OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are now 3-4 since having their six-game winning streak snapped (July 3-8)...1-1 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (1-1) and Houston (three games).
- Jason Hammel made his first home start as a member of the Athletics...tossed a season-low 2.0 innings...allowed two home runs in the first inning for the third time in his career (last: Aug. 28, 2008 at Baltimore).
- Yoenis Cespedes (1 for 4, r) is 6 for 53 (.113) with no extra base hits and one RBI in July...extended his career-high streak of consecutive games without an extra base hit to 18 (previous: 14, July 29-Aug. 15, 2012).
- Craig Gentry (0 for 3) is 10 for 51 (.196) over his last 19 games.
- Jed Lowrie (2 for 4, 2b, 3 rbi) recorded a season-high tying three RBI (second time, last: June 30 at Detroit)...is 17 for 42 (.405) with seven runs scored, five doubles, seven multiple hit games and one strikeout over his last 11 games.
- Brandon Moss (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so, bb) is batting .298 (20 for 67) with five doubles, five home runs and 12 RBI over his last 17 games.

- The Baltimore Orioles are 1-1 on this 10-game west coast road trip against Oakland (1-1), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (four games).
- Wei-Yen Chen is now 4-0 with a 1.67 ERA (6 er in 32.1 ip) in five career starts against the Athletics.
- J.J. Hardy (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, bb, so) is batting .296 (72 for 243) with three home runs and 23 RBI against RHP compared to .242 (22 for 91) with one home run and four RBI against LHP.

Chen

- Adam Jones (2 for 4, 2 r, hr, 5 rbi, bb, 2 sb) recorded a career-high tying five RBI (second time, last: July 28, 2008 at New York-AL)...became the first player in Baltimore history to record at least five RBI and have multiple stolen bases in the same game.
- Manny Machado (0 for 4, ibb, so) extended his on-base streak to a career-high 19 games...is 27 for 69 (.391) over the streak with four doubles, six home runs, 11 RBI, and six walks.
