OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** now lead the season series against Los Angeles 7-3, and are 4-0 at home against the Angels...are now 2-1 on this five-game homestand against New York (1-1) and Los Angeles (1-0).
- Sonny Gray tossed 8.1 innings and snapped his career-high four-game losing streak...it was his longest outing since tossing a complete game April 28 at Texas...was 0-4 with a 4.94 ERA (13 er in 23.2 ip) in four starts during the losing streak after going 6-0 with a 2.11 ERA over his previous seven starts...is 9-1 with a 2.15 ERA (17 er in 71.0 ip) in 10 starts against the American League West this season...allowed a season-high two home runs.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 4, 2 r, 2b, hr, rbi, so) hit his 15th career first inning leadoff home run, his 13th with the A's...the 13 with the A's moves him into a tie with Bert Campaneris for the third-most in Athletics history (most: Rickey Henderson, 43).
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 4, so) is 3 for 24 (.125) over his last seven games.
- Craig Gentry (1 for 3, bb, so) was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list today and singled in the first inning...was 4 for 29 (.138) over his final 12 games before being placed on the disabled list with a broken right hand on July 28.
- Derek Norris (1 for 3, bb, so) is 3 for 8 on the homestand after going 2 for 23 on the last road trip.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels are now 6-2 on their 10-game roadtrip to Texas (2-1), Boston (4-0), and Oakland (0-1).
- Hector Santiago tossed five innings and is now 3-2 with a 2.53 ERA (18 er in 64.0 ip) in 14 games (11 starts) since being recalled from Triple-A Salt Lake City on June 10...is 1-3 with a 2.39 ERA (7 er in 26.1 ip) in six career appearances (four starts) against the Athletics.
- Hank Conger (0 for 2, so, sac) extended his hitless streak to 0 for his last 13.
- David Freese (2 for 4) has hit safely in 16 of his last 18 games...is batting .338 (24 for 71) over his last 21 games.
- Mike Trout (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi) hit his 28th home run of the season in the first inning...20 of his 28 home runs this season have given the Angels the lead.
