**ROSTER NOTE:** Prior to tonight's game, the Mets placed RHP Bartolo Colon on the Bereavement List and recalled RHP Gonzalez Germen from Las Vegas (AAA) of the Pacific Coast League... Germen will wear #71 and will be available for tonight's game... The righty began the year with the Mets and was placed on the 15-Day DL from May 12-June 11 with a virus... He was optioned to Las Vegas (AAA) on July 8... Germen is 0-0 with a 4.78 ERA (14 earned runs/26.1 innings) with 26 strikeouts in 21 games with the Mets... Germen went 2-0 with a 0.52 ERA (one earned run/17.1 innings) with 17 strikeouts in 14 games with the 51s.

**HITS:** The Mets were held to four hits on Monday, the fifth straight game the team has finished with four hits or less, tying a franchise record... Also done September 3-8, 2004 and September 12-15, 1963... Since the Mets' streak in 2004, no other major league team has had such a streak.

**RECENTLY:** The Mets have lost two in a row and are 4-6 in their last 10 contests... New York is 21-18 in its last 39 contests... The Mets are 6-4-2 in their last 12 series.

**ON THE ROAD:** The Mets are 29-35 on the road and 8-5 over their last 13 road contests.

**INTERLEAGUE:** The Mets are 8-7 vs. the American League this year (2-1 vs. Seattle, 2-1 vs. Texas, 1-1 vs. Oakland, 2-2 vs. the Yankees and 1-2 vs. the Angels)... New York is 154-143 all-time in Interleague play... The .519 winning percentage ranks fourth among NL clubs.

**REMATCH OF '73:** The Mets have traveled to Oakland just once since the 1973 World Series... New York went 1-2 at Oakland in 2005... **The Mets went 1-1 vs. the A's at Citi Field earlier this year and have won seven of the last nine match-ups between the two clubs.**

**DUDA GOES DEEP:** Lucas Duda extended his career-high with his 22nd home run yesterday... He ranks fifth in the National League in home runs... **Duda is tied for third in the majors with eight home runs since the All-Star break...** Duda also has a career-best 66 RBI which is tied for 14th in the NL.

**COMBO MAN:** Lucas Duda has six walks in his last four games... He is 13th in the NL with 54 walks, one shy of his career-high (55) set last year... **Duda is one of five NL players with 20 or more home runs and 50 or more walks (Giancarlo Stanton, Anthony Rizzo, Justin Upton and Troy Tulowitzki).**

**WALKS:** New York is second in the NL and sixth in the majors with 413 walks... Oakland leads the majors with 456 walks... Curtis Granderson is tied for fourth in the NL with 65 walks.

**CARLOS TORRES:** Became the fourth pitcher in Mets history to start a game on zero days rest yesterday... Joined Dan Wheeler (April 7 and 8, 2004 at Atlanta), Kevin Kobel (recorded the final out of a suspended game before starting the regularly scheduled game against Houston at Shea Stadium on August 22, 1979) and Craig Anderson (game one of doubleheader on September 8 and September 9, 1962)... The last major league pitcher to start on no rest was the Angels' Billy Buckner (June 25 and 26, 2013 at Detroit)... The last pitcher to record at least 5.0 shutout innings in a start on no rest was Philadelphia's Bruce Ruffin, who tossed 8.0 shutout innings against Houston on June 21, 1991.

**METS-ATHLETICS NOTES:** The Mets make just their second regular season trip to Oakland, went 1-2 in 2005... New York has won seven of the last nine meetings.

**INHERITED RUNNERS:** New York stranded three runners yesterday and has stranded 129 of 162 inherited runners, the best percentage (79.6) in the majors.

**VIC BLACK:** Stranded two runners yesterday and has stranded 22 straight inherited runners (including one on June 30 after he had departed the game)... **Black has the second-best percentage (96%) in the majors, stranding 24 of 25 runners (minimum 20 runners).**

**BUDDY CARLYLE:** Had his bullpen season-high scoreless streak snapped at 13.0 innings yesterday... He has the fourth-lowest ERA (0.98) among all pitchers with 15 or more innings.

**DANIEL MURPHY:** Leads the National League and is tied for third in the majors with 152 hits... He is also tied for fourth in the NL with 34 doubles, second with 44 multi-hit games and 12th with a .297 batting average... **Murphy is hitting .325 on the road, the third-best mark in the NL.**

**DOUBLES:** Murphy collected his 187th career double yesterday tying Darryl Strawberry for eighth place on the club's all-time list... Mike Piazza is seventh on the list with 193 doubles... Since 2012, Murphy is tied for third in the majors with 112 with Dustin Pedroia... Paul Goldschmidt is first with 118 and Robinson Cano is second (117).

**TRAVIS d'ARNAUD:** Has three home runs, two doubles over his last 11 games... He has at least one hit in eight of those 10 contests... **D'Arnaud is hitting .266 (41-154) with 23 runs scored, 10 doubles, seven home runs and 21 RBI in 42 games since returning from Triple-A on June 24.**

**DAVID WRIGHT:** Is hitting .385 vs. lefthanders this year, the second best mark in the majors... Wright is a career .341 hitter vs. lefties.

**ERIC CAMPBELL:** Is batting .297 vs. lefties... Campbell has four RBI in last five games.

**DAISUKE MATSUZAKA:** Pitched 6.0 innings on Saturday for Binghamton (AA) of the Eastern League at Reading in his second rehabilitation outing... Matsuzaka allowed three hits, one run, earned, and picked up the win in the BMets 2-1 victory in the first game of a doubleheader... Matsuzaka did not issue a walk and struck out three... He threw 69 pitches, 43 strikes... Matsuzaka tossed 3.0 shutout innings for St. Lucie (A) on August 11.

**NYPL ALL-STAR GAME:** Brooklyn's MCU Park will host tonight's New York-Penn League All-Star Game... The Cyclones have six members on the team: RHP Marcos Molina, RHP Corey Oswalt, shortstop Amed Rosario, LHP Shane Bay and third baseman Jhoan Urena and outfielder Michael Bernal.

**GRANDERSON BOBBLEHEAD:** The first 20,000 fans on Saturday, August 30 will receive a Curtis Granderson bobblehead courtesy of Gold's.

**LAST START:** Received the loss in the Mets' 4-1 defeat against the Washington Nationals on August 14 at Citi Field...Pitched 6.0 innings, allowing four earned runs and four hits...Struck out three with four walks...Allowed home runs to Adam LaRoche and Bryce Harper.

**LOSING STREAK:** Has lost a career-high four straight decisions, receiving the loss in four of his last six games...The Mets have lost in five of Gee's six starts since the All Star Break, dating to July 19...Over this span, Gee is 0-4 with a 5.60 ERA (22 earned runs/35.1 innings pitched) with 29 strikeouts and 15 walks...Gee has the highest ERA and is tied with Jonathon Niese, Sonny Gray and Colby Lewis for the most losses in the majors since July 19 (minimum 35.0 innings pitched)...Before the All-Star Break, Gee was 4-1 with a 2.56 ERA (17 earned runs/59.2 innings pitched), with 37 strikeouts and 16 walks in nine starts.

**HOME RUNS:** Has allowed eight home runs over his last six starts (35.1 innings pitched)...Allowed five home runs over his first three starts of the season (19.2 innings pitched)...Has allowed 14 home runs over 95.0 innings pitched for a 1.33 HR/9 rate, sixth-highest in the NL and 12th-highest in the majors (minimum 90.0 innings pitched).

**WALKS:** Allowed a season-high tying four walks in his last start on August 14...Has walked three or more batters in four straight games, the longest streak of his career...Has allowed 31 walks over 95.0 innings pitched for a BB/9 rate of 2.94.

**NO EARLY EXITS:** Has gone at least 6.0 innings in 32 of his last 37 starts, dating to May 30, 2013 and in 11 of 15 starts this season...The last time Gee pitched fewer than 5.0 innings in a start was on May 14, 2013 against St. Louis at Busch Stadium.

**BATTING AVERAGE AGAINST:** Opposing batters are hitting .216 (75-347) against Gee, fourth-lowest in the NL...His 1.12 WHIP is ninth-lowest in the NL (minimum 90.0 innings pitched).

**STRIKEOUTS:** Has 66 strikeouts in 95.0 innings pitched for a K/9 rate of 6.25...Is tied with Los Angeles' Kevin Correia with the fourth-fewest strikeouts in the majors (minimum 90.0 innings pitched)...Of Gee's 66 strikeouts, 46 of them (70%) have been swinging.

**RUNNERS ON:** Batters are hitting .255 (14-55) with 10 strikeouts and five extra-base hits with runners in scoring position...Batters have a .185 (5-27) mark with seven strikeouts and two extra-base hits (both doubles) with runners in scoring position and two outs...Batters are hitting .250 (2-8) with the bases loaded with one strikeout and no extra-base hits.

**EARLY SUCCESS:** Batters have a .196 average (37-189) against Gee for his first 50 pitches...From pitch 51 onwards, batters are hitting .241 (38-158)...The first time around the order batters have a .205 batting average (25-122) against Gee...Batters leading off an inning are hitting .154 (14-91) and batters have a .208 average (11-53) in the first inning.

**RUN SUPPORT:** Gee is 0-5 with a 5.55 ERA (22 earned runs/35.2 innings pitched) when the Mets score two or fewer runs...When the Mets score three or more runs, Gee is 4-0 with a 2.58 ERA (17 earned runs/59.1 innings pitched).

**INJURY:** Was placed on the 15-Day Disabled List on May 14, retroactive to May 11, with a strained right lat...Gee was 3-1 when he went on the DL with an ERA of 2.73 (16 earned runs/52.2 innings pitched) and 33 strikeouts after eight starts...Since returning from the DL on July 9, Gee is 1-4 with a 4.89 ERA (23 earned runs/42.1 innings pitched) with 33 strikeouts in seven starts.

**STRONG STRETCH:** Since May 30, 2013, Gee has a 14-10 record with a 3.09 ERA (84 earned runs/244.1 innings pitched)...During this time his 3.09 ERA is the 11th-lowest in the NL (minimum 240.0 innings pitched), behind teammate Bartolo Colon...Los Angeles' Clayton Kershaw leads the majors with a 1.88 ERA (63 earned runs/301.0 innings pitched) over this span.
