Baltimore Orioles (52-43) vs. Oakland Athletics (60-36)

LH Wei-Yin Chen (9-3, 4.15) vs. RH Jason Hammel (0-1, 3.60)



TONIGHT'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the middle game of their three-game set, and the O's second game of a 10-game west coast swing that will also see the Birds face the Angels (three) and Mariners (four)...The O's dropped last night's road trip opening game, after closing the first half with a series win over the Yankees, their third consecutive three-game series win over the New York this season...The Orioles are 10-4 since June 30 and are 4.0 games up on New York and Toronto for the AL East lead.

VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles trail in the season series, 1-3, going 1-2 in Baltimore and 0-1 in Oakland...Per *STATS*, in the 11 games between the O's and A's dating back to 2013, the Orioles have been tied or leading after seven innings in 10 of the 11 games, but are just 6-5...The Birds have led after seven innings in three of the four games this season...The O's won last year's season series, 5-2, (2-1 at home and 3-1 in Oakland)...**It was the O's first season series victory over the A's since 1998**...The O's trail in the all-time series, 251-254 (122-128 in Baltimore and 129-126 away).

ON-BASE MACHINE: Manny Machado has reached base safely in a career-high 17 straight games since June 22, batting .415/.457/.754...In his last 37 games since May 31, Machado is batting .322/.366/.552, raising his season average from .210 to .274...Machado recorded multiple hits in four straight games, July 5-9, the second longest streak of his career (five, June 12-16, 2013).

BALTIMORE BOMB SQUAD: The Orioles have hit 116 home runs this season and trail only Toronto (117) for the major league lead...The Birds are on pace to hit 198 home runs...**Since June 1, the Orioles have hit a major league leading 62 homers, 18 more than the next closest teams (Cleveland, Houston, and Detroit - 44 each)**...From June 21-July 2, the Orioles homered in 12 straight games, their longest such streak since they homered in 13 straight games, August 1-16, 2013.

MAKING THEM COUNT: Jonathan Schoop and Manny Machado each hit go-ahead two-run homers in last night's game, the 42nd and 43rd go-ahead blasts for the O's this season...The Birds' 43 go-ahead homers rank second in the majors behind the White Sox (48)...Kansas City (19) has hit the fewest...Nelson Cruz leads the O's with eight such homers, Adam Jones is second with seven, and Chris Davis ranks third with six.

ONE AWAY: Nelson Cruz is one RBI away from collecting his sixth consecutive season of 20+ home runs and 75+ RBI...Nick Markakis is one double shy from collecting 20+ two-baggers in nine consecutive seasons...He would be the sixth player in franchise history to have nine or more 20+ double seasons, joining Cal Ripken, Jr. (17), Brooks Robinson (14), Eddie Murray (12), and Brady Anderson and Paul Blair (nine each).

BEST VS. THE WEST: The O's are 11-7 against the AL West this season, and their .611 winning percentage is the highest by any American League club against the West (Detroit is second at .593).

STRONG STARTS: In 34 games since June 9, the O's rotation has posted a 3.17 ERA (204.2IP, 72ER), chopping more than half of a run off the starter's ERA, lowering it from 4.61 to 4.07 for the season.

DIVISION DYNAMOS: The Orioles own the highest in-division winning percentage in the American League (26-18, .591 vs. AL East)...The O's are also tied with Seattle for most in-division wins in the AL (26).

CRUZ CRUSHING: Nelson Cruz has 28 home runs, bypassing his season total from last season (27 in 109 games) and is on pace for 48 longballs...His career high is 33 (2009)...Cruz's 28 homers before the All-Star break were the third-most in Orioles history behind Chris Davis (37 in 2013) and Brady Anderson (30 in 1996).

GONE HUNTING: Tommy Hunter has not allowed an earned run in his last 11 appearances (13.2 IP), setting a new career-long streak...He is 2.0 innings away from the longest scoreless streak of his career (15.2 IP) which he achieved in a then career-best 10 game scoreless streak, April 12-May 12, 2013.

O'DEALING: Darren O'Day has struck out at least one batter in each of his last eight outings, establishing a season-high for an Orioles reliever...He has not allowed a run in his last 10 outings (11.0IP), striking out 14, while walking just two (one intentional)...His 1.11 ERA leads American League relievers.

ZACH ATTACK: Zach Britton's stretch of 31.1 consecutive scoreless innings at home is an Orioles club record...His stretch of 23 straight scoreless home appearances is the second-longest streak in club history, trailing only Brian Matusz (27 appearances - June 16, 2013-May 25, 2014; 19.0 scoreless innings).

ALL-STARS: Nelson Cruz (0-for-2 as DH), Adam Jones (0-for-2, 2 putouts in CF), and Matt Wieters (did not play due to injury but voted starting CA) represented the O's at the 2014 All-Star Game as elected starters...Jones also participated in the Home Run Derby for the first time in his career and hit four first round blasts before bowing out to eventual champion Yoenis Cespedes, 9-3, in round two...He was pitched to by current Orioles bullpen catcher/batting practice pitcher Jett Ruiz.

WORTH THE WAIT: The Orioles are 9-3 in extra innings games this year and have won four straight games in extras...The Birds were 8-7 in extra innings in 2013 after going 16-2 in 2012...**Since the start of the 2012 season, the Birds are 33-12 in extra innings contests**...In games that have gone 12 or more innings since the start of 2012, the Orioles are 13-4 (14-5 including the 2012 postseason).

SLUGGING STEVE: Steve Pearce has a career-high 11 homers and 31 RBI this season...It took Pearce 46 games (150 AB) to hit 10 homers this year...He needed 192 games (488 AB) to hit his first 10 big league homers.

EXTRA, EXTRA: Per *Elias*, on July 7 at Washington, Chris Davis and J.J. Hardy became the first O's teammates to hit back-to-back homers in extra innings since Frank Robinson and Boog Powell did it in the 11th inning on June 3, 1969 at Oakland...**Davis has been involved in all three sets of back-to-back homers for the Birds this year**...Per *STATS*, the six-run 11th inning on Monday tied the O's franchise record for most runs scored in a single extra inning, done three times previously (4/16/12 @CWS, 6/25/70 @BOS, and 7/19/60 @OAK)...Per home run historian *David Vincent*, the Orioles became just the fifth team in baseball history to hit three home runs in the same extra inning (also KC 5/31/02, SF 8/7/01, MIL 6/8/65, and MIN 5/2/64).

TOMORROW'S STARTER: RH Kevin Gausman will make his eighth start of the season, his third on the road, where he has gone 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA (11.1IP, 1ER) this season...In his only career start against the A's, Gausman earned the win, allowing one earned run in 7.0 innings on June 7 at Oriole Park...In his most recent start, Gausman earned a rain-shortened complete game victory over the Yankees on July 13 (5.0IP, ER).

How Acquired: January 10, 2012; signed by the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent to a three-year contract with a club option for 2015



QUICK HITS: Making his 19th start of the season and eighth on the road...Name pronounced Way-In...First Taiwanese-born player in Orioles history...Named to *Baseball America's* 2012 All-Rookie Team...His 12 wins in 2012 were the most by an O's rookie since **Daniel Cabrera** won 12 in 2004 and the most by an Oriole pitcher since **Erik Bedard** won 13 in 2007...Missed 2006-07 seasons in Japan after having "Tommy John" surgery...Married to **Yi-Wen Tsai** (E-ewen sigh)...They have a son, **Karsten** (11/12/12).

CHEN VS. OAKLAND: Is making his second start this season and fifth of his career against the Athletics...In four career starts against the Athletics, is 3-0 with an 1.00 ERA (27.0IP, 3ER)... Set MLB career-high with 8.0 innings of work in his only career start at O.co Coliseum on April 26, 2013...Last faced the club June 6 at Oriole Park (ND, 6.1IP, 5H, 2ER, 0BB, 4K, 2HR)...Orioles lost 4-3 in 11 innings.

LAST START: Started July 10 vs. Washington (W, 5.2IP, 8H, 3ER, 6K, HR)...Has surrendered at least one HR in a career-high five straight games.

NO FREE PASSES: Chen has walked just 18 batters this season, which is the fewest issued by any Orioles starter (not including Gausman)...It is his fewest total through the first 18 games of any season in his career.

TROUBLE WITH THE LONGBALL: After allowing just one home run in April, Chen has allowed six in May, eight in June, and two in July...10 of the 17 home runs Chen has allowed have been to the leadoff batter of an inning...He has allowed a career-high tying three home runs twice this season (May 27 at MIL and June 28 vs. TB), matching his career-mark for the fourth time (also, July 8, 2012 & September 7, 2012)...22 of Chen's 49 runs allowed this season have come off of the long ball...15 of the 17 HRs served up have been hit by right-handed batters...Of his 17 HR allowed this season, 13 of them have been solo shots...Of the 63 home runs Chen has given up in his career, 37 of them have been solo blasts.

FIRST INNING FIX: In the first inning of his 18 starts in 2014, he has pitched to a 4.00 ERA (18.0IP, 8ER) and allowed four home runs...In the first inning of his 23 starts in 2013, he pitched to a 2.35 ERA (23.0IP, 6ER) and allowed just two first-inning home runs...In the first inning of his 32 starts in 2012, Chen posted a 5.91 ERA and allowed seven home runs.

AT ORIOLE PARK: In 11 starts, is 5-2 with a 3.92 ERA (66.2IP, 29ER) and six Quality Starts...In 10 home starts in 2013, was 4-2 with a 3.62 ERA (64.2IP, 26ER) and seven Quality Starts...In 38 career home starts, is 15-10 with a 3.92 ERA (234.1IP, 102ER) and 22 Quality Starts.

ON THE ROAD: Is 4-1 with a 4.58 ERA (37.1IP, 19ER) in seven starts on the road this year...In 13 road starts in 2013, was 3-5 with a 4.48 ERA (72.1IP, 36ER) and the O's were 5-8 in those 13 games...In 35 career road starts, is 13-11 with a 4.24 ERA (199.1IP, 94ER) and 15 Quality Starts...The O's are 19-16 in his 35 road starts.

GOOD SUPPORT: Chen ranks third in the AL in run support average (6.06) behind **Scott Kazmir** and **C.J. Wilson**...From 2012-13, Chen ranked 27th among 35 AL qualifiers at 4.40.

OUCH: Was on the 15-day DL, May 13-July 10, 2013 with a right oblique strain...Had surgery following the 2013 season to remove bony ossicles from his right knee.

LUCKY SEVENS: When Chen pitches 5.0 or fewer innings, the Birds are 6-12, but when he pitches 5.1 or more innings, they are 36-19, including a **16-2 mark when he works 7.0 or more innings** (Chen is 13-1 in those 18 outings with his only loss coming August 4, 2013 vs. Seattle).

THE EAST IS A BEAST: Chen is 19-10 with a 3.70 ERA (260.0IP, 107ER) in 43 career starts outside the AL East...Against AL East clubs, he is 9-11 with a 4.61 ERA (173.2IP, 89ER) in 30 starts...Since August 15, 2012, he is 6-9 within the division and 12-6 against the rest of MLB.

MAKING TAIWAN PROUD: Has 28 career wins, the second-most by a Taiwanese-born pitcher in major league history behind **Chien-Ming Wang** (62)...Chen passed **Hong-Chih Kuo** (13 wins) for second place with his April 26, 2013 win at Oakland...Is one of seven pitchers in MLB history to be born in Taiwan (also **Chia-Jen Lo**, **Chin-hui Tsao**, **Fu-Te Ni** and **C.C. Lee** and those above).

THE LONE RANGER: Was the only pitcher to make more than 20 starts (made 32) for the O's in 2012, making the Orioles the only playoff team in history to have only one starter make more than 20 starts.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Recorded first win April 17, 2012 at Chicago (AL)...Struck out **Curtis Granderson** in the first inning May 10, 2012 for his first strikeout...Earned the win in Game 2 of the 2012 ALDS vs. NYY (6.1IP, 8H, 2R/1ER, BB, 3K), becoming the third Taiwanese-born pitcher in ML history to record a post-season victory...Allowed a HR to **Derek Jeter**, the first batter he faced in the majors April 10, 2012 at home.
