#### OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have lost three straight and four of the last five games to fall to a season-high three games under .500...have not been three games under .500 since July 2, 2012 (39-42)...are 0-6 in day games compared to 8-5 at night...have out-scored the opposition 62-6 in their eight wins (7.8 to 0.8) and have been out-scored 72-28 in their 11 losses (6.5 to 2.5)...are 0-2 on this six-game homestand against Houston (0-2) and Los Angeles-AL (three games).
- The A's have committed nine errors in their last six games and have 19 for the season.
- Kendall Graveman** has tossed fewer than five innings in three of his four starts this season...has allowed at least three runs in three starts.
- Chris Bassitt** made his Athletics debut.
- Ike Davis** (1 for 4, r) is 18 for 46 (.391) over his last 14 games after going 1 for 9 (.111) over his first three contests.
- Max Muncy** (1 for 4) made his Major League debut...recorded his first hit with a single in the seventh inning...became the first player selected in the 2012 First-Year Player Draft to reach the Majors with the A's.
- Eric Sogard** hit a two-run triple in the seventh inning, his first triple since September 5, 2013.
- Stephen Vogt** (1 for 4, k) is 11 for 25 (.440) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI and four walks over his last eight games.

#### HOUSTON NOTES

- The **Houston Astros** are 10-7 through 17 games, their best start since the 2006 club went 12-5 to start the season...have now won four of their first six series, including three straight...are 4-1 on this nine-game road trip to Seattle (2-1), Oakland (2-0) and San Diego (three games).
- The Astros pitching staff has allowed just 53 earned runs through their first 18 games this season for a 3.02 ERA (53 er in 158 ip).
- Scott Feldman** has walked only three batters in his four starts (24 ip) this season...has made three quality starts.
- Jose Altuve** (2 for 5, r, hr, 3 rbi) has a 28-game hitting streak (45 for 120, .375) against Oakland dating back to Sept. 5, 2013...according to the Elias Sports Bureau, it is the longest hitting streak by any Astros player against any single team...it is tied for the second longest hitting streak by any player against the A's franchise...recorded his third consecutive multiple hit game and seventh of the season.
- Jed Lowrie** (2 for 3, 2 r, 2b, 2 rbi, bb, hbp) had his fifth multiple hit game of the season...leads the Astros in runs scored (8), is tied for the team lead in walks (9) and ranks second in home runs (3), RBI (9), and OBP (.415)
