OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are now 7-6 since the All-Star Break...are 0-1 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (0-1), Tampa Bay (three games), and Minnesota (four games).
- Sonny Gray made his first career start against Kansas City and tossed 7.0 innings...has a 2.00 ERA (12 er in 54.0 ip) over his last eight starts.
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 3, bb, so) is batting .319 (15 for 47) with three home runs and 11 RBI in 13 games since the All-Star Break...however, is batting .202 (35 for 173) with six home runs and 26 RBI over his last 45 games (since June 7).
- Sam Fuld (1 for 3, 2b, bb, so) made his first start in his second stint with the A's this season after being acquired from Minnesota yesterday in a trade for Tommy Milone...is 16 for 46 (.348) with 16 walks over his last 17 games.
- Jed Lowrie (0 for 4, 3 so) struck out a season-high tying three times.
- Brandon Moss (0 for 4, 2 so) is batting .188 (15 for 80) with four home runs and 10 RBI over his last 20 games.
- Josh Reddick (3 for 4, 2b) recorded a season-high tying three hits (sixth time, last: July 27 at Texas)...is 13 for 35 (.371) with seven runs scored, five
 doubles, two home runs and four RBI since his return from the 15-day disabled list on July 22.

Raul Ibanez (5)

- The Kansas City Royals snapped their four-game Oakland losing streak...prior to tonight, last won a game at the Coliseum on April 10, 2012...are 8-2 over their last 10 games...are now 1-0 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (1-0) and Arizona (three games).
- Jeremy Guthrie tossed 6.0 innings and allowed a season-low tying three hits...is 3-4 with a 4.29 ERA (27 er in 56.2 ip) in 12 appearances (11 starts) against Oakland in his career.
- Nori Aoki (1 for 3 2b, bb) is batting .314 (11 for 35) with two doubles and one triple over his last nine contests.
- Raul Ibanez (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his fifth home run of the season in the fifth inning, which broke his own record (set on July 2 at Minnesota) for being the oldest member of the Royals in history to hit a home run.
