OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics have won 10 of the last 14 contests, and 19 of the last 28...The A's won the season series against Baltimore 4-2...have lost a season series to the Orioles just once since 1998 (2013, 2-5)...are 2-1 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (2-1) and Houston (three games).
- Sonny Gray is 5-0 with a 2.24 ERA (10 er in 40.1 ip) over his last six starts...it is his third winning streak of three or more games this year...is 4-0 with a 0.96 ERA (3 er in 28.1 ip) in four starts in July...was 0-2 with an 11.42 ERA (11 er in 8.2 ip) in two previous career starts against Baltimore.
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4, r, bb, so) is 6 for 17 (.353) with five runs in five games against Baltimore this season...is 14 for 32 (.438) with 12 runs over his last nine games against the Orioles...the A's are 30-5 when Crisp scores a run.
- Yoenis Cespedes (2 for 5, r, 2b, 2 so) doubled in the 6th inning, snapping a streak of 18 consecutive games without an extra base, which was a career-high.
- Craig Gentry (2 for 4, r, 2 rbi, so) had his first multi-rbi game of the season, and his first since Sept. 29, 2013 against Seattle (with Texas).
- John Jaso (2 for 4, r, 3b, 2 rbi, bb) is now batting .311 (23 for 74) over his last 23 games.
- Eric Sogard (2 for 4, r, rbi) snapped a career-high 62-game errorless streak as a second basemen with an error in the 7th inning (last: Sept. 28, 2013)...the errorless streak was the fourth longest in Oakland history by a second basemen.
- Stephen Vogt (3 for 4, r, 2b, rbi, bb) is hitting .388 (38 for 98) against right-handed pitching compared to .250 (5 for 20) against left-handers...collected three hits for the third time this season (previous: 6/17 against Texas, 6/30 at Detroit).

BALTIMORE NOTES

- The **Baltimore Orioles** are now 1-2 on this 10-game west coast road trip against Oakland (1-2), Los Angeles-AL (three games) and Seattle (four games)... lost the season series to Oakland 2-4...have won a season series against the A's just once since 1998 (2013, 5-2).
- Kevin Gausman allowed five runs in 4.0 innings...was 1-0 with a 0.79 ERA (1 er in 11.1 ip) in two previous road starts this year.
- J.J. Hardy (1 for 2, rbi, bb) is batting .298 (73 for 245) with three home runs and 24 RBI against RHP compared to .242 (22 for 91) with one home run and four RBI against LHP.
- Caleb Joseph (0 for 3) had a seven-game streak of reaching base snapped.
- Manny Machado (1 for 3, rbi, 2 so) extended his on-base streak to a career-high 19 games.
