OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their 10th shutout of the season...are 3-2 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (1-2), Tampa Bay (2-0), and Minnesota (four games).
- Jason Hammel snapped his season-high four game losing streak...tossed 5.2 innings in his first scoreless start for the Athletics (fourth overall this season)... allowed a season-high four walks.
- · Sean Doolittle recorded his 17th save, which ties an Athletics record for most by a left handed pitcher (Alan Embree, 2007).
- Alberto Callaspo (2 for 4, r) recorded his first multiple-hit game in his last 20 games (last: July 7 vs. San Francisco).
- Coco Crisp (1 for 4, rbi, bb, so) made his first start since July 26 after recovering from a strained neck.
- Sam Fuld (1 for 4, 2 so, sb) is 20 for 63 (.317) with eight RBI, 17 walks, and nine stolen bases over his last 21 games.
- Josh Reddick (2 for 3, rbi) is batting .388 (19 for 49) with five doubles, four home runs, eight RBI, 11 runs scored, and seven multiple hit games in 14 games since being reinstated from the disabled list on July 22.

- The Tampa Bay Rays have lost five of their last six games after going 11-1 in their previous 12 games...are now 0-2 on this 10-game road trip to Oakland (0-2), Chicago-NL (three games), and Texas (four games).
- Drew Smyly tossed 5.1 innings in his first start for the Rays after being acquired in a three-team trade that sent David Price to Detroit on July 31...has now tossed fewer than 6.0 innings in three conecutive starts.
- Yunel Escobar (1 for 3, bb) is batting .300 (21 for 70) in 19 games since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list on July 11.
- Cole Figueroa (2 for 3) recorded his second career multiple-hit game.
- James Loney (1 for 4) extended his on-base streak to 24 games...is batting .337 (32 for 95) over that span.
