OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won 10 of their last 11 home games, and 23 of their last 29...the A's are 8-1 in interleague play this season (Washington, 3-0; New York, 1-1; Miami, 3-0; San Francisco, 1-0)...have won 10 of their last 12 home contests against the Giants...the A's are a season-high 23 games over .500.
- Jesse Chavez struck out nine, which ties a career-high (twice, April 4, 2014 at Minnesota and April 14, 2014 at Los Angeles-AL)...allowed no runs in six innings pitched..was 2-4 with a 4.08 ERA (21 er in 46.1 ip) in his previous eight starts...the A's are 13-5 in his starting assignments.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 3, 2 bb, sb) is batting .358 (39 for 108) with 24 runs, seven doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI and 19 walks over his last 31 games...
- Craig Gentry (1 for 3, r, so, hbp) has been successful in each of his 16 stolen base attempts this year...now has a streak of 28 consecutive steals without a caught stealing dating back to Aug. 14 of last year.
- Jed Lowrie (2 for 4, r) has collected multiple hits in three consecutive games for the first time this season...has multiple hits in six of his last ten games, hitting .310 (13 for 42) over that span.
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 4, 2b, so) has hit safely in his last eight games (12 for 28, .428)...this streak ties a career-high (Aug. 23-Sept. 5, 2013).

- The **San Francisco Giants** have lost 10 of their last 12 games in Oakland...are 7-19 in their last 26 games after going 42-21 in their first 63 games...are 2-2 on this five-game road trip to San Diego (2-1) and Oakland (0-1).
- Ryan Vogelson had a streak of 18.2-consecutive scoreless frames in interleague play snapped in the 5th inning.
- Joaquin Arias (2 for 3) had his second multi-hit game of the season, and his first since June 1st, 2014 against St. Louis.
- Brandon Crawford (1 for 3, so) committed a career-high tying two errors (third time, last; Sept. 26, 2012 against Arizona).
- Michael Morse (1 for 4) is 18 for 52 (.346) with five home runs in 16 career games at O.co Coliseum.
- Hunter Pence (0 for 3, so, bb) had an 11-game hit streak snapped.
- Buster Posey (1 for 3, bb) has hit safely in 27 of his 31 games, batting .333 (39 for 117) over that span.
