OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** went 3-2 on this five-game homestand against New York-NL (1-1) and Los Angeles-AL (2-1)...now lead the season series against Los Angeles 8-4...loss snapped a five-game home winning streak against the Angels...marks their first home loss to Los Angeles since Sept. 18, 2013.
- Scott Kazmir allowed a season-high tying seven runs (also June 24 at New York-NL) and season-high tying 10 hits (also August 3 vs. Kansas City)...fell to 5-4 with a 4.57 ERA (32 er in 63.0 ip) over his last 11 starts after going 9-2 with a 2.08 ERA over his first 15 starts.
- Alberto Callaspo (3 for 4, 2b, hr, 2 rbi, so) is 12 for 30 (.400) over his last nine games after going 9 for 42 (.214) over his first 13 games after being reinstated from the disabled list July 27...is 6 for 16 (.375) with a double, triple and home run all-time against Weaver.
- Brandon Moss (0 for 4, so) is 0 for his last 18...is batting .158 (9 for 57) with no home runs, four RBI and 26 strikeouts in 18 games in August...has not homered since July 24 and his 24-game homerless streak is his longest as an Athletic.
- Andy Parrino (2 for 4, r, hr, rbi, so) hit his first home run as an Athletic and his first Major League home run since April 8, 2012 vs. Los Angeles-NL (with SD).

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The Los Angeles Angels went 7-3 on their 10-game road trip to Texas (2-1), Boston (4-0), and Oakland (1-2)...now have sole possession of first place in the American League West by one game over the Athletics...the two teams play each other seven times over the final 33 games of the season.
- Jared Weaver improved to 4-1 with a 2.49 ERA (12 er in 43.1 ip) in his last six starts at O.co Coliseum...the Angels are 11-2 in his last 13 overall starts.
- Erick Aybar (2 for 4, r, 2b, 2 rbi) has hit safely in nine consecutive games...is 15 for 34 (.441) with two doubles and six runs scored over the streak.
- Kole Calhoun (3 for 5, r, 2b, rbi, so) is 14 for 35 (.400) against the Athletics this season...is 23 for 64 (.359) with seven doubles, two home runs and 12 RBI over his last 15 games and is 99 for 322 (.307) when batting leadoff.
- **Josh Hamilton** (2 for 3, 2 r, hr, 3 rbi) is 6 for 16 (.375) with two home runs and eight RBI over his last five games after going 5 for 41 (.122) with no home runs and 18 strikeouts over his previous 11 contests...all 10 of his home runs this season have come on the road...last home run at Angel Stadium came on August 18, 2013 vs. Houston.
- Mike Trout (2 for 5, 2 r, hr, rbi, so) has homered in six of his seven games at the O.co Coliseum this season...since the beginning of 2013, is 20 for 63 (.317) with eight home runs and 18 RBI in 14 games in Oakland...has more home runs than any other visiting player at the Coliseum since the beginning of 2013.
