PHILADELPHIA PHILLIES (71-84) vs. OAKLAND ATHLETICS (84-70)

Sunday, September 21, 2014 – O.co Coliseum – 4:05 p.m. EDT – Game 156; Road 78

RHP A.J. Burnett (8-17, 4.40) vs. LHP Scott Kazmir (14-9, 3.44)

- LAST NIGHT'S ACTION:** The Phillies snapped their short 2-game losing streak with a 3-0 shutout win over the A's ... Jerome Williams earned the win (4-2) pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing only 5 baserunners before letting the bullpen take over ... Antonio Bastardo and Ken Giles combined for 2.0 scoreless innings of relief with Giles picking up his first major league save with a perfect 9th inning ... Offensively, the Phillies were locked in a scoreless tie before Freddy Galvis hit a 2-run homer in the 7th inning scoring Cody Asche, who had doubled ... Marlon Byrd added an RBI single in the 8th inning.
- THREE'S A CHARM:** Yesterday, Jerome Williams made major league history by becoming the first pitcher ever to record 3 wins over the same team in one season for 3 different teams ... Before earning yesterday's win over the A's in a Phillies uniform, Williams had previously defeated them for the Houston Astros on April 26 (in relief), then again on July 25 for the Texas Rangers (in a start) ... Overall this season, Williams is 3-0 with a 2.25 ERA against Oakland in 5 games (2 starts).
- SUNDAY BLOODY SUNDAY:** The Phillies have not won a road game on a Sunday since April 27 at ARI, going 0-9 in their last nine tries ... Additionally, Philadelphia has won just three of their last 17 games on Sunday's ... Since May 25, their only Sunday wins came on July 27 vs ARI (4-2), August 10 vs NYM (7-6) and August 24 vs STL (7-1) ... The Phillies began the season with a 5-2 record on Sunday's, but have fallen to 8-16 (.333) for the season.
- THE HOLLOW OAK:** The Phillies and A's are playing their fifth series against each other and first since 2011 ... The two clubs have evenly split their previous four series, with the home team winning every series (2 in OAK, 2 in PHI), and the Phillies have a 7-7 record in their 14 games all-time ... This is the Phillies first trip to Oakland since June of 2008 ... Overall, Philadelphia has gone 3-5 in their eight games at the Coliseum.
- INTERLEAGUE FATIGUE:** The Phillies have won six of their last 10 Interleague games but are just 7-12 (.368) overall against AL clubs this season, which is the 14th-worst Interleague winning percentage in the NL, ahead of only Cincinnati (6-14, .300) ... They have been swept four times in eight total series by AL opponents in 2014, seven of them coming in two-game sets (vs TOR, at TOR, vs LAA, at LAA) ... Philadelphia lost eight straight games vs AL teams from April 1 through May 14, which was their 2nd-longest Interleague losing streak in franchise history (previous: 9 G, 6/14-8/29/97) ... Since the beginning of the 2012 season, Philadelphia has a .352 winning percentage (19-35) in Interleague play, 29th among all ML clubs (COL - .255, 14-41) ... The Phillies have the 2nd-highest Interleague ERA over that stretch (4.87, 263 ER, 485.2 IP) and have been outscored 292-203 ... Philadelphia has an all-time record of 134-170 (.441) in 304 Interleague games (73-84 at home, 61-86 on the road) with one IL game remaining on their schedule this season.
- THE DIVIDING LINE:** Following yesterday's win, Philadelphia is just 17-60 (.221) this season when scoring three runs or less in a game ... On the flip side, they are 54-24 (.692) when scoring four or more runs.
- FORMULA 50:** Phillies center fielder **Ben Revere** is only three steals away from the half-century mark this season ... Revere's 47 stolen bases are the most by a Phillie since Jimmy Rollins also swiped 47 bags in 2008 ... Current 1st base coach, **Juan Samuel**, was the last Phillie to steal 50 or more bases in a single season, swiping 53 bags in 1985.
- WHAT A RELIEF!:** Since August 5, the Phillies bullpen has posted a Major League-best 2.37 ERA (32 ER, 121.1 IP in 43 games) ... During that span, Phillies relievers have held opposing hitters to a .290 slugging %, best in the majors, and a .207 average, 2nd-best in MLB ... The Philadelphia bullpen employs three of the top 10 leaders in strikeouts per 9.0 innings in the NL this season: Ken Giles (4th, 13.08), Jake Diekman (5th, 12.64) and Antonio Bastardo (10th, 11.30).
- RY-NOTES:** Inducted to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 2005 (76.2% of the vote), **Ryne Sandberg** spent 16 years in the major leagues with the Philadelphia Phillies (1981) and Chicago Cubs (1982-94; 1996-97) ... He won the 1984 NL MVP Award, was a 10-time All-Star, and won nine gold gloves and seven Silver Slugger Awards ... From 1982-93, Sandberg led all NL players in hits, runs, total bases, at-bats and times on base ... He was originally selected by the Phillies in the 20th round of the 1978 draft before being traded to Chicago following the 1981 season ... In 2,164 career games, Sandberg batted .285 with 282 HR, 1,061 RBI and 344 stolen bases ... Sandberg spent six years as a manager in the minor leagues for single-A Peoria (2007-08), double-A Tennessee (2009), triple-A Iowa (2010) and triple-A Lehigh Valley (2011-12) ... "Ryno" was named 2010 Manager of the Year for the Pacific Coast League and Minor League Manager of the Year in 2011 by *Baseball America*.

LAST START – 9/16 at SD: L, 5.2 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 4 ER, 4 BB, 4 SO ... (Burnett vs Kennedy) ... Phillies lost 5-4 ... The Padres jumped out to a 2-0 lead in the 1st inning on a leadoff triple, RBI single by Cory Spangenberg, an RBI single by Wil Venable, and a run scoring groundout by Yasmani Grandal ... The Phillies also committed two errors in the frame (throwing E by Burnett, missed catch E by Howard) ... Domonic Brown cut the lead in half with a solo homer in the 2nd inning ... Then, in the top of the 5th, Freddy Galvis ripped a 2-run homer off Ian Kennedy to give the Phillies a 3-2 lead ... But it was short lived, as Burnett surrendered 3 runs on 4 hits in the 6th inning ... Darin Ruf's RBI single in the 9th cut the lead to 1, but the Phillies rally fell short as Cody Asche popped out to end the game.

TODAY'S START:

- **All-Timer:** Ranks 44th on MLB's all-time strikeout list (2,360) ... **Sits just 2 strikeouts shy of tying Charlie Hough for 43rd place all-time**
- **Losing Control:** Has a career-high 17 losses this season, the most by a Phillies starter since Mark Leiter lost 17 games in 1997 ... The last Phillies pitcher to lose 18 games or more in a single season was Hall of Famer Steve Carlton who went 13-20 in 1973
- Burnett has taken the loss in 9 of his last 12 starts (2-9, since 7/18), but has been given just 2.28 runs of support per 9.0 innings over that stretch
- **vs OAK:** 5-4, 3.82 ERA (30 ER, 70.2 IP) in 11 career games
- **Interleague:** 23-16 (.590), 3.75 ERA (135 ER, 323.2 IP) in 50 career starts ... **His .590 career winning percentage in Interleague Play ranks 4th all time (min. 45 GS), trailing only Mark Buehrle (.744), CC Sabathia (.727) and Mike Mussina (.618)**
- **Interleague Strikeouts:** His 297 career strikeouts in Interleague Play rank 2nd all time trailing only Randy Johnson (309 SO)
- **Walking Wounded:** His 87 walks this season are most in the majors ... Is averaging 3.86 BB/9.0 IP (87 BB, 202.2 IP) in 32 starts this season ... Averaged 2.95 BB/9.0 IP (129 BB, 393.1 IP) over 61 starts from 2012-13 ... Has surpassed his BB total from 2012 (62) and 2013 (67) ... Career-high is 97 BB set in 2009 with NYY
- **I'm Bat-Man:** Had a career-high 3 hits, 4/22 at LAD ... His 8 hits (59 AB) this season equal his total from the previous 4 seasons combined (2010-13, 8-125) ... Needs just 2 hits to tie his career-high of 10 set in 2005
- Is one of only six active pitchers with at least 150 career wins ... His 155 career wins rank 5th among active ML pitchers trailing only Tim Hudson (214), CC Sabathia (208), Bartolo Colon (203) & Mark Buehrle (198)

2014 SEASON:

- Moved into 44th place on MLB's all-time strikeouts list on 9/16 at SD, passing Hall of Famer and Phillies legend Robin Roberts (2,357)
- Struck out a season-high 12 batters on 8/25 vs WSH becoming the only pitcher in ML history to have a 12 strikeout game for 5 different teams
- Received his first career ejection on 8/2 from home plate umpire Chris Guccione
- Tossed his 24th career CG on 6/20 at STL ... It was his 1st CG since 8/4/13 vs COL
- Left his start vs MIA on 4/11 for precautionary reasons in the 5th inning due to right groin soreness ... Later diagnosed as a non-sports hernia

CAREER:

- Started and won Game 2 of the 2009 World Series, 10/29 vs PHI
- Led the AL with 231 SO in 2008 and the NL with 5 SHO in 2002
- Pitched the 3rd no-hitter in FLA history in his 2nd start of the season, 5/12/01 at SD ... Became the 1st pitcher in the modern era to issue 9 walks in a 9.0-inning no-hitter
- Selected by the New York Mets in the 8th round of the June 1995 draft out of Central Arkansas High School
