OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics won on a walk-off for the 7th time this season...have won nine of their last 12 games and 12 of their last 13 home contests....are 1-0 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (1-0) and Houston (three games)...tonight's win guarantees at least a season series tie with Baltimore...the A's have lost the season series to Baltimore just once since 1998 (2013, 2-5).
- **Jeff Samardzija** is 1-1 with a 3.27 ERA (8 er in 22.0 ip) in three starts with the A's...is winless in ten starts at night this season and has a 0-4 record...has an 12-start winless streak at night dating back to last year (last: Aug. 24, 2013 at San Diego).
- Yoenis Cespedes (2 for 4) snapped an 0 for 19 hitless streak with a single in the 1st inning...this was the longest hitless streak of his career (previous: 16, May 8-12, 2013).
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 4, r, hr, 3 rbi) hit his second walk-off home run of the season, and third of his career.
- Derek Norris (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his ninth home run of the season in the 5th inning, which ties a career-high (nine, 2013)...the home run came in his 71st game...last season, he hit nine home runs in 98 games.
- John Jaso (1 for 4, 2b, rbi) is batting .304 (21 for 69) over last 21 games...is 4 for 14 (.286) with three doubles and five RBI in four games against Baltimore.
- Jed Lowrie (0 for 3) had a nine-game hitting streak snapped...this streak matched the second longest of his career (12, Aug. 18-30, 2013).

- The Baltimore Orioles are 0-1 on this 10-game west coast road trip against Oakland (0-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (four games).
- Chris Tillman is 6-0 with a 4.95 ERA (38 er in 69.0 ip) on the road this season and 1-5 a 2.89 ERA (18 er in 56.0 ip) at home...is 1-0 with a 2.16 ERA (6 er in 25.0 ip) in four career starts against the Athletics.
- J.J. Hardy (2 for 3, 2 r, hbp) is batting .296 (71 for 240) with two home runs and 22 RBI against RHP compared to .244 (22 for 90) with oen home run and four RBI against LHP.
- · Caleb Joseph (0 for 2, hbp) has reached base safely in six straight games and eight of his last nine.
- Manny Machado (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi) has reached base in a career-best 17 straight games.
