LEADING OFF: Halos (96-61) have a +2.5 game lead on Orioles (93-63) for best record race...Tonight, Angels play the second game of the final road trip of season to **Oakland** (9/22-24; 0-1) and Seattle (9/26-28)...LAA is in span of 43 games in 45 days (next off day is 9/25)...<u>Last night's loss snapped an eight-game road win streak</u>...Halos are 9-3 in last 12 road affairs...**On Wednesday** (9/17), Angels clinched the ninth division crown in club history, first since 2009...Marks 10th all-time postseason berth, seventh with Mike Scioscia at the helm (sixth division title under Scioscia tied for most among active managers)...Angels lead MLB with a 96-61 record, one game off best record in club history thru 157 games (97-60 in 2008)...Club has reached 95+ wins for fifth time in team history (club record is 100 wins in 2008)... Halos are 51-26 since July 1, 39-24 in second half and 28-12 in last 40 G but have dropped six of last nine games (1-4 in last five games)... Halos have spent last 37 days in first place (94 days in 2nd place in Club reached 50 home wins (52-29) for ninth time, first since 2008 (50-31)...Angels reached three million fans for 12th consecutive season, an active streak only matched in AL by NYY.

KNOW THIS: Albert Pujols' 520 career HRs rank 21st all-time...Tied at 18th are **Ted Williams, Willie McCovey** & **Frank Thomas** (521)... **Pujols** is two home runs shy of becoming one of six players with at least 13 seasons of 30+ HR (H. Aaron, A. Rodríguez, Ba. Bonds, M. Schmidt and B. Ruth) and one of two (ARod) to do so during their age 34-year-old season or younger.

RBI GUY: With three RBI last night, Pujols passed the 1,600 career RBI mark (1,602)...He is just third player since 1901 to drive in 1600 runs in their first 14 seasons (L. Gehrig and A. Simmons)... He is one of six all-time to reach 1,600 RBI before age 35 season (J. Foxx, L. Gehrig, ARod, M. Ott, H. Aaron)...Pujols has logged his 12th 100-RBI season...One of five all-time to post as many by age-35 campaign (**ARod, Foxx, Gehrig, A. Simmons**)...<u>Pujols has 33 go</u>ahead RBI to lead MLB in 2014 (club record is 34 by Vlad in 2006).

ABOUT THE BULLPEN: Halo bullpen has logged a 2.91 ERA (315 IP - 102 ER) its last 84 appearances to rank 4th in MLB in span since June 20th (.223 BAA; 28/33 saves)...Bullpen posted a 4.46 ERA (.243 BAA) over first 69 outings (16/27 saves) to rank 11th in circuit...Since July 1, Halo bullpen has worked 3+ scoreless frames to end a game 20 times...Since 2011, **Huston Street** has converted 124 of 134 save opps (93%), best mark among all relievers over span (min. 50 SVO)...In 2014 (SD/LAA), he has converted 39 of 42 save opps (15/17 with LAA)...39 saves are a new career-high (prev. 37 in 2006)...65th scoreless appearance for **Joe Smith** Sunday extended Angels single-season club record (prev. 63 by **Francisco** Rodriguez in 2008)...Kevin Jepsen has 64 scoreless outings for the Halos this season.

THE ACE: Jered Weaver became AL's first 18-game winner Saturday...He joins **Nolan Ryan** as only Angels with three 18+ win seasons...Also became 17th AL pitcher to record 1,400 strikeouts in his first nine big league seasons (list includes Bob Feller, Lefty Grove and Walter Johnson)...LAA has won 15 of his last 18 starts.

ABOUT THE OFFENSE: Halos scored seven-or-more runs in eight straight games (Sept. 5-12) to match franchise record set in 1979...Angels lead MLB w/ 761 runs and rank second in run differential (+145; 761-616)...In AL, Halos rank T2nd in AVG (.261), 2nd in OBP (.325), 4th in SLG (.409), 2nd in XBH (478), 2nd in hits (1433) & 3rd in 2Bs (295)...In his last 17 games, Howie Kendrick is 27-for-64 (.422) w/ five doubles, two triples, two HRs, 13 runs & 16 RBI...He has batted cleanup in his last 16 affairs...**Kendrick** is three RBI shy of matching career-best of 75 in 2010... Erick Aybar is batting .339 (43/127) since August 16... David Freese has 21 hits his last 61 at-bats (.344) with five doubles and four home runs.

GOTTA BE THE SHOE: MRI results last Tuesday (9/16) showed a mild strain of the left oblique for Matt Shoemaker (day to day)...His 16 wins are a franchise rookie record (previously 14 by Dean Chance, Marcelino Lopez, Frank Tanana)... Most rookie wins in MLB since Yu Darvish had 16 in 2012 (Justin Verlander had 17 in 2006)...Since July 1, **Shoemaker** has a 2.09 ERA (82 IP - 19 ER) & 1.49 ERA over his last 11 outings (66.2 IP - 11 ER)...Named AL Pitcher and Rookie of the month for August (6-0, 1.31 ERA), ninth MLB player to win both honors in the same calendar month

FIELD GOOD STORY: Halos rank T2nd in A.L. with a .986 fielding ct...Club has committed 82 errors on season (fewest in a non-strike shortened season are 85 in 2009).

PITCHING POINTS: Angels starting pitchers have limited opponent to three earned runs or less in 36 of last 41 games and in 41 of 63 second half games (3.38 starter ERA since ASB; 343 IP – 129 ER)... Halos' team ERA since the break is 3.27 (586.1 IP - 213 ER).

ALBERT'S ALMANAC: Pujols' 520 career HRs rank 21st all-time...Tied are **Ted Williams, Willie McCovey** & **Frank Thomas** (521)... With 1,602 career RBI, he ranks 33rd all-time...Goose Goslin is 32nd (1,610)...Albert's 561 career doubles rank 24th all-time...23rd is Ivan Rodriguez (572)...Pujols has 1,097 career XBH to rank 19th alltime...18th on the list is **Eddie Murray** (1,099)...Albert is 1 of 5 players all-time with 500 HR, 550 2B & 1,500 RBI (Aaron, Murray, Bonds & Palmeiro)...Pujols is 16th player with 2,500 hits, 1,500 runs and 500 HRs and joins Jimmie Foxx, Hank Aaron and Alex Rodriguez as only players to reach milestones by age-34 season...1 of 14 players alltime with at least 13 seasons of 25+ HRs.

FISH WRAP: Mike Trout's 35 HRs and 110 RBI are career-highs of Trout's 35 HRs have tied or given Angels lead...He leads MLB w/ 113 runs, 83 extra-base hits, 333 total bases & leads AL with 110 RBI...83 XBH are a career-high (club record is 88 XBH, G. Anderson in 2002)...35 HRs are most by Angel since 2004 A.L. MVP Vladimir Guerrero in 2004...Trout is first Angel to record 100 RBI and 100 runs in season since **Guerrero** in 2004...Halos have one RBI champion, hitting coach **Don Baylor** with 139 RBI in his 1979 MVP campaign...**Trout** is also one of nine MLB players (since 1914) to have 100 RBI from No. 2 spot **Trout** is just third active player with 300 TBs three times by age 23 – others are **Miguel Cabrera** (4) and Pujols (3)...He is first player since 1901 with 100 career SBs and 90+ career HR by 22-or-younger season... Trout is first player since Ty Cobb (1909) w/ 100+ SB, 300+ RBI & 500+ career hits by age-22 season...<u>THE RUN AROUND:</u> Trout is one of six players all-time with three 100-run campaigns before age 23 season (Mel Ott, Buddy Lewis, Ted Williams, Vada Pinson & ARod)...<u>He currently leads MLB in runs (112), on pace to be first player in MLB history to lead either</u> league in runs scored in his first three full MLB seasons (STATS)...Can become first player (of any age or career point) to lead AL in runs for three consecutive seasons since Mickey Mantle in 1956, 1957 and 1958 (ELIAS).

THIS AND THAT: Trout's 97 career HRs prior to age-23 season sixth-most all time and one shy of matching Frank Robinson for fifth (98)...**John McDonald** celebrates his 40th birthday tomorrow... Garrett Richards was voted as the Nick Adenhart Award recipient for team pitcher of the year...Mike Trout joins Bobby Knoop (1964-66) and **Garret Anderson** (2001-03) as only players to earn Angels team MVP in three straight seasons...**Angels 10-game win streak (Sept. 4**-13) matched second longest in club history...Halos are 27-2 in last 29 G when Kole Calhoun scores a run (34-3 since July 1 & 47-12 overall)...Angels have posted a club-record five 4-game sweeps in 2014 (vs. HOU, @TEX, @BOS, vs. OAK & @MIN)...Mike Scioscia's 1,329 managerial victories rank 30th all-time...29th on the list is Chuck Tanner (1,352)...Halos have used 31 pitchers in 2014, most in a single-season in club history (previously 29 in 1996)...Halos have gone first to third on a single 117 times to lead MLB...Angels are first team in A.L. history to be 6+ games behind after 70+ games and then take a lead of 8+ games at any later point in a season (STATS LLC)...Halos clinched MLB's first playoff spot with Monday's 8-1 win over Seattle...Sept. 15, 2014 is the second earliest postseason qualifying date in club history (9/10/08)...COMEBACKS: 45 of club's 96 victories are in comeback fashion (17 wins overcoming 2+ run deficits, 11 of 3+ run and three have been 4+ run)...45 comeback wins lead MLB, two shy of matching club-record of 47 in 2009.

@ OAKLAND: A's lead 2014 series 9-8 (LAA is 1-6 on road, 7-3 at home)...Angels have won five of last six meetings...In last series (8/28-31), Halos completed first four-game sweep over A's since July 10-13, 1997 in Oakland...Halos have won seven of last eight games vs. A's at Angel Stadium...LAA has lost three straight season series vs. A's (2011-2013)...Since 2008, LAA leads series 66-65...<u>Trout</u> has five HRs and 13 RBI over his last 14 games vs. A's

THIS DATE IN ANGELS HISTORY

September 23

(1978) Following a Saturday afternoon game in Chicago, Lyman Bostock went to visit family in his hometown of Gary, Indiana for the evening. While in a car at a stop light with a woman he had met that evening, an enraged man by the name of Leonard Smith unloaded a shotgun into the car intended for his estranged wife. The blast caught Bostock in the head and he died two hours later. The news crushed the Angels' franchise as one of their most likeable and promising players was gone. The club honored Bostock with a black armband for the remainder of

the season.

- In 22 starts across three stints with Triple-A Salt Lake this season, went 10-4 with a 4.43 ERA (128 IP 63 ER)...Recorded 119 strikeouts while walking just 42.
- LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision in last start Thursday vs. Seattle after tossing 5.1 shutout innings and allowing just three hits and no walks while striking out three...Marked longest start since tossing 5.2 innings for Miami on May 1, 2013 vs. New York Mets.
- <u>VS. OAKLAND:</u> In three career games (one start) against A's, is 0-0 with a 7.84 ERA (10.1 IP 9 ER)...Has made two appearances (both in relief) against Oakland this season...Pitched 6.1 innings in Angels debut on May 30 and allowed four runs at the Coliseum...Allowed two runs in one inning pitched in relief for Yankees against Oakland on June 4 in New York.
- AT O.CO COLISEUM: Only career appearance at the Coliseum came earlier this season on May 30 in Angels debut...Pitched 6.1 innings in relief after Garrett Richards allowed five runs in 0.2 innings pitched in his start...In his 6.1 innings of work, allowed four earned runs on six hits with two walks and four strikeouts...The 6.1 innings pitched mark the second longest relief outing of the season by any pitcher in the Majors (6.2 IP by Scott Baker for Texas on June 26 vs. DFT).
- Made first start of the season on August 25 vs. Miami and was the losing pitcher after allowing six runs on seven hits across 3.1 innings pitched.
- Claimed off waivers by New York Yankees on June 3...Made one relief appearance with New York-AL on June 4 vs.
 Oakland and allowed two earned runs on two hits with one walk and zero strikeouts...Was granted Free Agency by Yankees on June 15 and signed back with Angels on June 17.
