OAKLAND NOTES

- The **Oakland Athletics** have been out-scored 85-37 in their 13 losses (6.5 to 2.9)...are 1-4 on this six-game homestand against Houston (0-3) and Los Angeles-AL (1-1).
- Ike Davis (1 for 4, r, 2b, rbi, k) is 20 for 56 (.357) over his last 17 games after going 1 for 9 (.111) over his first three contests.
- Jesse Hahn made his first start since April 18 after missing his last turn in the rotation due to a blister...has allowed three earned runs or less in each of his four starts this season...has tossed fewer than six innings in three of his four starts.
- Josh Reddick (1 for 3, rbi, bb) extended his hitting streak to seven games with a game-tying RBI single in the sixth inning...is 11-for-22 (.500) with seven RBI during the streak.
- Marcus Semien (3 for 4, 2 r, 2 2b) is 12 for 29 (.414) with five multiple hit games over his last seven contests after going 3 for 24 (.125) over his previous seven games...has nine multiple hit games for the season...collected his first three-hit game of the year (last: 4, April 20, 2014 at TEX).
- Stephen Vogt (1 for 4, rbi) is 14 for 36 (.389) with two doubles, three home runs and nine RBI over his last 11 games...has thrown out an attempted base stealer on back-to-back nights after beginning the season 0 for 9...has tossed out 2 of 11 (18.2%) attempted base stealers this season.

LOS ANGELES NOTES

- The **Los Angeles Angels** scored more than three runs for just the fourth time in their last 11 games and for just the ninth time in 21 games overall...are 1-1 on this six-game road trip to Oakland (1-1) and San Francisco (three games).
- Matt Shoemaker...made his first start since April 20 after missing his last turn in the rotation while on the bereavement list...is 9-1 with a 3.23 ERA (28 er in 78.0 ip) against the A.L. West...his only A.L. West loss came on April 20 against the A's (3 ip, 7 h, 5 er).
- Houston Street has converted 134 of his 144 save chances (93%) since 2011.
- Erick Aybar (1 for 4, 2 rbi, 2 k) is 79 for 234 (.338) in his career in Oakland.
- Kole Calhoun (1 for 4, bb, k) is 19 for 52 (.365) over his last 14 games.
- · Johnny Giavotella (2 for 4, r, rbi, k) is 15 for 44 (.341) over his last 14 games...recorded his sixth multiple hit game of the season.
- Mike Trout (2 for 3, 2 r, hr, 2b, 3 rbi, bb, k) hit his 14th career home run against the Athletics (63 g)...10 of those homers have come at the O.co Coliseum... collected his sixth multiple hit game of the year.
