OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost six of their last eight games...are 7-15 over the last 22 contests...are 1-1 on this six-game homestand against Seattle (1-1) and Houston (three games).
- Sonny Gray** allowed six earned runs in five innings pitched...the six earned runs ties a season-high (once, 8/6 vs. Tampa Bay)...was previously 4-0 with a 1.10 ERA (4 er in 32.2 ip) in six career starts against Seattle...went 5.0 innings or fewer for just the third time this season (4.1 ip; 6/28 at Miami and 5.0 ip; 8/6 vs. Tampa Bay).
- Alberto Callaspo** (0 for 2) has an 0 for 14 hitless streak...is 1 for his last 29 after going 8 for 17 (.471) in his previous homestand.
- Josh Donaldson** (0 for 4, 2 so) had an eight-game hitting streak snapped.
- Craig Gentry** (3 for 4, 2 rbi, 2b) snapped an 0 for 16 hitless streak with a single in the 4th inning...was the longest hitless streak of his career...collected a season-high tying three hits (previous: once, 4/15 at Los Angeles-AL)...had his first multi-hit game since July 20 against Baltimore.
- Brandon Moss** (1 for 1, 2b, rbi) collected his first RBI since August 12 at Kansas City.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** are 38-27 on the road this season after tonight's win, compared to 36-36 at home...the .585 road winning percentage is currently the 2nd-best in club history behind the 2001 Mariners (.728/59-22)...are 1-1 on a seven-game road trip to Oakland (1-1) and Texas (four games).
- James Paxton** made his first career start against the A's...has a 1.77 ERA (14 er in 71 ip) through his first 12 career starts.
- Fernando Rodney** collected his 40th save of the season...this is the second 40-save season of his career (48, 2012 with Rays)...becomes just the third Mariners reliever with 40 or more saves in a season, joining Kazuhiro Sasaki (45) and J.J Putz (40).
- Robinson Cano** (1 for 4, r) has hit safely in 22 of his last 23 games against the A's (since Sept. 22, 2012)...has hit .351 (33 for 94) with 13 runs, seven doubles, two home runs and 13 RBI during the streak.
- Endy Chavez** (1 for 1, r, 2b, 2 rbi, bb) is batting .380 (16 for 42) with five runs, six doubles, one home run, 12 RBI, and six walks over his last 19 games (since August 6).
- Logan Morrison** (2 for 4, r, 2b, so) has a career-best 15-game road hitting streak since July 19...is hitting .352 (19 for 54) with six runs, six doubles and six RBI during the streak.
