Baltimore Orioles (53-43) vs. Oakland Athletics (60-37)

RH Kevin Gausman (4-2, 3.29) vs. RH Sonny Gray (10-3, 2.79)



TODAY'S GAME: The Orioles and Athletics meet in the rubber game of their three-game set, and the O's third game of a 10-game west coast swing that will also see the Birds face the Angels (three) and Mariners (four)...The O's bounced back from Friday night's walk-off loss with an 8-4 win last night, **the O's fourth win in five games immediately following a walk-off loss this season...**The Orioles are 11-4 since June 30 and are 4.0 games up on New York and Toronto for the AL East lead.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The O's jumped out to a 4-0 first inning lead on the strength of an **Adam Jones** three-run homer and a **J.J. Hardy** solo blast...The Jones HR was just the 10th Earl Weaver special of the season for the O's amongst their major league leading 119 homers...Jones recorded a career-high tying five RBI (July 28, 2008 at New York)...Hardy is now batting .312/.337/.439 in 40 road games this season...**Wei-Yin Chen** recorded his 10th win and **Zach Britton** struck out **Nick Punto** with the tying run on deck to end the game for his 16th save.

VS. OAKLAND: The Orioles trail in the season series, 2-3, going 1-2 in Baltimore and 1-1 in Oakland...Per *STATS*, in the 12 games between the O's and A's dating back to 2013, the Orioles have been tied or leading after seven innings in 11 of the 12 games, but are just 7-5...The Birds have led after seven innings in four of the five games this season...The O's won last year's season series, 5-2, (2-1 at home and 3-1 in Oakland)...**It was the O's first season series victory over the A's since 1998...**The O's trail in the all-time series, 252-254 (122-128 in Baltimore and 130-126 in Oakland).

RARE OCCURRENCE: **Adam Jones** became the sixth player since 1914 to record at least one walk, home run, two steals, and five RBI in a game, joining **Matt Lawton** (PIT, 5/8/05), **Gary Sheffield** (FLA, 9/18/95), **Glenallen Hill** (CHC, 6/18/94), **George Grantham** (CHC, 4/23/24), and **Rogers Hornsby** (STL, 6/12/22).

ROAD WARRIORS: Since May 31, the Orioles are 12-5 in 17 road games, batting .288/.345/.487 as a team and averaging 5.8 runs per game.

ON-BASE MACHINE: **Manny Machado** has reached base safely in a career-high 18 straight games since June 22, batting .391/.440/.710...In his last 38 games since May 31, Machado is batting .313/.361/.537, raising his season average from .210 to .270...Machado recorded multiple hits in four straight games, July 5-9, the second longest streak of his career (five, June 12-16, 2013).

GOOD GLOVES: The O's have recorded just one fielding error in their last 11 games since July 5 (99.1 innings)...The O's rank second behind Cincinnati with 44 errors and a .988 fielding percentage this season.

BALTIMORE BOMB SQUAD: The Orioles have hit a major league leading 119 home runs this season and are on pace to hit 201 long balls this season...**Since June 1, the Orioles have hit a major league leading 65 homers, 19 more than the next closest team (Cleveland - 46)...**From June 21-July 2, the Orioles homered in 12 straight games, their longest such streak since they homered in 13 straight games, August 1-16, 2013.

ONE AWAY: **Nelson Cruz** is one RBI away from collecting his sixth consecutive season of 20+ home runs and 75+ RBI...**Nick Markakis** is one double shy from collecting 20+ two-baggers in nine consecutive seasons...He would be the sixth player in franchise history to have nine or more 20+ double seasons, joining **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (17), **Brooks Robinson** (14), **Eddie Murray** (12), and **Brady Anderson** and **Paul Blair** (nine each).

BEST VS. THE WEST: The O's are 12-7 against the AL West this season, and their .632 winning percentage is the highest by any American League club against the West (Detroit is second at .593).

STRONG STARTS: In 35 games since June 9, the O's rotation has posted a 3.22 ERA (209.2IP, 75ER), chopping more than half of a run off the starter's ERA, lowering it from 4.61 to 4.09 for the season.

DIVISION DYNAMOS: The Orioles own the highest in-division winning percentage in the American League (26-18, .591 vs. AL East)...The O's (26) rank second behind Seattle (27) for most in-division wins in the AL.

O'DEALING: **Darren O'Day** has not allowed a run in his last 11 outings (12.2IP), striking out 14, while walking just three (one intentional)...His 1.06 ERA leads American League relievers.

GONE HUNTING: **Tommy Hunter** has not allowed an earned run in his last 11 appearances (13.2 IP), setting a new career-long streak...He is 2.0 innings away from the longest scoreless streak of his career (15.2 IP) which he achieved in a then career-best 10 game scoreless streak, April 12-May 12, 2013.

ZACH ATTACK: **Zach Britton**'s stretch of 31.1 consecutive scoreless innings at home is an Orioles club record...His stretch of 23 straight scoreless home appearances is the second-longest streak in club history, trailing only **Brian Matusz** (27 appearances - June 16, 2013-May 25, 2014; 19.0 scoreless innings).

CRUZ CRUSHING: **Nelson Cruz** has 28 home runs, bypassing his season total from last season (27 in 109 games) and is on pace for 47 longballs...His career high is 33 (2009)...Cruz's 28 homers before the All-Star break were the third-most in Orioles history behind **Chris Davis** (37 in 2013) and **Brady Anderson** (30 in 1996).

WORTH THE WAIT: The Orioles are 9-3 in extra innings games this year and have won four straight games in extras...The Birds were 8-7 in extra innings in 2013 after going 16-2 in 2012...**Since the start of the 2012 season, the Birds are 33-12 in extra innings contests...**In games that have gone 12 or more innings since the start of 2012, the Orioles are 13-4 (14-5 including the 2012 postseason).

ALL-STARS: **Nelson Cruz** (0-for-2 as DH), **Adam Jones** (0-for-2, 2 putouts in CF), and **Matt Wieters** (did not play due to injury but voted starting CA) represented the O's at the All-Star Game as elected starters...Jones participated in the Home Run Derby for the first time and hit four first round blasts before bowing out to champion **Yoenis Cespedes**, 9-3, in round two...He was pitched to by Orioles bullpen catcher/batting practice pitcher **Jett Ruiz**.

SLUGGING STEVE: **Steve Pearce** has a career-high 11 homers and 31 RBI this season...It took Pearce 46 games (150 AB) to hit 10 homers this year...He needed 192 games (488 AB) to hit his first 10 big league homers.

TOMORROW'S STARTER: **RH Bud Norris** is expected to be activated from the 15-day DL to make his 16th start of the season, his ninth on the road, where he has gone 3-4 with a 4.86 ERA (46.1IP, 25ER) this season...In four lifetime starts against the Angels, Norris is 3-0 with a 0.32 ERA (28.0IP, ER)...In two starts in Anaheim, Norris is 2-0 and pitched 13.0 scoreless innings, holding the Angels to a .159/.260/.205 triple slash line.

QUICK HITS: Is making his eighth start this year and his 13th career major league start (28th appearance)...Was taken fourth overall out of LSU in 2012 as a draft-eligible sophomore...Rated as having the best change-up and best fastball in the Orioles system entering the 2014 season by *Baseball America*...**Was the first player selected in the first round in 2012 to reach the majors**...His pitching coach at LSU was former Orioles bullpen coach **Alan Dunn**.

CAREER VS. OAKLAND: Is making his second career start against the Athletics...Earned his first ML win as a starter on June 7 at OPACY vs. Oakland (7.0IP, 4H, ER, BB, 6K)...Set a career-high with 7.0 innings of work...Allowed a solo HR to **Coco Crisp** in the third inning.

LAST START: Started on July 13 against the Yankees (W, 5.0IP, 4H, ER, 2K)...Was the final game for the Orioles before the All-Star break...The rain-shortened game was called after a 2:22 delay...Earned the first complete game of his ML career...Surrendered a leadoff HR to **Brett Gardner**...Did not allow another runner to reach past first base.

AT ORIOLE PARK: Is 3-2 with a 4.33 ERA (27.0IP, 13ER) in five starts at home this season...Is 5-3 with a 4.18 ERA (47.1IP, 22ER) in 12 career outings (seven starts) at OPACY.

ON THE ROAD: Is 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA (11.1IP, ER) in two road starts this season...Held opponents scoreless over the first 11 innings of his road starts this season...Is 2-4 with a 5.12 ERA (38.2IP, 22ER) in 15 games (five starts) on the road in his career...Is 1-3 with a 6.93 ERA (24.2IP, 19ER) in five career road starts.

IN 2014 WITH TRIPLE-A NORFOLK: Made 11 starts for the Tides and went 1-3 with a 3.32 ERA (43.1IP, 16ER)...**Was placed on disabled list May 2, retroactive to April 30, with left intercostal strain**...Initially diagnosed as a left intercostal strain...However, a CT scan later revealed the injury to be a case of focal pneumonia...Gausman did not allow an earned run from April 20, until the fifth inning of his start on May 20 with Norfolk, a span of 18.1 innings...Owned a 6.55 ERA in the first inning (11.0IP, 8ER) with Norfolk and pitched to a 2.23 ERA (32.1IP, 8ER) outside of the first frame...Gausman pitched to a 1.93 ERA (23.1P, 5ER) in six home starts with the Tides this season, as he held Triple-A batters to a .225 average at Harbor Park (20-89).

WHAT A RELIEF: Is 4-5 with a 5.00 ERA (63.0IP, 35ER) in 12 career starts, but owns a 3-2 record with a 3.52 ERA (23.0IP, 9ER) in 15 career relief appearances.

PROSPECTING: Entered the 2014 season as the Orioles' #2 prospect for the second straight season according to MLB.com and *Baseball America* (behind RHP **Dylan Bundy**)...Also ranked as the #20 prospect in all of baseball by *Baseball America* (#26 in 2013) and #29 by MLB.com (#36 in 2013).

MLB FIRSTS: Made his ML debut on May 23, 2013 in a start against the Blue Jays in Toronto and struck out **Edwin Encarnacion** in the first inning for his first ML strikeout (L, 5.0IP, 7H, 4ER, 2BB, 5K)...Earned his first ML win as a starter June 7, 2014 vs. Oakland (7.0IP, 4H, ER, BB, 6K).

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: Gausman became the 953rd player to play for the Orioles and the 12th player to make his Orioles debut in 2013, joining **Alex Burnett, Chris Dickerson, Alexi Casilla, Zach Clark, Freddy Garcia, Jair Jurrjens, T.J. McFarland, Yamaico Navarro, Chris Snyder, Josh Stinson, and Danny Valencia**...**Mike Belfiore** was recalled for the May 12 game at Minnesota but did not pitch...Gausman was the 21st pitcher used by the Orioles in 2013...Gausman was the third Oriole to make his ML debut in 2013, joining Clark and McFarland.

JUST A PUP: When he made his debut, May 23, 2013 at Toronto, Gausman was the youngest pitcher in the AL (22 years, 137 days) and the fifth-youngest MLB pitcher behind Miami's **Jose Fernandez** (20.296), St. Louis' **Carlos Martinez** (21.263), Los Angeles' **Paco Rodriguez** (22.037) and Atlanta's **Julio Teheran** (22.116).

QUICK ASCENT: Gausman became the third player selected in the 2012 draft to reach the big leagues, joining LHP **Paco Rodriguez** (Dodgers, second round, #82 overall) debuted September 9, 2012 and LHP **Michael Roth** (Angels, ninth round pick, #297 overall) debuted April 13, 2013...Gausman's eight starts above the Class-A level at the time of his debut are fewer than **Clayton Kershaw** (14), **David Price** (13) and **Steven Strasburg** (11)...Gausman (61.1 IP) started a game in the majors faster than any Orioles first-round pick...**Ben McDonald** and **Gregg Olson** reached the big leagues in fewer innings, but did not start their first major league game.

THE PIPELINE: His pitching coach at LSU was former Orioles bullpen coach **Alan Dunn**...Is the third Oriole first round pick out of LSU, joining **Mike Fontenot** (19th overall in 2001) and **Ben McDonald** (1st overall in 1989).

AT LOUISIANA STATE IN 2012: Went 11-1 with a 2.72 ERA (115.2IP, 35ER), 128 strikeouts, 27 walks and two complete games in 16 starts for LSU...Named 2012 First-Team All-American (*Collegiate Baseball, Perfect Game, ABCA*); Second-Team All-American (*Baseball America, NCBWA*); First-Team All-SEC; ABCA First-Team All-South Region; Louisiana Pitcher of the Year; and NCAA Baton Rouge Regional All-Tournament Team...**IN 2011:** Was 5-6 with a 3.51 ERA and 86 strikeouts in 89.2 innings...Named 2011 SEC Freshman of the Week (May 16, 2011 and May 2, 2011).

HIGH SCHOOL: Was originally selected by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the sixth round of the 2010 First Year Player Draft after being named a two-time All-State selection, two-time Perfect Game High School All-American, 2009 Under Armour All-American, 2009 AFLAC All-American and gold medal winner with the USA Baseball Junior National Team.
