WINS AND LOSSES: With a 3-1 victory on Tuesday, the Rangers have split the 1st 2 games of the season for the 3rd straight year...in each instance, the club lost the opener and was victorious in Game 2...Texas is now 24-20 all-time in Game 2, winning 3 in a row since losing to CWS in 2012 and also capturing 6 of 8, 8 of 11, and 12 of 18...the Rangers have started a season 2-1 on 13 occasions, including each of last 3 years after not doing so since 2003...club has lost 2 of 3 to open the year on 17 occasions, last in 2010.

THE .500 MARK: At 1-1, the Rangers have a .500 record for the 1st time since 6/16/14 at 35-35...the last time the club was over .500 in 2014 was on 6/6 at 31-20.

A GOOD MONTH: The Rangers have posted a 50-27 record in April since the start of 2012, a .649 winning percentage that ranks just behind Atlanta (.658) in that span...Texas went 17-6 in 2012, 17-8 in 2013, and 15-12 in 2014 during April.

VS. OAKLAND: The Rangers have won 6 of the last 9 meetings vs. the A's beginning 9/16/14 with a 21-20 advantage since the start of last season...Texas has captured 4 of the last 5 games at O.co Coliseum, where the club is 13-7 since the start of 2013...all-time, Texas leads, 335-323 overall with the A's holding a 170-159 advantage in Oakland.

SCORELESS STRING SNAPPED: The Rangers ended a 21.0 inning regular season scoring drought with a 3rd inning run on Tuesday...that was the team's longest span without a run over one or multiple seasons since 26.0 innings, 7/26-29/13...team's last tally came in a 2-run 7th vs. OAK on 9/27/14 at TEX...club did not score in the bottom of the 8th in that 9/27 game and was in the season finale on 9/28 and again in Monday's 2015 opener.

COLBY LEWIS allowed one run in 6.0 innings for the victory on Tuesday and is now 7-1 in his last 12 starts against Oakland beginning 9/26/12...his .692 (9-4) career winning percentage vs. the A's ranks as 5th best among active pitchers with a minimum of 125.0 innings pitched.

--Lewis won his 55th game as a Ranger on Tuesday, tying Danny Darwin for 9th place on the team's all-time list.

FELIZ FINISHES: Neftali Feliz converted the Rangers' 1st save opportunity of the season on Tuesday and has earned saves in each of his last 11 tries over 2 seasons...since returning to the closer's role at the end of July in 2014, Feliz has converted 14 for 15 save opportunities with the lone blown save on 8/3/14 at CLE.

--Feliz has not allowed a run in his last 12.1 IP over 2 seasons beginning 8/24/14.
--He has worked 12.2 scoreless innings in his last 13 games vs. OAK, converting all 7 save tries in that span...has a 0.69 ERA (1 ER/13.0 IP) with 6 saves in 6 tries in 12 career outings at O.co Coliseum.

HOLD ON: According to baseball-reference, Keone Kela became just the 5th Ranger with a hold in ML debut when he worked a scoreless 7th inning on Tuesday...the others: Terry Mathews (6/21/91 at CWS), Bill White (9/5/07 vs. KC), Neftali Feliz (8/3/09 at OAK), and Cody Eppley (4/23/11 vs. KC)...White and Eppley recorded holds in an eventual Texas win.

LOOKING FOR A LONG BALL: The Rangers have gone homerless in 1st 2 games of a season for the 1st time since 2001 (2)...the only times the club has not gone deep in more than the 1st 2 games of a year were 1972 (4) and 1981 (4).

HIT BATSMAN: Rongned Odor has been hit by a pitch in each of the season's 1st 2 games, the 20th time that has been accomplished in major league history...the last was current Ranger Shin-Soo Choo, who has HBP in each of Cincinnati's 1st 2 games in 2013, 4/1 and 4/3 vs. LAA...the Rangers club record for overall consecutive games being hit by a pitcher is 3, Scott Fletcher, 8/3-6/88.

--Rangers batters were plunked by 3 pitches last night, one shy of the club record accomplished 7 times, last on 8/24/13 at CWS...Texas leads the majors with 4 HBP but has just one total walk through 2 games...the last ML team with as many as 4 HBP in 1st 2 games was MIL in 2008 (4).

IRONMAN: Adrian Beltre, who celebrated his 36th birthday on Tuesday, has appeared in all 142 Rangers games since being activated from the disabled list on 4/25/14...he missed 14 games with a strained left quad...according to STATS, Inc., that is currently the 4th longest active consecutive games streak in the majors:

VERSUS LEFTHANDERS: The Rangers see their 1st lefthanded starter of 2015 tonight when the A's Scott Kazmir takes the hill...club was 22-29 in games started by opposing southpaws in 2014, 13-13 on the road.

GENO PETRALLI NAMED ROUND ROCK COACH: Former Rangers catcher Geno Petralli has been named to the coaching staff at Triple-A Round Rock...Petralli returns to the pro coaching ranks for the 1st time since 1995, when he worked for Baltimore's extended spring team...he also served as a player coach in the Cubs organization in 1994...Petralli played in 809 ML games with the Blue Jays (1982-84) and Rangers (1985-93).

ROSTER ACTION: Through 2 games, Rangers not seeing action other than starting pitchers (Detwiler, Holland, Martinez) are RHP Logan Verrett, INF Adam Rosales, and OF Delino DeShields...Verrett and DeShields will be MLB debuts.

SHORTS: Friday's home opener with Houston is a sellout except for the availability of a few scattered single tickets...Globe Life Parking in Arlington parking lots open at 9:00 a.m. and the park gates open at 12 noon on Friday...Elvis Andrus joins Ian Desmond of WAS and Jimmy Rollins of LAD with 2 errors this season...Texas has just one extra base hit in 1st 2 games of a season for 3rd time (1972 and 1978)...Happy birthday to Rangers bullpen catcher Josh Frasier.

TONIGHT'S STARTING PITCHER

#47 Ross Detwiler, LHP
(0-0, —)

TONIGHT: The 29-year-old left-hander is set to take the mound tonight, starting the Rangers' 3rd game of the opening series here in Oakland...will be his first ML start since 7/3/13 vs. MIL while with the Nationals...earned a spot in Rangers starting rotation after pitching exclusively out of the bullpen for the Nationals in 2014, making 47 relief appearances with a 4.00 ERA (28 ER/63 IP)...faced Oakland for the first time in his career in 2014, giving up one run and 2 K's in 2.1 innings...worked through 9 batters and gave up 3 hits in his lone appearance 5/9/14 at O.co Coliseum...held LHBS to a .226 batting average in 2014, compared to a .312 average by righties...posted a road ERA (2.89) nearly 3 points lower than his home mark (5.61)...gave up just one extra-base hit against 93 LHB faced in 2014...earned his 1st major league save on 6/28/14 at CHC, throwing 4.0 scoreless innings to match the longest relief appearance by a National in 2014...made 50 starts for Washington from 2010-12, posting career bests with 27 starts, 10 wins, 164.1 innings, and 105 strikeouts in 2012...had just 13 starts in 2013, missing 101 games with back issues...6th overall selection in the 2007 MLB 1st Year Player Draft, making major league debut with the Nats at end of that season after just 9 minor league appearances.

BACK TO THE START: Tonight would be first start since 7/3/13 vs. MIL while with the Nats...totaled 28 outings of at least 6.0-or-more innings and 3 or fewer earned runs allowed as a starter from 2009-2013 as a starter...is 14-7 with a career ERA of 1.86 (37 ER/179.0 IP) in quality starts...from 2012-13, posted a 1.034 WHIP in 18 quality starts and held opposing hitters to a .227 batting average en route to a 1.78 ERA and a 9-4 record.

VS. OAKLAND: First and only career game against the A's came in relief on 5/9/14 at O.co Coliseum (2.1 IP, 3 H, 1 R-ER, 1 BB, 2 SO, 48 pitches/26 strikes), inducing 2 double plays...pitched scoreless ball until surrendering a run on back-to-back singles with 2 out in the bottom of the 7th, then was replaced.

Interleague: Went 0-2 in 16 interleague games (6 starts) with a 3.71 ERA (21 ER/51.0 IP) in his career with the Nationals...has pitched 4 games against AL West clubs, amassing a 2.70 ERA over 6.2 innings...racked up 5 strikeouts with 6 walks Washington's tour of the AL West last season...allowed just one extra-base hit against AL West opponents, a double by Houston's Jesus Guzman.

SPRING TRAINING: Made 4 'A' appearances this spring, pitching 9.2 innings and taking the loss in his only decision on 3/25 at CIN...posted a 3.91 ERA (5 ER/9.2 IP)...notched a spring-high 4 strikeouts in the Reds start...averaged nearly a strikeout per inning, 9 K's over his 4 games...yielded just one walk in an A game all spring, free pass to Justin Maxwell on 3/13 at SF.

STARTING FAST: Detwiler holds a career 1.86 ERA (14 ER/67.2 IP) in 18 April appearances, nearly 1.5 runs lower than any other monthly mark (Sep/Oct, 3.34)...has posted sub-2.05 April ERAs in each of the past 3 seasons, with a WHIP of 1.300 over the first month of the campaign...is 3-3 in 9 April starts, posting a 1.208 WHIP in 53.0 innings as a starter...the lefty's 6.0 K/9 IP in April is a monthly high, and his April .262 batting average against is the 2nd-lowest monthly mark (Sept/Oct, .238).

ROAD WARRIOR: Held opposing hitters to a .243 batting average in road contests in 2014, 90 points lower than his home mark (.333)...posted a 2.89 ERA (12 ER/37.1 IP) in away games, averaging nearly 3 fewer runs on the road compared to at home (5.61, 16 ER/25.2 IP)...posted a road WHIP of 1.132 last season (1.865 at home).

2014: Made all 47 appearances in relief for Washington after just 17 bullpen outings in 1st 7 pro seasons...issued runs in 17 of 47 games and permitted 29 1st batters to reach base...allowed 3 of 11 IR to score, finished 15 games, and had 3 holds...issued a 2B to Freddie Freeman on 4/13 vs. ATL, the only extra-base

hit he allowed to a LHB in 93 at bats...did not allow an earned run (5 total runs) in 12.1 innings over season's 1st 7 games...permitted 13 ER in 10.2 IP in next 8 appearances for a 5.24 ERA thru 5/22...posted a 3.32 ERA (15 ER/40.2 IP) in final 32 games...had a 1.82 ERA (6 ER/29.2 IP) in 1st 21 outings of that stretch thru 8/17, then allowed 9 runs in 11.0 innings in last 11 contests...worked more than an inning 21 times, going 1-1, 2.93 (13 ER/40.0 IP) in those outings.

2014 NOTES: Earned his 1st major league save 6/28 at CHI-NL, matching the longest relief appearance by a National all season (4.0 IP)...issued just one homer in final 43.0 innings over 34 games beginning 5/22...was not on Washington's active NLDS roster vs. SF...fanned season high 3 batters twice.

WASHINGTON: Made just 13 starts in 2013 due to back injuries...ranked 4th on the Nationals staff in 2012 in innings (164.1) and T4th in wins (10) in 1st full big league season...was 9-8, 3.58 in 27 starts and 1-0, 1.42 in 6 relief appearances... had 7th lowest ERA (3.40) among N.L. left-handers...held LHB to .170 batting average, lowest among ML qualifiers...defeated LAD on 9/20 to clinch postseason berth, 1st for a Washington, D.C. franchise since 1933...in lone career playoff appearance, issued 3 hits and one unearned run in Game 4 of NLDS vs. STL...Washington won, 2-1, on Jayson Werth's game-ending HR in the bottom of the 9th to stave off elimination for the Nats.

TOMORROW'S SCHEDULED STARTER — RHP NICK MARTINEZ (0-0, —)

The 24-year-old right-hander will be making his season debut in tomorrow's series finale in Oakland...went 2-2 with a 2.29 ERA (9 ER/35.1 IP) over his final 6 starts in 2014 beginning Aug. 31, as he has allowed 2-ER-or-less in each of his last 6 reg. season starts...will be starting a road day game...had lower ERA's both on road and in daytime vs. the alternative in 2014...Martinez is the only repeat member of the Texas season-opening rotation from 2014...he made his ML debut in Rangers' 5th game last season on 4/5/14 at TB...Martinez is the youngest member of the club's 2015 season-opening rotation by nearly 4 years (next-youngest is Derek Holland)...went 1-1 with a 2.53 ERA (6 ER/21.1 IP) in 4 G/3 starts vs. the A's in his rookie campaign...is making back-to-back starts vs. A's, as he started Rangers' season finale on 9/28/14 in Arlington (L, 5.2 IP, 4 H, 2 R-ER)...pitched 5.0+ innings and allowed 2-ER-or-less in all 4 outings vs. A's (including lone relief game 4/28/14 in Arlington)...most recent start at Coliseum was lone win vs. A's on 9/18/14 (5.2 IP, 3 H, 2 R-ER), besting Sonny Gray to finish off Rangers' 3-game sweep...the Coliseum was one of 3 road parks in which he had multiple starts in '14 (also 2 GS at HOU and SEA)...went 2-0, 3.94 (7 ER/16.0 IP) in 5 A games this spring, allowing multiple runs just once...last game was Sat. vs. NYM in Arlington, posting a perfect 2nd inning (1.0 IP, 1 SO, 14 pitches)...in his rookie season in 2014, ranked among club leaders in starts (2nd, 24), innings (3rd, 140.1), and strikeouts (3rd, 77).
