERA 106ER/245.1IP).
- Jose Reyes now needs just 8 stolen bases to reach 450 for his career...Only 52 players have stolen 450 career bases in a career...Currently ranks **T6th in the AL** with 17 SB this season.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN:

- Today, TOR continues a **10**-game road trip with the finale to a **4**-game series at OAK...Following the game today the Blue Jays will travel to Anaheim to take on the Angels in a **3**-game set...Enjoy an off-day on July 10 before concluding the road trip with a 3-game series at Tampa Bay ...This trip leads into the **all-star break** which will conclude the **1**st half of the season.
- Are 22-21 on the road, having dropped five straight, eight of their last nine & ten of their last 13 contests...Prior to those last 13 games on the road, TOR had won six in a row & 11 of 12 games... Ar looking to avoid dropping six straight games on the road for the 1 .. Are time since a **7**-game losing streak from **Aug. 18-24, 2013**...Have lost three consecutive series back to back series (**0-3** at NYY/**1-2** at CIN/**0-3** plus today at OAK) for the **1**st time this season.

- Looking to avoid being swept by Oakland in a series for the first time since July 31- Aug. 2, 2000 (3 games)...The last time Toronto was swept in a four game series by the A's was May 22-24, 1981 in Oakland.
- Despite yesterday's loss, TOR has won **eight** of their last **15** meetings since **2012**...TOR has also won **four** of their last **eight** & six of their last 13 contests in Oakland.
- TOR recorded a 3-game sweep in their previous series at Rogers Centre (May 23-25)...TOR allowed just five runs over those 3-games (outscored them, 11-5)...It was the 1st sweep of the A's in a series of 3-games or more since 2003...It was the 1st time TOR won three straight games in a season since 2008 (six straight).

ED-WING GROUNDED:

- Edwin Encarnacion suffered a right quadriceps strain while running to first base yesterday in the first innings... He currently tied for 3rd in the Majors with 26-HR (Jose Abreu & Nelson Cruz-27)...Since 2012, no player in the Majors has hit more HR than Edwin-104 HR (Miguel Cabrera ranks 2nd with 102)...Has hit 150 career HR as a Blue Jay which ranks 7th on the all-time club HR list...His 26-HR prior to the break are the 6th most in club history, a career high...The club record for most HR prior to the break is 31-HR set by Jose Bautista in 2011.
- Prior to May 1, Edwin was batting .250 with 2-HR, 15-RBI & a .747 OPS in 27 games...Over his last 61 games since that point, is batting .290 with 24-HR, 55-RBI & a 1.058 OPS...Since May 1, leads the Majors in HR, RBI, SLG (.677), XBH (37* tied), TB (151) & OPS.
- He leads the Majors with 49-XBH this season (one more than Mike Trout & Paul Goldschmidt who ranks 2nd)...The 49-XBH prior to the break represents a career high & ranks T-5th most by a Blue Jay...Carlos Delgado (55-XBH in 2000) & Vernon Wells (55-XBH in 2002) and the second to 2003) own the club record for most XBH prior to the break

GOING STRONG: Jose Bautista has reached base safely in 77 of his 82 starts this season, having recorded a hit in 61 of those contests... Has hit safely in 34 of his last 46 games since May 12 (.312, 9-2B, 8-HR, 26-RB, 26-BB, .417 OBP, .939 OPS)...Despite missing six games from June 23-28, still leads the Majors with 60-BB...Among the AL, ranks 1^{st} in OBP (.423), times on base (152), 4^{th} in OPS (.952), 8^{th} in SLG (.529) & 10^{th} in HR (17).

ROSTER MOVE:

Today the Blue Jays will add OF Cole Gillespie to the 25-man roster after he was claimed on waivers yesterday from the Seattle Mariners...To make room on the 40-man roster **OF Kenny Wilson** was designated for assignment...A corresponding move to add him to the 25 man roster will be made prior to today's game...He will wear uniform #9.

TROUBLE ON THE LEFT:

TOR ranks last in the AL with a .230 batting average vs. LHP this season, despite posting a record of 12-12 when facing a left-handed starter (5-5 on the road)...Are batting just .143 (24-168) against LHP in last 13 contests.

YARD WORK:

TOR **leads the Majors** with **113**-HR this season (**six** more than BAL who rank 2nd)...The **113**-HR prior to the break currently ranks **T-8th** most in club history...Hit **115**-HR in the 1st **half** of **2013**...No team since **2010**, has hit more HR than TOR in the month of **July** with **137** (10 more than BAL/BOS who rank 2nd).

TONIGHT'S START & 2013/14 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Is making his 18th start of the season...Marks his 1st career start vs. the Athletics.
- Has a 2.23 ERA on the road, 5th in the AL...Last five road starts is 3-1 with a 1.36 ERA...His .244 opponents avg. leads the staff and ranks 17th in the AL..Has allowed 15 stolen bases against, 2nd most in the AL (Feldman-18).
- Struck out a career-high 10 batters in his last start vs. MIL, becoming just the second Blue Jays pitcher to fan at least 10 in a start (Buerhle, April 2 at TB)...The 7.0 innings is the most one earned run the least he has recorded at home this year...Has now limited the opposition to one earned run or less in seven of his 17 game starts...Earned his 6th quality start of the year.
- Over two consecutive starts vs. NYY (June 19/25) was dealt the loss in both, allowing 8ER in 10.1 IP...The two losses represent the 1st time in his career he had lost consecutive starts... Walked a career-high four (5th time, 2nd vs. NY) in 4.1 innings on June 19 at Yankee Stadium.
- Tossed seven shutout innings at BAL on June 13 in a 4-0 win...Was his 5th start on road without allowing a run, extending his streak of shutout innings on the road to 15.2 innings at the time.
- Did not receive a decision despite seven shutout innings at DET in his start on June 3...Team won 5-3 with all the scoring coming in the 9th inning...Allowed just three baserunners (3H/0BB), all singles...Was pitching on seven days rest.
- Won his 3rd straight start (5.0, 7H, 5ER, 4BB, 3HR) & improved to 4-3 in a 10-5 win vs. TB on May 26...Is the 1st Jay to win a game when allowing 3-HR since Brandon Morrow on May 23, 2013 vs. BAL...Is the 1st Jay to win a game when issuing at least 4-BB without recording a SO since Aug. 19, 1997 vs. CWS (Chris Carpenter)...In fact, it marks the 1st time since April 19, 1948 (Phil Marchildon – 3HR, 5-BB, 0-SO) that any starter in the Majors won a game when allowing 3-HR while issuing at least 4-BB with 0-SO.
