OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** scored five runs in the first inning after scoring just four runs over their four previous games...are 1-0 on this six-game homestand against Seattle (1-0) and Houston (three games).
- **Jason Hammel** tossed a season-high 8.0 innings (previous: 7.0 innings, nine times)...recorded his 10th win of the season between both leagues (second with the Athletics) to match his career high (third time, 2009 and 2010 with Colorado)...is 2-1 with a 2.40 ERA (8 er in 30.0 ip) over his last five starts after going 0-4 with a 9.53 ERA over his first four starts with the A's.
- Adam Dunn (2 for 3, r, hr, 2 rbi, so) hit a two-run home run in his first at-bat...became the 12th player in history to hit a home run in his first at-bat with the Oakland Athletics (last: Josh Willingham, April 1, 2011 vs. Seattle)...recorded his 461st career home run, which ties him with David Ortiz for 35th most in MLB history.
- · Jed Lowrie (2 for 4, r) was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list today and hit a single in his first at bat.
- Brandon Moss (0 for 3, r, bb, so) extended hit hitless streak to 0 for his last 13...has not hit a home run since July 24, and his 31-game homerless streak is his longest as an Athletic.
- Josh Reddick (2 for 4, 2 r, 2b, bb) is batting .291 (35 for 120) with 23 runs, nine doubles, and six home runs in 36 games since the All-Star Break after batting .229 with 21 runs, three doubles, and four home runs in 54 games before the break.
- Eric Sogard (2 for 4, rbi, so) is batting .287 (25 for 87) with 17 runs scored, 15 walks and 11 RBI in 33 games since the All-Star Break after hitting .186 with 18 runs, 14 walks and nine RBI in 63 games before the break.

- The Seattle Mariners are 1-4 over their last four games...are 0-1 on this seven-game road trip to Oakland (0-1) and Texas (four games).
- Chris Young tossed a season-low 0.2 innings and allowed a season-high tying five earned runs (second time, last: May 16 at Minnesota)...was 1-1 with a 2.25 ERA (5 er in 20.0 ip) against the Athletics this season prior to today's start.
- Carson Smith made his major league debut in the eighth inning.
- Endy Chavez (1 for 2, bb) is batting .355 (16 for 45) with five runs, five doubles, one home run, 10 RBI, and six walks over his last 18 games (since August 6).
- Austin Jackson (0 for 4) had his 11-game hitting streak snapped...was 15 for 47 (.319) with two doubles, one triple, two RBI and three walks over the streak.
- Mike Zunino (0 for 3, 2 so) extended hit hitless streak to 0 for his last 14.
