OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** are 22-11 over the last 33 games...have won 9 of the last 11 home games, 27 of the last 35, and are 33-17 for the season...The A's have scored nine or more runs 20 times this season...are 3-2 on this six-game homestand against Baltimore (2-1) and Houston (1-1).
- **Jesse Chavez** is 5-2 with a 2.24 ERA (14 er in 56.1 ip) in eight starts at home compared to 3-4 with a 3.49 ERA in 11 road starts...earned his eight win of the season...had just nine wins in 191 career appearances entering the season.
- **Yoenis Céspedes** (2 for 4, 2 r, 2 hr, 5 rbi) snapped a career-high tying 25-game homerless streak in the 2nd inning...had his fifth career two-home run game, and his second this season (last: June 4 at NYY)...collected a career-high tying five RBIs (three times, last: May 31 against LAA)...is 8 for 21 (.381) on the homestand after going 0 for 18 on the previous road trip.
- **Coco Crisp** (0 for 2, r, 3 bb, so) walked three times, which matches the most by an Athletic this season (nine times, last: Coco Crisp, June 28 at Miami).
- **John Jaso** (3 for 3, r, 2b, 2 rbi, bb) is 15 for 34 (.441) over his last 10 games and is hitting .346 (27 for 78) over his last 25 contests...recorded a season-high tying three hits (four times, last: June 28 at Miami).
- **Jed Lowrie** (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi) is batting .358 (19 for 53) with eight runs scored, five doubles, eight RBI and seven multiple hit games over his last 14 games...snapped a 40-game homerless streak in the 2nd inning.

HOUSTON NOTES

- **The Houston Astros** had a three-game win streak against the A's snapped, their longest in franchise history...are 2-3 on this six-game, seven-day road trip against Chicago-AL (1-2) and Oakland (1-1).
- **Brad Peacock** allowed five earned runs through the first two innings...had not allowed more than four earned runs in all previous starts this season... had allowed 3 earned runs or less in all five previous career starts against Oakland...allowed 7 earned runs in 3.2 innings pitched...was 3-2 with a 3.35 ERA (17 er in 45.2 ip) in his previous ten starts.
- **Chris Carter** (1 for 4, r, 2b, rbi, bb, so) is batting .310 (18 for 58) with 14 RBI in his 15 games this month.
- **Jason Castro** (2 for 5, 2 r, so) snapped an 0 for 16 hitless streak with a single to left field in the 6th inning.
