**THE TWINS:** After recently completing their two-game homestand against San Diego with a split, the Twins began a four-game series in Oakland with three straight losses...today they play the fourth and final game with the A's...following the game the Twins will travel to Houston for three, Monday-Wednesday.

MAY SUFFERS LOSS AT OAKLAND: The Twins lost to Oakland last night by a score of 9-4... Trevor May made his Major League debut and suffered the loss as he pitched 2.0 innings allowing four runs on three hits and walked seven batters...Samuel Deduno pitched 3.0 innings of relief and allowed five runs on five hits (two home runs)...Ryan Pressly tossed 2.0 scoreless innings of relief...Danny Santana, Kennys Vargas, Eduardo Escobar and Jordan Schafer each had a pair of hits...Escobar and Schafer each had two doubles...Trevor Plouffe drove in two runs as he went. If for 5 drove in two runs as he went 1-for-5.

TWINS COMPLETE TRADE WITH DODGERS: The Twins announced last night that they have traded Kevin Correia to the Los Angeles Dodgers in exchange for a player to be named later or cash considerations...in 23 starts with the Twins this season, Correia went 5-13 with a 4.94 ERA (129.1 IP, 71 ER), 61 strikeouts and 32 walks. Since signing with the Twins prior to the 2013 season, Correia made 54 starts going 14-26 with a 4.49 ERA (314.2 IP, 157 ER) while recording 30 quality starts...to replace Correia on the 25-man roster, the Twins plan to recall left-handed pitcher Tommy Milone from Triple-A Rochester and start him Monday night in Houston..Milone, who was recently acquired via trade from Oakland, made one start for the Red Wings on August 5, tossing 7.0 innings allowing just one run on six hits. The 27-year-old Milone, has appeared in 80 career games (78 starts) with Washington and Oakland from 2011-2014, going 32-22 while recording a 3.84 ERA (468.2 IP, 200 ER) with 339 strikeouts and just 105 walks. Milone will wear uniform number 49.

**NOT SO ATHLETIC:** The Twins are looking to snap a 12-game losing streak to the A's which dates back to September 11, 2013, their last win being a 4-3 victory September 10, 2013 at Target Field...the last time they lost 12-plus straight to a single opponent came May 10,

2002-April 21, 2003, when they lost 13 straight to the New York Yankees.

The Twins are looking to snap a nine-game losing streak at the Coliseum and win here for the first time since August 20, 2012.

CATCHING ON WITH MINNESOTA: Former Athletic Kurt Suzuki is hitting .304 (99-for-326), best among American League catchers... he is hitting .333 (25-for-75) with runners in scoring position...the former A's second round pick in the 2004 First-Year Player Draft hit .258 (847-for-3283) in parts of seven seasons with Oakland...he has played in 367 career games at the Coliseum, hitting .251 (319for-1269) with 36 home runs here...he ranks third among actives in games played in this stadium, trailing only Jason Giambi (535) and Mark Ellis (521) — recently retired Eric Chavez played 669 games here.

MAUER REHAB UPDATE: Joe Mauer went 2-for-4 and played nine innings at first base last night for Single-A Cedar Rapids...it marked his fourth game of his rehab assignment and second straight multi-hit game...Mauer, who has been out since July 1 with a right oblique strain, is expected to join the team in Houston.

TWINS MINOR LEAGUE PLAYER OF THE WEEK: Triple-A Rochester outfielder Danny Ortiz is the Twins Minor League Player of the Week... in six games with the Red Wings, he hit .455 (10-for-22) with three doubles, a home run, and five RBI...he also walked twice and scored seven runs to go with a .500 on-base percentage...the 24-year-old Cayey, Puerto Rico-native was selected by the Twins in the fourth round of the 2008 First Year Player Draft out of Benjamin Harrison (PR) High School.

LAST TIME OUT: Hughes snapped a season-high three game losing streak in his start August 5 at home vs. San Diego, allowing one run on seven hits in 6.0 innings, tying a season-high with nine punchouts, picking up the win...with his start, Hughes surpassed his strikeout total (127) from all of last season (121), and is just two innings from matching his innings total from 2013 (143.2)...Hughes has received 13 straight-decisions over the past two-plus months, a streak dating back to May 27 at Texas (7.0 IP, ND).

VS. OAKLAND: Will be making his ninth career start against the Athletics this afternoon and second this season...received a no-decision after going five innings allowing four runs while striking out three against them on April 9 at Target Field, opposing Jesse Chavez... Hughes has a 3-2 record, 4.62 ERA (48.2 IP, 25 ER) in 12 career games against Oakland... he has faced them four times (three starts) at 0.co Coliseum, going 1-2, 2.66 ERA (20.1 IP, 6 ER)...his last start here came on June 12, 2013 with the Yankees, going 4.1 innings, allowing three runs. allowing three runs.

- Hughes hasn't allowed a home run with a two-strike count this season, after he allowed 10 two-strike homers in 2013.
- He's walked just two batters to leadoff innings in his last 21 starts (Brian McCann June 1, Logan Forsythe July 19).

<u>WINNER.</u> WINNER: Hughes' victory against the Rockies on July 13 gave him double-digit wins (10) before the All-Star break for just the second time in his career, the other coming in 2010 when he had 11 pre-break wins with the Yankees and was selected an All-Star.

**FEWEST FREEBIES:** Hughes has allowed just 14 walks in 23 starts this season, the fewest in Major League Baseball among qualified pitchers...since the start of 2013, he has made 52 starts, allowing 56 walks...Hughes has walked the third-fewest in baseball over that span behind New York-NL's Bartolo Colon (49) and Seatte's Hisashi lwakuma (53).

**PUNCHING EM' OUT:** Hughes leads the Twins starting rotation with 8.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched (127 K, 143.2 IP)...he has six-or-more strikeouts in 14 of his games this season...his 127 strikeouts are most among Twins pitchers (Ricky Nolasco second with 72).

MODEL OF CONSISTENCY: From April 26 to June 22 (11 starts), Hughes posted a record of 7-2, 2.54 ERA (74.1 IP, 21 ER), with a 62:3 strikeout to walk ratio and opponents hitting .247 in those games...only Masahiro Tanaka (2.09) and Felix Hernandez (2.33) posted a lower ERA among AL pitchers over that span...in his first four starts, Hughes posted a 6.43 ERA (21.0 IP, 15 ER), allowing an opponent average of .326, second-worst in the AL...his 1.62 ERA (33.1 IP, 6 ER) in the month of May was the second best in baseball (min. five starts) behind only the Cubs Jeff Samardzija (1.32).

**QUALITY CONTROL:** Hughes has 13 quality starts this season, tied for most among Twins starters (Correia)...he eclipsed his total from all of last season (11) on July 30 in Kansas City (6.0 IP, 3 ER)...his career-high in quality starts in 2012, when he had 18.

REWRITING HISTORY: After issuing a walk to the Yankees Brian McCann to leadoff the second inning on June 1 in New York, Hughes snapped a streak of 178 batters-faced without a walk...his previous walk before that came on April 20 at Kansas City, walking Alcides Escobar in the second inning...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, he now holds the second-longest streak among Twins pitchers all-time record (since 1961), set by Brad Radke in 2005:




