OAKLAND NOTES

- **The Oakland Athletics** had a five-game winning streak in Oakland against the Rays snapped...have not won more than two straight games since a six-game winning streak from July 3-8...are 3-3 on this ten-game homestand against Kansas City (1-2), Tampa Bay (2-1) and Minnesota (four games).
- **Sonny Gray** allowed a career-high 10 hits and a career-high tying six earned runs...lasted 4.1 innings, the second shortest start of his career (3.1 innings at Baltimore, Aug. 25, 2013)...snapped a six-game streak of allowing one earned run or fewer..this was the longest such streak by an A's pitcher since at least 1914 (Cody Lidle, Aug. 4-31, 2002).
- **John Jaso** (0 for 3, hbp) is 0 for his last 17...is 5 for 36 (.139) with five RBI over his last eight games after going 15 for 34 (.441) with eight RBI over previous 11 contests.
- **Brandon Moss** (0 for 3, r, bb, so) is 0 for his last 17, which ties the longest hitless streak of his career (17, Sept. 10-29, 2010).
- **Josh Reddick** (1 for 4, 2b, 2 rbi) has hit safely in each of his last eight home games, hitting .466 (14 for 30) over that span... is batting .377 (20 for 53) with six doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 11 runs scored, and seven multiple hit games in 15 games since being reinstated from the disabled list on July 22.
- **Eric Sogard** (1 for 3, r, hr, rbi, so) homered in the sixth inning, snapping a career-high 110-game homerless streak (last: July 21, 2013 at Los Angeles)...was the second longest homerless streak by an Athletic over the last seven years (114, Weeks from April 14, 2012-Sept. 29, 2013).
- **Stephen Vogt** (0 for 3) is 0 for his last 23, which is the second longest hitless streak of his career...began his career by going 0 for 32, including 0 for 25 in 2012 with Tampa Bay.

TAMPA BAY NOTES

- **The Tampa Bay Rays** snapped a five-game losing streak in Oakland today...are 1-2 on this ten-game road trip to Oakland (1-2), Chicago-NL (three games) and Texas (four games).
- **Jeremy Hellickson** earned his first win of the season...was winless over his previous six starts (last: Sept. 4, 2013 at LAA)...pitched more than five innings for the first time in his last six starts (last: Sept. 12, 2013 vs. Boston), which was a career-long streak.
- **Yunel Escobar** (2 for 5, 2 r) is batting .315 (23 for 73) in 20 games since being reinstated from the 15-day disabled list on July 11.
- **James Loney** (2 for 4, bb) extended his on-base streak to 25 games...is batting .343 (34 for 99) over that span.
- **Evan Longoria** (1 for 4, rbi, bb, 2 so) has a seven-game hitting streak, going 8 for 28 (.286) over that span.
