OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost the past two games...it is the first time the A's have put together consecutive wins or losses...have out-scored the opposition 30-0 in their three wins and have been out-scored 26-13 in their four losses...went 3-4 on this season-opening seven-game homestand against Texas (2-2) and Seattle (1-2)...leave following the game today for a 10-game road trip to Houston (three games), Kansas City (three games) and Los Angeles-AL (four games).
- Jesse Hahn** is 1-0 with a 0.71 ERA (1 er in 12.2 ip) in two career starts against Seattle.
- Billy Butler** (3 for 4, r, 2b) is the only Athletic to hit safely in each of the first seven games and is the only American Leaguer with a seven-game hitting streak...is a career .336 hitter (74 for 220) against the Mariners, which is his best mark against any American League team.
- Mark Canha** (1 for 5) has hit safely in each of the first five games of his career.
- Josh Reddick** (2 for 5, rbi, 2b) was reinstated from the 15-day disabled list today and made his season debut.
- Stephen Vogt** (2 for 5, r, rbi, 3b) has a five-game hitting streak (7 for 19, .368) and has now reached base safely in each of his first six games...recorded an RBI triple in the fourth inning, the fourth triple of his career and first since July 6, 2014 against Toronto.

SEATTLE NOTES

- The **Seattle Mariners** have won the past two games to snap their three-game losing streak...are 2-1 on their current six-game road trip to Oakland (2-1) and Los Angeles-NL (three games).
- Felix Hernandez** left the game after five innings for precautionary reasons with tightness in his right quad...is 19-7 with a 2.64 ERA (73 er in 249.1 ip) in 36 career starts against the A's...is 10-2 with a 2.64 ERA (41 er in 140.0 ip) at O.co Coliseum...including 6-0 with a 2.87 ERA (29 er in 91.0 ip) in 13 starts at O.co Coliseum since April 11, 2009.
- Dustin Ackley** (2 for 4, 2 r, 2b) is on a four-game hitting streak (5 for 14, .357).
- Robinson Cano** (0 for 5, r) is 0 for his last 13.
- Nelson Cruz** (1 for 4, rbi, r, hr) hit his second home run of the season, the 199th of his career...both of his home runs this season have given the Mariners the lead.
- Rickie Weeks** (1 for 2, r, hr, 3 rbi) hit a pinch-hit home run in the seventh inning, the first pinch-hit home run for the Mariners since June 3, 2014 (last: Stefen Romero)...it is the third pinch-hit home run in his career.
