OAKLAND NOTES

- The Oakland Athletics are 5-4 over their last nine games...are 3-4 on their final, nine-game homestand against Texas (0-3), Philadelphia (2-1) and Los Angeles-AL (1-0).
- **Jeff Samardzija** had his 16.0-inning scoreless streak snapped in the first inning when the Angels scored an unearned run, however he maintains a streak of 23.0 innings of not allowing an earned run.
- Coco Crisp (2 for 5) is batting .319 (15 for 47) with 10 runs in 14 games against Los Angeles this season.
- Josh Donaldson (0 for 2, r, 3 bb) recorded a career-high tying three walks (third time, last: May 18 at Cleveland).
- Sam Fuld (0 for 4, r, bb, 2 so) is batting .169 (11 for 65) in 20 games in September.
- Geovany Soto (1 for 4, r, 2 rbi, so) has hit safely in each of his four games against Lost Angeles this year, and now has an 11-game hitting streak against the Angels (15 for 39, .385)...is a .313 (21 for 67) career hitter against Los Angeles, which is his best mark against any American League team.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The **Los Angeles Angels** had their eight-game road winning streak snapped...the record was the fourth longest road winning streak in club history (longest: 11, July 6-August 2, 1998).
- C.J. Wilson tossed 0.2 innings, which is the second shortest start of his career (shortest: 0.1 ip, May 11, 2012 at Texas)...allowed a season-high tying six runs (sixth time, last: August 2 at Tampa Bay)...was 5-0 with a 2.79 ERA (16 er in 51.2 ip) over his previous eight starts against the Athletics dating back to Sept. 3, 2012
- Erick Aybar (1 for 4, so) is batting .343 (37 for 108) over his last 31 games.
- Cole Calhoun (1 for 4, r, 2b, so) snapped his 0 for 12 hitless streak with a leadoff double in the first inning.
- · Chris lannetta (2 for 4) is batting .355 (11 for 31) with a double, three home runs and seven RBI against the Athletics this season.
- Albert Pujols (1 for 4, r, hr, 3 rbi) hit a three-run home run in the eighth inning, and now has 1,602nd career RBI...is now one of six players in history to record 1,600 RBI prior to his age 35-year-old season (others: Jimmy Foxx, Lou Gehrig, Alex Rodriguez, Mel Ott, Hank Aaron).
- Mike Trout (1 for 3, r, rbi, so) is batting .315 (23 for 73) with four doubles, three triples, five home runs, 16 RBI and 22 runs scored over his last 21 games.
