Friday, July 18, 2014 • Game #95 • Road Game #46 Baltimore Orioles (52-42) vs. Oakland Athletics (58-36) RH Chris Tillman (7-5, 4.11) vs. RH Jeff Samardzija (1-1, 2.40)

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the opening game of their three-game set, and the O's first game of a 10-game west coast swing that will also see the Birds face the Angels (three games) and Mariners (four)...The O's closed the first half with a series win over the Yankees, their three consecutive three-game series win over the New York this season...**The Orioles are 10-3 since June 30 and entered the All-Star break in sole possession of first place in the AL East (52-42, +4.0) for the first time since 1997 (55-30, +7.0 that year).**

<u>ALL-STARS</u>: Nelson Cruz (0-for-2 as DH), **Adam Jones** (0-for-2, 2 putouts in CF), and **Matt Wieters** (did not play due to injury but voted starting CA) represented the O's at the 2014 All-Star Game as elected starters...Jones also participated in the Home Run Derby for the first time in his career and hit four first round blasts before bowing out to eventual champion **Yoenis Cespedes**, 9-3, in round two...He was pitched to by current Orioles bullpen catcher/batting practice pitcher **Jett Ruiz**.

VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles trail in the season series, 1-2...The O's won last year's season series, 5-2, going 2-1 at home and 3-1 in Oakland...It was the O's first season series victory over the A's since 1998...The O's trail in the all-time series, 251-253, going 122-128 in Baltimore and 129-125 out west.

BEST VS. THE WEST: The O's are 11-6 against the AL West this season, and their .647 winning percentage is the highest by any American League club against the West (Detroit is second at .593).

ON-BASE MACHINE: Manny Machado has reached base safely in a career-high tying 16 straight games (also May 8-26, 2014) since June 22 (.410/.455/.721)...In his last 36 games since May 31, Machado is batting .317/.362/.532, raising his season average from .210 to .270...Machado recorded multiple hits in four straight games, July 5-9, the second longest streak of his career (five, June 12-16, 2013).

STRONG STARTS: In 33 games since June 9, the O's rotation has posted a 3.18 ERA (198.0IP, 70ER), chopping a half of a run off the starter's ERA and lowering it from 4.61 to 4.09 for the season.

<u>DIVISION DYNAMOS</u>: The Orioles own the highest in-division winning percentage in the American League (26-18, .591 vs. AL East)...The O's are also tied with Seattle for most in-division wins in the AL (26).

BALTIMORE BOMB SQUAD: The Orioles have hit 114 home runs this season and trail only Toronto (116) for the major league lead...The Birds are on pace to hit 196 home runs...**Since June 1, the Orioles have hit a major league leading 60 homers, 16 more than second place Houston and Detroit (44)**...From June 21-July 2, the Orioles homered in 12 consecutive games, their longest such streak since they homered in 13 straight games from August 1-16, 2013...The 12-game homer streak was the second-longest in the majors this year (Oakland, 16).

<u>MAKING THEM COUNT:</u> Chris Davis's home run on Sunday night was the 41st go-ahead homer of the season for the O's...Davis is third on the club with six go-ahead blasts, behind **Nelson Cruz's** team-leading eight and **Adam Jones**'s seven (Steve Pearce ranks fourth, with five).

<u>ONE AWAY</u>: Nelson Cruz is one RBI away from collecting his sixth consecutive season of 20+ home runs and 75+ RBI...Nick Markakis is one double shy from collecting 20+ two-baggers in nine consecutive seasons...He would be the sixth player in franchise history to have nine or more 20+ double seasons, joining Cal Ripken, Jr. (17), Brooks Robinson (14), Eddie Murray (12), and Brady Anderson and Paul Blair (nine each).

<u>CRUZ CRUSHING</u>: Nelson Cruz has 28 home runs, bypassing his season total from last season (27 in 109 games) and is on pace for 48 longballs...His career high is 33 (2009)...Cruz's 28 homers before the All-Star break were the third-most in Orioles history behind Chris Davis (37 in 2013) and Brady Anderson (30 in 1996).

ZACH ATTACK: Zach Britton's stretch of 31.1 consecutive scoreless innings at home is an Orioles club record...His stretch of 23 straight scoreless home appearances is the second-longest streak in club history, trailing only Brian Matusz (27 appearances - June 16, 2013-May 25, 2014; 19.0 scoreless innings).

O'DEALING: **Darren O'Day** has struck out at least one batter in each of his last eight outings, establishing a season-high for an Orioles reliever...He has not allowed a run in his last 10 outings (11.0IP), striking out 14, while walking just two (one intentional)...His 1.11 ERA leads American League relievers.

<u>GONE HUNTING</u>: Tommy Hunter has not allowed an earned run in his last 10 appearances (12.1 IP), matching his career-long streak...He is 3.1 innings away from the longest scoreless streak of his career (15.2 IP) which he achieved in the previous 10 game scoreless streak, April 12-May 12, 2013.

<u>SLUGGING STEVE</u>: Steve Pearce has a career-high 11 homers and 31 RBI this season...It took Pearce 46 games (150 AB) to hit 10 homers this year...He needed 192 games (488 AB) to hit his first 10 big league homers.

WORTH THE WAIT: The Orioles are 9-3 in extra innings games this year and have won four straight games in extras...The Birds were 8-7 in extra innings in 2013 after going 16-2 in 2012...**Since the start of the 2012 season, the Birds are 33-12 in extra innings contests**...In games that have gone 12 or more innings since the start of 2012, the Orioles are 13-4 (14-5 including the 2012 postseason).


<u>GOOD CELEBRATION:</u> Manny Machado collected a career-high five hits on July 7 after turning 22 the day before, becoming the youngest Oriole with a five-hit game since **Cal Ripken**, Jr. (21.363), August 22, 1982.

EXTRA: EXTRA: Per *Elias*, on July 7 at Washington, **Chris Davis** and **J.J. Hardy** became the first O's teammates to hit back-to-back homers in extra innings since **Frank Robinson** and **Boog Powell** did it in the 11th inning on June 3, 1969 at Oakland...**Davis has been involved in all three sets of back-to-back homers for the Birds this year**...Per *STATS*, the six-run 11th inning on Monday tied the O's franchise record for most runs scored in a single extra inning, done three times previously (4/16/12 @CWS, 6/25/70 @BOS, and 7/19/60 @OAK)...Per home run historian *David Vincent*, the Orioles became just the fifth team in baseball history to hit three home runs in the same extra inning (also KC 5/31/02, SF 8/7/01, MIL 6/8/65, and MIN 5/2/64).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: LH Wei-Yin Chen will make his 19th start of the season, his eighth on the road, where he has gone 4-1 with a 4.58 ERA (37.1IP, 19ER) this season...In four career starts against Oakland, Chen is 3-0 with a 1.00 ERA (27.0IP, 3ER), eight walks and 25 strikeouts...In his lone career start in the Coliseum, Chen tossed a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings and earned the win, April 26, 2013.

QUICK HITS: Making his 21st start of the season and 12th on the road...Made his first career Opening Day start on March 31 vs. Boston...Led the 2013 Orioles in wins (16), innings (206.1), and strikeouts (179)...His 16 wins in 2013 equaled his career total from his first four years in the majors...Made his MLB debut July 29, 2009 vs. Kansas City and recorded his first MLB win August 14, 2009 vs. Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim.

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Is making his fourth career start against the Athletics...Is 1-0 with a 1.96 ERA (18.1IP, 4ER) in his three starts...Is 1-0 with a 2.61 ERA (10.1IP, 3ER) at O.co Coliseum against the A's...Last start against A's at Oriole Park August 24, 2013 (ND, 8.0IP, 3H, ER, 2BB, 9K)...His nine strikeouts match a career-high.

LAST START: Started July 12 against the Yankees...Posted his 11th Quality Start (L, 6.2IP, 7H, 3ER, 3BB, 4K)...Orioles lost 3-0.

AT ORIOLE PARK: Is 1-5 with a 2.89 ERA (56.0IP, 18ER) with five Quality Starts in nine starts in Baltimore this season...He is 17-15 with a 4.02 ERA (291.0IP, 130ER) and 28 Quality Starts in 50 starts at OPACY and the Birds are 29-21 in those games...Has not allowed more than three earned runs in any of his nine home starts this season.

ON THE ROAD: Is 6-0 with a 5.20 ERA (62.1IP, 36ER) with six Quality Starts in 2014...In 54 career road starts, is 22-15 with a 4.47 ERA (300.1IP, 149ER) and 25 Quality Starts...The O's are 29-25 in his 54 road starts...**Tillman has allowed three or fewer earned runs in 27 of his last 35 road starts dating back to July 4, 2012.**

<u>CENTURY MARK:</u> He became the 28th player in club history to start 100 games as an Oriole with his June 22 start in New York against the Yankees.

ZEROS: On June 15 vs. Toronto, Tillman turned in the sixth start in club history of at least 7.0 innings without recording a walk or strikeout...It is the first since **Jimmy Key**, May 12, 1997 vs. Oakland (7.2IP)...**Jeff Ballard** is the only pitcher in club history to make two such starts (August 7 and 21, 1989 – 7.0 and 9.0 innings, respectively).

SHORT, BUT NO LOSS: Tillman has two starts this year with 1.0 inning or less and five or more earned runs, without receiving a loss...**Mike Flanagan** owns the Orioles' single-season record of starts of 1.0 innings or less and five or more earned runs, making three such starts in 1992.

TAKE TWO: Tillman allowed 14ER over two consecutive starts from May 21 (at Pittsburgh) to May 26 (at Milwaukee) over a combined 6.2 innings...It was the highest total he had allowed in a two-game span in his career.

DON'T EVEN TRY: Last season, Tillman allowed only one stolen base in 33 starts all year...In 2014, only **Carlos Gomez** has tried to run on Tillman (May 26) and was thrown out by **Nick Hundley...Jimmy Paredes** was the last player to steal a base (second base) off of Tillman, back on June 4, 2013.

<u>COMPLETE WIN</u>: In his start on May 16 in Kansas City, Tillman tossed his first career complete game shutout and second career complete game...Allowed five hits, walked one and struck out three over 9.0 scoreless innings...Threw 117 pitches (77 strikes).

ROUGH START: Threw 49 pitches in the top of the first inning against the Pirates on May 1... According to *Elias*, he was also the last Oriole to throw 49 or more pitches in an inning (July 16, 2012 at Minnesota in a 19-7 loss)...His 0.2 IP in that game marked the shortest start of his career.

ALL-STAR SELECTION: Was added to the 2013 American League All-Star team by **Jim Leyland**, but did not appear in the game...Was the first Orioles starting pitcher to make an All-Star team since **Mike Mussina** in 1998...Was 11-3 with a 3.95 ERA (111.2IP, 49ER) in 19 starts before the break.

HERE TO STAY: In 68 starts since being recalled from Norfolk (AAA) on July 4, 2012, Tillman is 32-15 with a 3.66 ERA (410.2IP, 167ER)...His 32 wins since July 4, 2012 are 2nd-most in the AL behind **Max Scherzer** (41)...Tillman had been optioned to the minors six times during the season & twice at the end of spring training from the time he made his debut in July of 2009 until July of 2012.

IF YOU'RE GOING TO GIVE THEM UP...: Tillman has allowed 86 home runs in his career (57 solo shots)...The Rays' **Evan Longoria** has hit five homers off Tillman, the most by any one opponent.
