The Mariners and Athletics meet for the first of 19 games this season...will host the A's May 8-10 before making their next trip to Oakland July 2-5...Seattle went 10-9 vs. the A's last season, including 6-4 at the O.co Coliseum.

TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners visit the Athletics in the first game of a three-game set in Oakland...won on Opening Day but dropped 2 of 3 to the Angels to open the season...following this three-game set in Oakland, will have a three-game series at Los Angeles Dodgers...tonight's game will be televised in the Mariners TV market on **ROOT SPORTS NW** and broadcast live on **710 ESPN Seattle** and the Mariners Radio Network.

ODDS AND ENDS...are 1-2 on the season, going 1-0 during the day and 0-2 at night...pitching staff has allowed 8 runs in the 3 games...12 of first 18 games of the season will be played at Safeco Field.

- **ERA** - The Mariners have a 2.33 team ERA through the first 3 games with 27 strikeouts.
- **Young & Old** - **Fernando Rodney** was the oldest player on the Mariners Opening Day roster at 38 years, 19 days...**Taijuan Walker** was the youngest player at 22 years, 236 days.
- **First Opening Day** - **Tyler Olson** (LHP), **Jesus Sucre** (C), **Carson Smith** (RHP) and **Taijuan Walker** (RHP - on DL last year) made their first Opening Day rosters...was the 10th Opening Day rosters for **Felix Hernandez** and **Robinson Canó**.
- **2014 Review** - completed the 2014 season 87-75 (.537), 7th-most wins in club history...were 51-44 before the All-Star break and 36-31 after the break...posted a 24-23-6 record in series, including 11 sweeps...finished one game back of Oakland for the second AL Wild Card.

ROAD WARRIORS...the Mariners take to the road for the first time in 2015 after a successful season away from Seattle in 2014...went 46-35 (.568) on the road last season, tying for the 2nd-best road winning percentage in the American League...2nd-best road record in club history behind the 2001 team (59-22/.728)...secured first winning road season since going 43-38 in 2003, the 7th Mariners club with a winning season on the road, joining 2001 (59 wins), 2002 (45), 1997 (45), 2000 (44), 2003 (43) & 1996 (42).

ROAD LID LIFTER...are just 14-24 (.368) in the first road game of a season, but have won 6 consecutive (2009-2014)...broke a string of 6 consecutive seasons opening a season on the road with Monday's 4-1 win over the Angels...the 6-year stretch without a home season opener is the longest by a Major League team since the Brewers had a 10-season stretch without a home season opener from 1996-2005 and the Phillies opened 8 consecutive seasons on the road from 1997-2004.

OAKLAND HITTERS...**Robinson Canó** is a career .300 hitter at O.co Coliseum, going 54-for-180 (.300) with 25 runs scored, 14 doubles, 2 triples, 5 home runs and 17 RBI in 45 games...**Seth Smith** (10 HR), **Nelson Cruz** (6 HR), **Canó** (5 HR), **Dustin Ackley** (3 HR) and **Kyle Seager** (3 HR) have all hit 3 or more home runs at O.Co Coliseum.

FEELS LIKE HOME...**Robinson Canó** ranked 3rd in the American League in 2014 in road batting average...on the road, he hit .320 (101x316) with 21 doubles, 1 triple, 5 home runs and 47 RBI...he ranked only behind Detroit's **Victor Martinez** (.346) and **J.D. Martinez** (.325)...his .313 career road average ranks 4th in the majors since his first season in 2005 behind Cincinnati's **Joey Votto** (.319), Detroit's **Miguel Cabrera** (.318) and Minnesota's **Joe Mauer** (.318).

FIRST ROUND MATCH-UP...both of tonight's starters, left-hander **Drew Pomeranz** and right-hander **Taijuan Walker**, were taken in the 1st round of the 2010 June draft...Pomeranz was taken 5th overall by Cleveland out of the University of Mississippi, while Walker was the Mariners supplemental first round pick at #43 overall out of Yucaipa High School in Southern California.

SMASHING SOUTHPAWS...**Nelson Cruz** ranked 7th in the American League last season with a .569 slugging percentage against left-handers...on the season he hit .314 (43x137) with 9 doubles, 1 triple, 8 home runs and 22 RBI with a .407 on-base percentage...since becoming an every day player in 2009, only New York's **Michael Cuddyer** (.569), Toronto's **Jose Bautista** (.558) and Detroit's **Miguel Cabrera** (.551) have a higher slugging percentage than Cruz's .546 against lefties.

SPEAKING OF SOUTHPAWS...on the National League side, amongst batters with at least 90 at-bats against lefties, **Justin Ruggiano** (18th/.512) and **Rickie Weeks** (24th/.504) both slugged at least .500 and ranked in the top-25 in the league...as a team, the Mariners had a .342 slugging percentage against lefties which ranked last in the American League and 28th in the majors.

MINOR LEAGUES IN FULL SWING...the Mariners minor league affiliates began play yesterday: AAA Tacoma lost 11-4 to El Paso (**Carlos Rivero** HR)...AA Jackson scored 2 in the 9th to win 2-0 over Jacksonville (back-to-back RBI hits by **Gabby Guerrero** & **Jabari Henry**...High-A Bakersfield lost 3-2 to Rancho Cucamonga (**Edwin Diaz** had 8 K in 5.0 ShO IP)...A Clinton's game was postponed due to inclement weather.

THE EVERGREEN STATE...**Tyler Olson** made his MLB debut Wednesday night recording 2 outs on 1 pitch, inducing Erick Aybar to ground into a 5-4-3 double play...Olson is a Washington native from Spokane, playing at University High School and Gonzaga University...he is the 32nd player in Mariners history that was born or raised in the state of Washington.

YOU ALREADY KNOW...that **Taijuan Walker** had a strong spring, going 4-0 with a 0.67 ERA (2 ER, 27.0 IP) in 7 starts...**BUT DID YOU KNOW?**...that his spring performance carried over from his finish last season?...in his final 7 games (4 starts) of the 2014 season, he posted a 2.25 ERA (8 ER, 32.0 IP) with 28 strikeouts...over his last 14 games, including 11 starts (regular season & spring training), he has a 1.53 ERA (10 ER, 59.0 IP) with 54 strikeouts.

ABOUT WALKER...

- Pronounced: Taijuan (TIE-wahn) Walker.
- 22-year-old right-hander is making his 9th career Major League start today vs. the Oakland Athletics (12th game).
- Mariners supplemental first round selection (43rd overall) in the 2010 MLB First-Year Player Draft.
- Made his professional debut with the AZL Mariners in 2010, going 1-1, 1.29 ERA (1 ER, 7.0 IP) in 4 games.
- Pitched in the 2011 and 2012 MLB All-Stars Future game... also named to the Southern League All-Star team in 2012 (starting pitcher) and 2013 (DNP).
- Owns a 30-30 record with a 3.65 ERA (184 ER, 454.0 IP) in 88 games/84 starts in the Mariners minor league system.
- Named Mariners Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2011 & 2013.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP...went 4-0 with a 0.67 ERA (2 ER, 27.0 IP) in 7 Cactus League starts...he had a scoreless streak of 19.0 consecutive innings by not allowing a run in his first 5 starts...Walker ended up ranking 2nd in the Cactus League in ERA, 4th in innings pitched, and T3rd with 26 strikeouts...he joined Jacob deGrom (NYM) and Daniel Norris (TOR) as the only pitchers to go 4-0 in spring training play.

LAST TIME OUT...tossed 1st career CG but suffered a 1-0 loss in his last start Sept. 24 at Toronto...allowed just 1 run on 4 hits, with 6 strikeouts and 1 walk...8.0 innings was a career-high (prev. 6.0 IP, 2x...last: 9/1/14 at OAK).

HOUSTON. WE HAVE A WIN...all 3 of his career wins have come vs. the Houston Astros...4 of 7 career starts have been vs. the Astros.

WITH SEATTLE...had three separate stints with Seattle last year and was a combined 2-3, 2.61 in 8 G, 5 GS...in 5 starts was 2-3, 2.83 ERA (9 ER, 28.2 IP) in 16 walks and 27 strikeouts...in 3 relief appearances posted a 1.93 ERA (2 ER, 9.1 IP).

WITH AAA TACOMA...went 6-4 with a 4.81 ERA (39 ER, 73.0 IP) in 14 starts...pitched at least 6.0 innings in each of his final four starts, including a season-high 7.0 innings while striking out a season-high 13 batters Aug. 10 vs. Fresno.

CG IN MINOR LEAGUES...tossed first career complete game shutout in Rainiers 2-0 win over Oklahoma City on June 24 at Cheney Stadium...he limited the RedHawks to 4 hits, 1 walk and struck out 8...Walker's 9.0 inning shutout was the first thrown by a Tacoma player since LH James Paxton accomplished the feat at Tucson on July 8, 2013...the outing marked Walker's first complete game since tossing 9.0 innings against Great Lakes while pitching at Single-A Clinton on June 13, 2011.

ABOUT THE INJURY...Walker was placed on the 15-day disabled list on March 29 with a right shoulder impingement...he was activated from his rehab assignment (4/4-16 & 5/28-6/10) and optioned to Tacoma on June 10...he went 0-1 with a 6.30 ERA (7 ER, 10.0 IP) in 3 rehab starts with Tacoma...Walker was originally set to start at Tacoma on April 15, but was scratched due to shoulder tightness...he also made a rehab start with Jackson on April 9 vs. Mississippi (W-5.0,3,0,0,1,10,BK) and High Desert on April 4 vs. Inland Empire (4.1,4,2,1,1,7).

2013 REWIND...Walker went 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA (6 ER, 15.0 IP) in 3 starts with the Mariners in 2013...made his Major League debut on Aug. 30, 2013 at HOU and earn first career win...named the Seattle Mariners Starting Pitcher of the Year, going 9-10 with a 2.93 ERA (46 ER, 141.1 IP) in 25 starts combined between AA Jackson and AAA Tacoma...he struck out a career-high 160 batters in 141.1 innings in 2013, leading all Mariners farmhands and ranking T7th overall in the minor leagues...his 160 strikeouts are the most by a Mariners farmhand since RHP Francisco Cruzeta (185) and LHP Justin Thomas (162) in 2006...Walker pitched in the All-Star Futures Game and was selected as a Southern League All-Star this season.

HE WILL REMEMBER HIS FIRST...Walker is the youngest Mariners starting pitcher to win his MLB debut (8/30/13 at HOU)...is the 11th pitcher in Mariners history to win his starting debut and the 2nd (Pat Rice, 5/18/91 @NYY) to allow 0 ER AND earn a win...Erik Hanson (9/5/88 @MIN) is the only other starter to allow 0 ER in his debut, but he lost 2-0.

YOUNG HURLER...Walker made his MLB debut at 21 years, 17 days old on Aug. 30, 2013 at HOU, becoming the youngest Seattle pitcher to debut since Felix Hernandez (19.118 on 08/4/2005) and the 17th-youngest in club history.

TOP PROSPECT...Walker was listed by MLB.com as the Mariners top prospect and No. 5 prospect in baseball heading into the 2014 season, including the No. 2 right-handed pitching prospect...No. 6 PCL and No. 4 Southern League prospect by *Baseball America* after 2013 season...listed as Mariners No. 1 prospect by *Baseball Prospectus* and by *Baseball America* in 2014.
