1965 - Joe Morgan singles home Bob Aspromonte in the 11th inning for a 5-4, walk-off win over Pittsburgh...it is the 1st day game in the Astrodome after the ceiling tiles had been painted to reduce the glare.

Hernandez:.....5 strikeouts shy of 800 Jed Lowrie:..... 1 double shy of 150 2 runs shy of 300 Pat Neshek:........ 6 strikeouts shy of 300 TODAY'S GAME: The Astros and Athletics will HOLY HITTING STREAK, BATMAN: After gocontinue this 3-game series today at the O.co Coliseum with a 1:07 p.m. CT matinee...the Astros will send veteran starter and Bay Area native RHP Scott Feldman (1-2) to the mound opposite RHP Kendall Graveman (1-1) and the A's...Feldman is coming off a winning perfomance on April 19 vs. LAA, in which he tossed 6.0 innings, allowing 2 runs on 6 hits.

BEST START SINCE 2007: With a 9-7 record thru 16 games, the Astros are off to their best start since the 2007 club also went 9-7 to open up their season...with a win today, a 10-7 mark would be the club's best start since the 2006 squad started 12-5 thru their first 17 games.

WINNING WAYS: The Astros have won 3 of their first 5 series on the young season, including 2 straight and 3 of their last 4...the Astros have won 5 of their last 6 games and are 6-2 in their last 8 contests.

ABOUT FELDMAN: RHP Scott Feldman has 2 quality starts in his 3 chances this season, giving him quality starts in 9 of his last 10 appearances dating back to Aug. 20, 2014...over that stretch, Feldman has posted a 2.75 ERA (21ER/68.2IP).

ASTROS HOLD ON IN EXTRAS: The Astros and A's played a suspenseful contest last night which culminated in an Astros 5-4 win over the homestanding A's...all 9 runs in the contest were scored in the 10th and 11th innings, with the deciding hit coming off the bat of LF Robbie Grossman, a 2-run, go-ahead single in the top of the 11th...the real story was a masterful LHP Dallas Keuchel, who tossed 9.0 shutout innings, allowing just 2 hits and 2 walks...the bullpen held on with RHP Chad Qualls (0ER/0.1IP) recording the final out, stranding 2 inherited runners.

ARM LIKE A ROCKET: LHP Dallas Keuchel has posted a 0.62 ERA (2ER/29IP) through his first 4 starts of the season, including 3 scoreless starts...per Elias, the only other Astros pitcher to have a lower ERA through his first 4 starts of a season than Keuchel was $\vec{R}HP$ Roger Clemens, who posted a 0.32 ERA (1ER/28IP) in his 4 starts to open up his 2005 campaign.

THAT'S QUALITY: LHP Dallas Keuchel has posted 11 consecutive quality starts, dating back to Aug. 15, 2014, in which he's gone 4-1 with a 1.81 ERA (16ER/79.2IP)...this is the longest quality start streak by an Astro since **LHP Wandy Ro**driguez posted 13 straight from July 25-Sept. 28, 2010...it also is the longest active streak in MLB.

STAY GOLD PONYBOY: LHP Dallas Keuchel. who became the first Astros pitcher to win a Gold Glove last season, has continued his defensive efforts thru 4 starts this season, recording a Major League best 10 assists to go along with 1 putout... Keuchel led the Majors in assists (47) in 2015.

STREAKER: RHP Will Harris has made 22 consecutive scoreless appearances (23.2IP), dating back to Aug. 19, 2014...this includes 6 appearances for Houston (8IP) this season ... his scoreless appearance streak ranks as the 2nd-longest active streak in the Majors immediately trailing LHP Aroldis Chapman (24g).

ing 2x4 last night, 2B Jose Altuve enters today's game with an active 27-game hitting streak against the Athletics...during the run, which dates back to Sept. 5, 2013, Altuve has hit .374 (43x115) with a .410 OBP in those games...per Elias, this ranks as the longest hitting streak any Astros player has had against any single team in the history of the franchise...Lance Berkman held the previous record with a 21-game hitting streak against the Rockies from 2004-08.

PITCH PERFECT: The Astros pitching staff has allowed just 50 earned runs thru their first 16 games this season for a 3.02 ERA (50ER/149IP)... this ranks 2nd among American League pitching staffs and tied for 3rd in the Majors...the starting staff and bullpen have both been effective, with the starters ERA (3.28) ranking 2nd in the AL and the bullpen ERA (2.55) ranking 3rd in the AL... AL rankings listed below:

EARLY SEASON LEADERBOARDS: Several Astros rank highly on the American League leaderboards, as 2B Jose Altuve ranks tied for 1st in stolen bases (5) and tied for 9th in hits (21) and **3B Luis Valbuena** ranks tied for 4th in home runs (5)...on the pitching side, LHP Dallas Keuchel ranks 2nd in ERA (0.62) and 3rd in opponent's batting average (.135), while RHP Collin McHugh ranks tied for 1st in wins (3).

SPEED AND POWER: The Astros rank 1st in the AL in stolen bases (16) and 5th in home runs (19)...in 2014, Houston finished 2nd in the AL in stolen bases (122) and 3rd in homers (163).

DIVISION SCHEDULE: Today marks the 14th of 15 straight games for the Astros against AL West-ern opponents...the Astros are 8-5 so far through this stretch...Houston will see each ALWest club over this 2-week span, including 3 games with Texas (2-1), Los Angeles (2-1) and Seattle (2-1) and 6 games with Oakland (2-2)...the Astros went 35-41 in divisional games last season.

vs. OAK: The Astros and A's will match up a total of 19 times this season, including 10 games at the O.co Coliseum...the Astros are 2-2 against the A's this season ... Houston has 4 players on their active roster that played for Oakland at some point in their career: **IF Chris Carter** (2010-12), **RHP** Luke Gregerson (2014), IF Jed Lowrie (2013-14) and RHP Pat Neshek (2012-13).

ODDS AND ENDS: The Astros are 7-0 in games started by LHP Dallas Keuchel and RHP Collin McHugh...the club is also 8-0 when scoring 1st and 8-0 when scoring 4 or more runs...the Astros have yet to lose a game in which they've led at any point and have used 15 different batting orders in their 16 contests...after using the same lineup in games 1-2, Houston has used 15 consecutive different batting orders.

- **LAST START 4/19 vs. LAA:** earned his first win of the season in the rubber match vs. LAA last Sun...pitched 6.0 innings, allowing 2 runs on 6 hits with 3 strikeouts...didn't walk a batter for the 2nd time this year...was his first win since Aug. 30, 2014 vs. TEX.
- he also notched his 2nd quality start of the season and now has 9 quality starts in his last 10 starts dating back to Aug. 20, 2014.
- **ABOUT FELDMAN:** the 32-year-old veteran is in his 11th Major League season...owns the 2nd-longest service time on the Astros roster behind only **Chad Qualls**...has made 20 or more starts in 6 of the last 7 seasons.
- signed a 3-year contract with Houston as free-agent on Dec.
 6, 2013 and will remain in an Astros uniform through the 2016 season.
- **NO FREE PASSES:** Feldman has only walked 1 batter in his 3 starts this season (17.1IP)...his 0.51 walks/9 innings ranks 3rd in the Majors, and 1st in the American League among qualifying pitchers.
- is the 1st Astro since **Wandy Rodriguez** in 2008 to start a season by tossing 5.0 innings and allowing 1 walk or less in 3 straight starts...is looking to become the 1st starter in club history to open a season with a 4-game streak of 5.0+ innings and less than 1 walk.
- FELDMAN IN 2014: spent the entire 2014 season on the Astros roster, starting 29 games and hurling 180.1 innings...his 3.74 ERA (75ER/180.1IP) marked the lowest he has produced over a full season in his entire career.
- received the Astros **2014 Darryl Kile Good Guy Award** as voted by the Houston Chapter of the BBWAA.
- shared a tie for the club lead in starts with Dallas Keuchel... ranked 2nd on the club in quality starts (20) and innings...finished T-6th in the AL in complete games (2) and 11th in groundball to flyball ratio (1.66).
- started on Opening Day for the Astros opposite **CC Sabathia** on April 1, 2014 at Minute Maid Park...led the Astros to a 6-2 victory, tossing 6.2 scoreless innings.
- IN FOR THE LONG HAUL: in 2014 finished T-6th in the AL in complete games (2)...threw both of his complete games in the second half of the season, which was tied for the most in the AL with LHP Dallas Keuchel, RHP Corey Kluber and RHP Colby Lewis.
- threw his second career shutout in a 3-hit, complete game performance over his former club, the Texas Rangers, on Aug. 30, 2014...was perfect through 4.1 innings...became the first Astro to allow three hits or fewer in a shutout since LHP J.A. Happ (8/30/10 vs.STL)...joined Keuchel and RHP Taylor Buchholz as the only pitchers in franchise history to throw a shutout against the Rangers.
- MASTERING THE MAGNUS EFFECT: according to PITCHf/x, Feldman threw the highest percent of curveballs in 2014 among all Major League pitchers at 28.9%...ranked directly ahead of RHP Sonny Gray.
- **vs. OAK:** will make his 28th appearance (19th start) against the Athletics today...his 27 appearances against OAK are tied with SEA as the opponents he's faced the most times in his career.
- last met the A's in his 2nd start of this season on April 13...allowed 8 runs (7 earned) on 10 hits in 5.0 innings of work.
- had arguably he best outing vs. Oakland on Sept. 6, 2014, at O.co Coliseum...pitched 8.1 innings, allowing only 2 earned runs on 7 hits with 6 strikeouts.
