GIANTS BLANKED...AGAIN

- For the ninth time this season and the fourth time in the past eight games, the Giants were shut out last night by the A's, losing 5-0 in the opener of this four game home-and-home series...the Giants have lost eight of their last 11 games and 19 of their past 26...beginning June 9, SF is tied with Texas for the worst record in the Majors at 7-19 (.269).

TONIGHT'S PITCHING MATCHUP

- Will feature 2014 All-Star **Madison Bumgarner** (9-6, 3.09) against **RHP Sonny Gray** (8-3, 3.08)...Bumgarner has lost each of his last two starts, allowing 10 runs (9er) on 15 hits in 11.0 innings...however, he enters tonight's outing with a five-game road winning streak, going 5-0 with a 1.05 ERA (5er, 43.0ip) in his past six road outings...Gray, who will face the Giants for the first time in his career, has gone 2-0 with a 3.79 ERA in his past three starts.

GIANT STRUGGLES IN AMERICAN LEAGUE PARKS

- The Giants have lost 12 of 14 road games against the American League, dating back to June 24, 2012, including four straight to Oakland.

TOUGH PLACE TO PLAY

- Dating back to the 2010 season, the Giants have lost 10 of their last 12 games here at O.co Coliseum, having been outscored by a 52-26 margin.

MAGIC NUMBER IS FIVE

- San Francisco is 30-4 when scoring five or more runs this season (19-36 when scoring fewer than five runs).

FIVE-GAME HOMESTAND STARTS TOMORROW

- The Giants will begin a five-game homestand tomorrow, with two games against the A's and then a three-game series against the D-Backs that will conclude the first half...after going 22-9 in their first 31 home games, the Giants have really struggled at AT&T Park as of late, winning just three of their past 17 games.

WITH RUNNERS IN SCORING POSITION

- The Giants have been held to two hits or fewer with runners in scoring position in each of their last 11 games, going just 8-for-60 (.133) in this stretch.

ON THE ROAD

- The Giants are 24-17 (.585) on the road, the third-best road record in the NL behind the Dodgers (29-17, .630) and Brewers (28-19, .596).

WE NEED SOME SUPPORT

- In the last 11 games, Giants starting pitchers are averaging 1.77 runs of support per game (14 runs/11 games)...they've received just six runs of support in the last six games.

ABOVE AND BELOW

- San Francisco has gone 28-20 against opponents with a record of .500 or better and 21-20 against opponents below .500.

IN THE 'PEN

- Giants relievers have combined to allow 21 runs (19er) on 40 hits in 32.2 innings (5.29 ERA) in their past 12 games...opponents are hitting .310 off SF relievers during this span.

JUST SCORE FIRST

- SF is 36-11 when they score the game's first run and 13-29 when they don't score first.

ADRIANZA AND SCUTARO REHAB UPDATES

- **IF Ehire Adrianza** (right hamstring strain) has made five rehab starts with triple-A Fresno, hitting .286 (4-for-14) with a home run.
- **IF Marco Scutaro** (lower back strain) was transferred from the AZL Giants to triple-A yesterday and went 1-for-3 with an RBI in his first game, playing 5.0 innings...overall, he's gone 3-for-15 (.200) with a double and RBI in seven rehab games between the two teams.

THIS DATE IN GIANTS HISTORY

July 8, 1970 - **Jim Ray Hart** hit for the cycle within 5.0 innings in a 13-0 win at Atlanta...he capped his performance with a three-run HR off Phil Niekro and a bases loaded triple in the Giants' 11-run 5th.

2014 SEASON

- 24-year-old left-hander will make his 19th start of the season...the two-time All-Star (2013, 2014) has gone 9-6 with a 3.09 ERA in 18 starts, with the Giants going 10-8 in his outings (7-2 on the road and 3-6 at home).
- Was selected to his second consecutive All-Star team this past Sunday as he finished fourth on the player ballot, behind Johnny Cueto, Adam Wainwright and Clayton Kershaw...however, he won't be eligible to pitch because he's starting the Sunday before the break...he didn't pitch in the ASG last season either, as Buchy held him back for long relief.
- Is tied for fifth in the NL with nine wins.
- His 120 strikeouts are the fourth-most in the league behind Stephen Strasburg (140), Johnny Cueto (130) and Ian Kennedy (125)...is averaging 9.50 strikeouts per 9.0 innings, the fourth-high figure in the league.
- Suffered his second-straight loss in his last start on Thursday against the Cardinals in the Giants' 7-2 loss at AT&T Park...worked 5.0 innings, allowing five runs (4er) on six hits.
- Has now surrendered 10 runs (9er) in his last two starts (11.0ip) and has gone 1-4 with a 4.09 ERA (15er, 33.0ip) in his past five outings.
- His record on the road is much better this season than at home, as he's 6-1 with a 1.32 ERA (9er, 61.1ip) in nine road starts compared to a 3-5 mark with a 5.16 ERA (30er, 52.1ip) in nine starts at AT&T Park.

OAKLAND:** Is 3-5 with a 2.11 ERA in 10 starts (nine quality starts)...after going 1-4 with a 3.38 ERA in his first five starts versus Oakland, has gone 2-1 with a 0.95 ERA in his past five outings.
