OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost seven of their last nine games...are 7-16 over the last 23 contests...are 1-2 on this six-game homestand against Seattle (1-2) and Houston (three games).
- Jon Lester** tossed eight innings and allowed a season-high tying two home runs (third time, last: August 17 at Atlanta)...is 4-4 with a 3.80 ERA (31 er in 73.1 ip) in 11 career starts against the Mariners...is 3-3 with a 2.59 ERA (14 er in 48.2 ip) in seven starts since being acquired from the Red Sox on July 31.
- Josh Donaldson** (0 for 4) is 1 for 13 (.077) on the homestand after hitting safely in all seven games on the last road trip (12 for 24, .500).
- Adam Dunn** (1 for 4, r, hr, rbi, 2 so) hit his second home run in two starts with the Athletics...it was the 462nd home run of his career, which ties him with Jose Canseco for 34th on the MLB all-time list.
- Sam Fuld** (0 for 4, so) is 10 for 52 (.192) over his last 19 games.
- Jed Lowrie** (1 for 3) is 3 for 11 (.272) in three games since his return from the 15-day disabled list on Monday.
- Stephen Vogt** (1 for 2) left the game in the top of the seventh inning with a sprained left ankle.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** are 39-27 on the road this season compared to 36-36 at home...the .590 road winning percentage is currently the 2nd-best in club history behind the 2001 Mariners (.728/59-22)...Kyle Seager and Corey Hart hit back-to-back home runs in the seventh inning...it was the fourth time the Mariners hit back-to-back home runs this season (last: Seager and Ackley, May 11 vs. Kansas City, fourth inning), and the second time that Seager and Hart went back-to-back (April 2 at Los Angeles-AL, ninth inning)...are 2-1 on a seven-game road trip to Oakland (2-1) and Texas (four games).
- Felix Hernandez** has now pitched over 200.0 innings on the season...is the first pitcher in Mariners history to record six seasons in which he pitched 200.0 innings while recording at least 200 strikeouts (previous high: Randy Johnson, five seasons)...is 6-0 with a 1.98 ERA (15 er in 68.1 ip) in nine starts at the O.co Coliseum since April 1, 2011.
- Robinson Cano** (1 for 4, 2b, so) has hit safely in 23 of his last 24 games against the A's (since Sept. 22, 2012)...has hit .347 (34 for 98) with 13 runs, eight doubles, two home runs and 13 RBI over that span.
- Chris Denorfia** (0 for 4) extended his hitless streak to 0 for his last 14.
- Kyle Seager** (3 for 4, r, 2b, hr, rbi) hit his 22nd home run of the season, which matches his career high (2013)...leads the Mariners in extra-base hits on the season with 53.
