OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics recorded their 11th shutout win of the season...became the first team to reach 70 wins on the season...are 4-3 on this 10-game homestand against Kansas City (1-2), Tampa Bay (2-1) and Minnesota (1-0).
- Bob Melvin won his 800th game as a manager...is now the eighth active manager and 76th in Major League history with 800 wins...the A's are 307-230 (.572) since he took over as manager June 9, 2011, which is the best mark in the majors since that date.
- Jon Lester recorded his fourth career complete game shutout (last: May 10, 2013 vs. Toronto)... is now 6-0 with a 1.21 ERA (10 er in 74.1 ip) over his last 10 starts dating back to June 12...threw a season-high tying 122 pitches (second time, last: April 27 at Toronto).
- Josh Donaldson (1 for 4, sb) has a 15-game hitting streak against Minnesota dating back to August 20, 2012...is 23 for 56 (.411) with eight doubles, two
 home runs and 11 RBI during the streak...is a .383 (23 for 60) career hitter against Minnesota, which is his best mark against any AL team.
- John Jaso (1 for 3) snapped his 0 for 18 hitless streak with a single to right field in the third inning.
- Brandon Moss (1 for 3, r, 2b, ibb, 2 so) snapped his 0 for 18 hitless streak with a double in the fourth inning...the streak was the longest hitless streak of his career (previous: 17, Sept. 10-29, 2010).
- · Josh Reddick (0 for 4) had his eight-game home hitting streak snapped...batted .466 (14 for 30) over that span.
- Eric Sogard (2 for 4, so, sb) recorded his 11th multiple hit game of the season, his second this homestand (last: August 4 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 3, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) snapped his 0 for 23 hitless streak with a two-run home run to right field in the third inning...the hitless streak was the second longest hitless streak of his career after beginning his career 0 for 32.

- The Minnesota Twins extended their losing streak against the Athletics to 10 games, including a seven-game losing streak at the Coliseum...are 0-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-1) and Houston (four games).
- Yohan Pino made his first career start against the Athletics...tossed 5.2 innings, and has now tossed 5.0 innings or more in eight of his nine career major league starts (all this year).
- Brian Dozier (0 for 3, bb) had his 10-game road hitting streak snapped...batted .409 (18 for 44) with 11 walks, 2 home runs, five doubles, 7 RBI, and six walks during the streak.
- Danny Santana (0 for 4) extended his hitless streak to 0 for his last 11.
