PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (70-83) vs. OAKLAND ATHLETICS (83-69)

Friday, September 19, 2014 – O.co Coliseum – 9:35 p.m. EDT – Game 154; Road 76

RHP David Buchanan (6-7, 3.75) vs. LHP Jon Lester (15-10, 2.45)

- LAST NIGHT'S ACTION:** The Phillies lost to the San Diego Padres, 7-3, at Petco Park ... Starter Kyle Kendrick (L, 9-13) threw 5.0 innings, allowing 3 ER on 6 hits while walking 5 (tied season high) and striking out 2 ... Alexi Amarista gave the Padres an early 1-0 lead with a solo HR ... Philadelphia tied it up in the top of the 4th on an RBI single by Domonic Brown ... But the Padres then scored one run each in the 4th (Amarista sac fly), 5th (Smith RBI single) and 6th innings (Spangenberg RBI single) ... Will Venable crushed a 2-out, 3-run HR in the bottom of the 8th inning to give the Padres a 7-1 lead ... Cesar Hernandez and Ben Revere added RBI singles in the top of the 9th, but the Phils rally fell short.
- ISN'T IT IRONIC?:** Sixty years ago today, on September 19, 1954, the Philadelphia Athletics played their final home game of the season, a 4-2 loss to the New York Yankees at Shibe Park (attendance: 1,715), but it turned out to be their last game ever in Philadelphia ... At an American League owners meeting on November 18, 1954, approval was granted to have the team sold and moved to Kansas City ... The franchise was a charter member of the American League when it formed in 1901 ... The A's played 54 seasons in Philadelphia (1901-54), 13 in Kansas City (1955-67), and are now in the midst of their 47th season in Oakland (1968-present) ... The Phillies, on the other hand, played their first game on May 1, 1883, and remain the oldest, continuous, one-nickname, one-city franchise in all of professional sports.
- THE HOLLOW OAK:** Tonight, the Phillies and A's begin their fifth-ever series against each other and first since 2011 ... The two clubs have evenly split their previous four series, with the home team winning every series (2 in OAK, 2 in PHI), and they have an even 6-6 record in their 12 games all-time ... The Phillies have not traveled to Oakland since June of 2008 ... In their last game here, OAK's Rich Harden defeated PHI's Adam Eaton by throwing 8.0 shutout innings (2 H, 1 BB) with 11 strikeouts ... Overall, Philadelphia has gone 2-4 in their previous six games at the Coliseum.
- INTERLEAGUE FATIGUE:** The Phillies have won five of their last eight Interleague games but are just 6-11 overall against AL clubs this season (.353), which is tied for the 5th-lowest Interleague winning percentage in the majors ... They have been swept four times in seven total series by AL opponents in 2014, each coming in two-game sets (vs TOR, at TOR, vs LAA, at LAA) ... Philadelphia lost eight straight games vs AL teams from April 1 through May 14, which was their 2nd-longest Interleague losing streak in franchise history (previous: 9 G, 6/14-8/29/97) ... Since the beginning of the 2012 season, Philadelphia has a .346 winning percentage (18-34) in Interleague play, T-28th among all ML clubs (also: HOU) ... The Phillies have the 2nd-highest Interleague ERA over that stretch (4.99, 260 ER, 468.2 IP) and have been outscored 289-199 ... Philadelphia has an all-time record of 133-169 (.440) in 302 Interleague games (73-84 at home, 60-85 on the road) with three IL games remaining on their schedule this season.
- THE DIVIDING LINE:** Including last night's loss, Philadelphia is just 16-59 (.213) this season when scoring three runs or less in a game ... On the flip side, they are 54-24 (.692) when scoring four or more runs.
- FORMULA 50:** Phillies center fielder **Ben Revere** is only three steals away from the half-century mark this season ... Revere's 47 stolen bases are the most by a Phillie since Jimmy Rollins also swiped 47 bags in 2008 ... Current 1st base coach, **Juan Samuel**, was the last Phillie to steal 50 or more bases in a single season, swiping 53 bags in 1985.
- WHAT A RELIEF!:** Since August 5, the Phillies bullpen has posted a Major League-best 2.44 ERA (32 ER, 118.0 IP in 41 games) ... During that span, Phillies relievers have held opposing hitters to a .290 slugging %, best in the majors, and a .207 average, 2nd-best in MLB ... The Philadelphia bullpen employs three of the top 10 leaders in strikeouts per 9.0 innings in the NL this season: Ken Giles (4th, 13.08), Jake Diekman (5th, 12.64) and Antonio Bastardo (10th, 11.30).
- RY-NOTES:** Inducted to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 2005 (76.2% of the vote), **Ryne Sandberg** spent 16 years in the major leagues with the Philadelphia Phillies (1981) and Chicago Cubs (1982-94; 1996-97) ... He won the 1984 NL MVP Award, was a 10-time All-Star, and won nine gold gloves and seven Silver Slugger Awards ... From 1982-93, Sandberg led all NL players in hits, runs, total bases, at-bats and times on base ... He was originally selected by the Phillies in the 20th round of the 1978 draft before being traded to Chicago following the 1981 season ... In 2,164 career games, Sandberg batted .285 with 282 HR, 1,061 RBI and 344 stolen bases ... Sandberg spent six years as a manager in the minor leagues for single-A Peoria (2007-08), double-A Tennessee (2009), triple-A Iowa (2010) and triple-A Lehigh Valley (2011-12) ... "Ryno" was named 2010 Manager of the Year for the Pacific Coast League and Minor League Manager of the Year in 2011 by *Baseball America*.

LAST START – 9/14 vs MIA: ND, 6.1 IP, 5 H, R, ER, BB, 2 SO, (Buchanan vs Koehler) ... Phillies lost 5-4 ... The Phillies took a 4-1 lead into the 9th inning as Jonathan Papelbon entered looking for his 15th consecutive save ... Papelbon allowed 4 runs on 4 hits and a walk, needing 38 total pitches to finish the inning as he blew his first save since July ... The Phils closer was then ejected by 2nd base umpire Joe West following the top of the 9th inning ... The Phillies went just 3-for-17 with runners in scoring position on the day.

TONIGHT'S START:

- Rookie on a Run:** Has allowed 3 ER or less in each of his last 14 starts (since 6/14) which is the longest streak by a Phillies rookie since Bruce Ruffin went 16 straight starts in 1986 (7/23-10/5/86) ... Buchanan is 5-4, 3.07 ERA (28 ER, 82.0 IP) in that span ... Has allowed 2 ER or fewer in 9 of those 14 starts and in each of his last 6
- Has allowed 2 ER or fewer in each of his last 6 starts (2.38 ERA, 9 ER, 34.0 IP, since 8/17) ... **Has the lowest ERA of any Phils starter over that span (Hamels: 2.58)**
- Has posted a 3.34 ERA (37 ER, 99.2 IP) in 17 of his 18 starts this season** ... Allowed 7 ER in 6.0 IP in his other start, 6/3 at WSH

ROAD:

- 2-4, 3.65 ERA (20 ER, 49.1 IP) in 8 games ... **Is 2-2, 2.17 ERA (9 ER, 37.1 IP) over his last 6 road starts (since 6/19)** ... Began his career 0-2, 8.25 ERA (11 ER, 12.0 IP) in his first 2 starts away from CBP

2014 SEASON:

- Was recalled from Lehigh Valley on 8/6 (Neris optioned) ... Went 1-1, 3.86 ERA (7 ER, 16.1 IP) in 3 starts for LV after being optioned from PHI on 7/11
- Won 3 consecutive starts (6/14-24: 3-0, 3.06 ERA, 6 ER, 17.2 IP) ... Became the first Phillies rookie to win three consecutive starts since Vance Worley, 8/23-9/6/11
- Made his ML debut, 5/24 vs LAD (W, 5.0 IP, 2 ER, 2 SO)
- Became the 1st Phillies starting pitcher to earn the win in his ML debut since Antonio Bastardo, 6/2/09 at SD and the 1st Phillies pitcher since Jake Diekman, 5/15/12 vs HOU
- Was a non-roster invitee to Major League Spring Training ... Went 1-1, 2.25 ERA (3 ER, 12.0 IP) in 5 games (4 starts) ... Held opposing batters to a .146 average (6-41)
- Went 6-2, 3.95 ERA (25 ER, 57.0 IP) in 12 starts for LV ... Pigs went 7-5 (.583) in his 12 starts
- Went 5-1 2.84 ERA (14 ER, 44.1 IP) in 8 night starts with LV this season ... Went 1-1, 7.82 ERA (11 ER, 12.2 IP) in 4 starts during the day for the IronPigs
- Is 10-4, 3.56 ERA (38 ER, 96.0 IP) in his first 18 career triple-A starts ... Lehigh Valley is 11-7 (.611) in those 18 starts
- Allowed 3 ER or less in 9 of his 12 starts for Lehigh Valley
- Scratched from his start on 5/8 at Charlotte due to inflammation in his non-pitching shoulder ... Hurt his left shoulder diving for a bunt on 5/3 at Gwinnett
- Had a 5-game winning streak to begin the season (8 GS, 5-0, 3.18 ERA)
- Tied a LV franchise record by winning 4 consecutive starts (4/21-5/13, 4-0, 3.57 ERA, 9 ER, 22.2 IP) ... Done 12 times by 11 different pitchers in IronPigs history
- Was the Opening Day starter for LV (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 5 SO) ... Pigs won 4-0

CAREER:

- Minors:** 36-28, 3.98 ERA (229 ER, 518.1 IP) in 91 games (all starts)
- Selected by the Phillies in the 7th round of the June 2010 draft out of Georgia State University ... Originally selected by the New York Mets in 6th round of June 2009 draft, but did not sign
- Is the first player from Georgia State University to ever play in the major leagues**
- Named a 2011 South Atlantic League Mid-Season All-Star with Lakewood (A)
